TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) are on the road in Salisbury, Maryland against the Delmarva Shorebirds. Today is the sixth game of the six-game series and a 12-game head-to-head series in 2024. Delmarva has stormed back to win three straight games and leads the series 3-2. Fayetteville has not lost a series yet this year, but is in danger of doing so without a win today. On the mound, Fayetteville hands the ball to RHP Alonzo Tredwell. RHP Trey Gibson, who pitched out of the bullpen on Tuesday, will start for Delmarva.

ABOUT THE SHOREBIRDS: The Delmarva Shorebirds, founded in 1996, begin their 28th season of operation in 2024. Last season, the Shorebirds went 56-74 and finished sixth in the 1st half standings and fifth in the 2nd half standings. Delmarva joined the Carolina League in 2021 after spending 1996-2020 as a member of the South Atlantic League. The franchise was affiliated with the Montreal Expos during its innagural season in 1996 and has been affiliated with the Baltimore Orioles since 1997, winning South Atlantic League titles in 1997 and 2000. The 2024 season is out to a slow start for Delmarva, as they currently hold the worst record in all of minor league baseball at 6-19.

RICKY RIVERA RETURNS: Ricky Rivera returns to Fayetteville after leading the Woodpeckers to a 60-win season during the summer of 2023 and becomes the first manager in franchise history to head the club for two consecutive years. Rivera was named the fourth manager in Woodpeckers history in February of 2023 following the promotion of former Fayetteville manager Joe Thon to Corpus Christi (AA). This marks Rivera's fourth season as a minor league manager. He joined the Astros organization in 2020 and spent the 2021 and 2022 seasons managing the Florida Complex League Astros). A native of Dorado, Puerto Rico, Rivera attended Dorado Academy where he was a two time All-Country team selection and helped Dorado to a conference title. He was also a volleyball standout in high school. Rivera grew up a Yankees fan and idolized Roberto Clemente as a kid.

WOODPECKERS IN THE SHOW: On Tuesday night in Houston, former Fayetteville outfielder Joey Loperfido made his major league debut against the Cleveland Guardians. Loperfido started in left field and went 1-for-5 in the game, connecting for a two-run go-ahead single marking his first major league hit and RBI. Upon making his debut, Loperfido becomes the 22nd Fayetteville Woodpeckers to make it to MLB, along with the second this season following RHP Spencer Arrighetti who debuted earlier in April.

HR POWER 1-9: The Woodpeckers have shown the ability over the early stretch of the season to hit home runs at any part of the lineup card. On Tuesday in Delmarva, Cesar Hernandez hit a two-run home run, becoming the eleventh different Fayetteville bat to hit a homer. 16 of Fayetteville's homers to this point have been hit by 11 different players. Will Bush, Fernando Caldera, Alberto Hernandez and Alejandro Nunez are still seeking their first.

COMEDACK KIDS: The Woodpeckers have pulled out eight of 15 victories this year when trailing at some point in the game, including a pair of walk-off victories last week against Down East. They added another come-from-behind win on Wednesday night in Delamarva, erasing a 2-0 deficit. Fayetteville has also found a way to win on the margins, going 5-1 in one-run games this season.

GOMEZ GETS ON: 18-year-old OF Kenni Gomez had reached base in 18 straight games prior to Saturday night, but saw the streak end going 0-4. The 18-year-old outfielder still has a hit in 17 of his last 19 games played. The 18-game on-base streak was the fourth longest streak in the Carolina League this season.

PROSPECT PICTURE: Fayetteville's current roster has four of the Astros Top-30 prospects on MLB.com rankings. 3B/OF Waner Luciano ranks #18 overall in the system. The 19-year-old was a Dominican Summer League All-Star during the 2022 season and ranked second in the Florida Complex League with 10 homers in 2023. 5th round draft pick Chase Jaworsky, also just 19 years old ranks as the #29 overall prospect in the system. Jaworksy begins his first full season of pro baseball in 2024. RHP Alonzo Tredwell was added to the roster on Monday and ranks as the #13 prospect in the system after being drafted in the 2nd round of the 2023 Draft. Top international signing from the Astros 2024 class Cesar Hernandez joined the team on 4/22 and ranks as the #19 prospect in the system.

BABY DIRDS: The Woodpeckers entered the 2024 season with the youngest roster in franchise history. The average age of the lineup is just 20.14 years old, with three players in their age-19 season and two players age-18. The youngest position player on the roster is Nehomar Ochoa Jr., born July 31st, 2005. The youngest pitcher is 18-year-old Raimy Rodriguez, born July 16th, 2005.




