Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Gwinnett Stripers play game two of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Nashville won the opener last night, 4-1. Tonight, right-hander Tyler Herb starts for the Sounds against left-hander Tucker Davidson for the Stripers.

Tyler Herb: 30-year-old Tyler Herb makes his sixth appearance (fifth start) of the season with Nashville tonight. Herb is 0-3 with an 8.38 ERA (19.1 IP/18 ER) in five games with Nashville. He began the season with Double-A Biloxi and went 3-1 with a 1.31 ERA (34.1 IP/5 ER) in seven outings (6 starts). Herb last pitched on June 16 in a road start at Memphis and was hit with his third loss in as many decisions (2.2 IP, 9 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 2 BB, 5 K). Herb spent most of 2021 with Double-A Arkansas in the Mariners organization, going 3-6 with a 4.16 ERA in 17 games (15 starts). He also has spent time with the Giants and Orioles organizations. Herb was drafted by the Mariners in the 29th Round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Coastal Carolina.

Tucker Davidson: 26-year-old Tucker Davidson starts for the Stripers tonight. The left-hander has split 2022 between Atlanta and Gwinnett in 2022. In eight starts with the Stripers, he is 1-3 with 4.30 ERA (46.0 IP/22 ER). In four games (three starts) with Atlanta, he is 1-2 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP/11 ER). He last pitched on June 17 vs. Indianapolis and was tagged with a loss (5.2 IP, 6 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 5 BB, 6 K). Davidson split time between Atlanta and Gwinnett in 2021, making 4 appearances (all starts) at each. He went 2-2 with a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP/3 ER) with Gwinnett and 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (20.0 IP/8 ER) with Atlanta. MLB Pipeline tabs Davidson as Atlanta 7th-best prospect. The Braves drafted him in the 19th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Tascosa (TX) High School.

Superlatives: Last night's win improved the Sounds to 35-0 when leading after 8 innings...21-10 at First Horizon Park...31-7 when scoring first...26-10 when hitting at least one home run...29-4 when outhitting the opponent and 12-2 when a starter goes 6+ innings.

A Little Mo for Mona: Infielder Andruw Monasterio has hit safely in five straight games, tied for his longest streak of the season. During the five-game stretch, he's hitting .400 (10-for-20) with 4 multi-hit games, 4 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run and 5 RBI. After hitting .160 in the month of April, he hit .281 in May and is now hitting .333 (13-for-39) in the month of June.

Nothing Dahl About It: Outfielder David Dahl has hit safely in six consecutive games for Nashville, his longest hitting streak of the year. During the six-game span, he is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with 4 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 9 RBI and 2 walks.

The Sad Man: Reliever Connor Sadzeck continued his brilliant season out of the 'pen with another scoreless outing last night (1.0 IP, 2 K), his first time pitching in 10 days. In 19 games with the Sounds, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 1.27 ERA (21.1 IP/3 ER) with 26 strikeouts. Opposing batters are hitting just .184 against him.

Pitchers Prefer First Horizon Park: The Sounds return home to First Horizon Park where they will play 17 of their next 23 games. The team is 21-10 as they near the halfway point of the home schedule. Nashville's pitching has been the difference with a team ERA of 2.85 (275.0 IP/87 ER) at home, compared to a 4.47 ERA (299.2 IP/149 ER) on the road. Nashville pitchers are holding opposing batters to a .215 average.

Sweet's Managerial Watch: Rick Sweet has 187 wins as Nashville's manager, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223.

Earn It: The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.70 ERA. Buffalo checks in at second with a 3.96 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Herb last pitched on June 16 at Memphis. He lasted just 2.2 innings, allowing six runs (all earned) on nine hits and two walks in the loss. Herb struck out five on 63 pitches (41 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: Herb's only previous outing against Gwinnett came on May 26, 2019 at Coolray Field. Pitching for Norfolk in the Orioles organization, Herb took the loss. He yielded seven runs (all earned) on eight hits and six walks in 5.2 innings.
