OFFENSE TAMPED DOWN IN 6-1 LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Corpus Christi Hooks 6-1 on Friday night from Whataburger Field. Corpus Christi (8-8, 39-46) jumped out in front in the third inning against Frisco (9-7, 48-36) starter **Ben Anderson** (0-3) on an RBI groundout to lead 1-0. Tyler Whitaker then homered in the fifth and Joseph Sullivan lifted a sacrifice fly in the sixth to push the lead to 3-0. The Hooks then exploded for three runs in the eighth inning to extend the advantage to 6-0. The Riders found the scoreboard in the top of the ninth on an RBI single from **Corey Joyce**, but fell 6-1. James Hicks (4-8) took the win for the Hooks, allowing just one hit over 5.0 shutout innings.

THIS CURRY IS SPICY:

RoughRiders starter **Aidan Curry** tied a career best with 12 strikeouts in his start on Tuesday against Corpus Christi over 6.0 innings in a no-decision and has now whiffed 23 in his last 2 starts (11.2 IP). His 12 strikeouts are the most whiffs by a Texas League starter this season and was the most by a RoughRiders starter since **Victor Payano** cut down 13 Missions on May 3rd, 2016 (the franchise record is 14 by **Robbie Erlin** on June 26th, 2011). Frisco also struck out 18 as a team on Tuesday, tying their season-high and franchise record for a nine-inning game. The RoughRiders have most strikeouts in Minor League Baseball with 119 (11.9 per game) in their last 10 games, despite striking out just 1 batter on Friday. It marked just the 23rd time in recorded franchise history (since 2005) that Frisco had struck out just one batter, and the first since August 31st, 2019 at Northwest Arkansas.

WAGNER BY THE WATER:

Max Wagner has owned Corpus Christi, homering 6 times in his first 7 games in Corpus. He has the most home runs at Whataburger Field of any visiting player and only Trevor Austin (7 in 37G) of Corpus Christi has hit more long balls at the ballpark all year. From 2023 to 2026, Wagner's six home runs are the most by a visiting player during that span and they have all been this year. He is the first visiting player to homer 6 times in a season at Whataburger Field since Kent Matthes for Midland in 2014, who did so in 11 games. No visiting player has ever hit 7 home runs in a season at Whataburger Field.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has an incredibly clutch for the RoughRiders, homering 8 times in his first 34 games with the RoughRiders. All of but 2 of his 8 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including his go-ahead, 2-run home run in the 8th on Tuesday in Corpus. The Riders are 8-0 when he homers. His 19 home runs this year are the 2nd most in the Rangers organization. With 4 3-hit games in July already, he is batting .412 (14-for-34)/.500/.735/1.235 in the month. For the first time in his career, he had 3 hits or more in 3 games in a row. Since May 31st, he is 5th in the Texas League in average (.333), 5th in OBP (.431), 3rd in SLG (.650), 3rd in OPS (1.081), 4th in hits (41), 1st in doubles (13), 1st in extra-base hits (22) and 72nd in runs (34).

BALLPARK BY THE BAY:

The RoughRiders are back in Corpus Christi for the 3rd time this season before the Hooks even travel to Frisco once. The Riders are 9-4 in Whataburger Field in 2026, including a 3-game sweep of the Hooks to open the season. In the 13 games, the Riders have hit 20 home runs while slashing .261/.345/.440/.785 while averaging 5.9 runs per game on offense.

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567).

BIG POWER STRETCH:

In their last 16 games, Frisco is tied for 2nd in the Texas League with 27 long balls. Their 110 home runs through 84 games are the most in franchise history, as are their 6.1 runs per game (the 4th-highest mark in Double-A since 2005).

OH, YOU THINK THE DARKNESS IS YOUR ALLY:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (181 runs) and the 5th-best team in Double-A (and 2nd in the Texas League) in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.89).

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

Frisco's 58 runs in the first inning this year are 2nd in the Texas League. They have scored in the first inning in 29 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 14 games this season. The Riders are 9-9 when trailing after one inning this year. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 22-35 (including a combined 9-11 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 26-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 20-19 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 84 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in Double-A with 758 hits. They are 2nd in the league in batting average (.266) and 2nd in runs (513, 6.1 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 41 percent of their games (35-of-84). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (110), 1st in doubles (153), 3rd in SLG (.444) and 2nd in OPS (.802).

ABOUT DYLAN

-Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.

-Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.

-Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.

-At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.

-Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

2026 SEASON

-Opened the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders

-Opened season with 5.89 ERA in April.

-Threw first career quality start on May 24th vs. San Antonio: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 K.

-After a 5.89 ERA (12ER/18.1IP) over 4 GS, he owned May in 5 GS, going 2-0 with a 2.88 ERA (8ER/25.0IP) while holding opponents to a .228 batting average.

2025 SEASON

-Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)

-After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.

-Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

2024 SEASON

-Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

2023 SEASON

-Lead the team with 7 wins on the season

-As a starter, went 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA over 7 games. As a reliever, went 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

PITCHING COACH

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

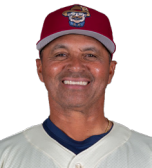
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

BRETT PLATTS

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League. The Canadian completed his strength and conditioning internship with the University of Iowa athletic department in 2022 and spent four years with the Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy from 2019 through 2022.
