TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves and the Shuckers open the season at Trustmark Park after Biloxi won the 2022 season series 18-12. The M-Braves are 4-13 on Opening Day, last winning 3-0 on April 5, 2018 against the Tennessee Smokies.


- M-BRAVES FEATURE 16 RETURNERS FROM LAST SEASON: The M-Braves Opening Day squad includes six Top-30 MLB Pipeline prospects and 16 players who made at least one appearance with the M-Braves last season.
- The Top-30 prospects include RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 11), INF Cal Conley (No. 13), RHP Rod-dery Muñoz (No. 21), RHP Alan Rangel (No. 26), RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 28), and LHP Luis De Avila (No. 30).
- Conley opens the season as the M-Braves highest ranked prospect (MLB/BA) and will make his first appearance in Double-A. In 2022, the infielder split time between Single-A Augusta and High-A Rome. After being promoted to Rome on July 12, he hit .260 with six home runs and 25 RBI in 44 games for the High-A club. Conley recorded the South Atlantic's longest hitting streak, hitting in 18 consecutive games from July 15 to August 7.
- Returning M-Braves position players include C Hendrik Clementina, C Javier Valdes, INF Cade Bunnell, INF Drew Lugbauer, INF Luke Waddell, OF Cody Milligan, OF Jacob Pearson, and OF Landon Stephens.
- Returning M-Braves pitchers include LHP Hayden Deal, RHP Tanner Gordon, RHP Coleman Huntley III, RHP Roddery Muñoz, RHP Alan Rangel, RHP Trey Riley, RHP Victor Vodnik, and RHP Kyle Wilcox.
- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer has hit a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America.
- NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN: Kanekoa Texeira takes over as the M-Braves 11th manager in club history after spending the last two seasons managing High-A Rome in the Atlanta organization. He will be joined by second-year pitching coach **Bo Henning**, hitting coach **Danny Santieste**ban and coach Jefferson Romero.
- Texeira will make his Double-A debut. The Maui native enters his sixth season of coaching. He began his coaching career with Rookie League Danville in 2017 as a pitching coach. Last season, Texeira led the Rome Braves to the South Atlantic Playoffs for the first time since 2018, finishing 74-54. The 74 wins was tied for second-most in team history. In two seasons with rome, Texeira had a 130-114 (.533) managerial record.
- 2023 SCHEDULE: The 2023 schedule features 138 games, including 69 home games. The M-Braves will take on division rivals Montgomery and Pensacola 30 times each while taking on division rival Biloxi 27 times. From the North Division, the M-Braves will take on Chattanooga 15 times and Birmingham, Rocket City, and Tennessee 12 times each (6 home, 6 road). All 2023 series will be six games in length, except for the first series against Biloxi and a three-range corrige corrige to the take on the All Star Brack. game series against Chattanooga from July 14-16 after the All-Star Break.

2022 SEASON IN REVIEW: The M-Braves concluded their 17th season with a 62-74 overall record, the sixth-best in the Southern League.

- The pitching staff's 4.28 ERA ranked second in the Southern League and sixth in Double-A The starting pitchers posted a 4.43 ERA. The M-Braves had a streak of eight games where the starting pitcher made it at least five innings (8/30-9/8), posting a 3.29 ERA (15 ER, 41.0 IP) over that span. RHP Alan Rangel led the league with 139 strikeouts and was fifth with a 5.26 ERA. The bullpen posted a 4.17 ERA
- OF Michael Harris II and IF Vaughn Grissom were both promoted directly from Double-A Mississippi to Atlanta last season. Harris II played in 43 games for the M-Braves, reaching base safely in 41 of 43 games. The Dekalb, GA native had a minor-league best 31-game on-base streak to start this season. Overall, he hit .305 with 16 doubles, five home runs, 33 RBI, and 11 stolen bases. He registered a .878 OPS from the leadoff spot. Grissom had his contract selected by the Atlanta Braves on Wednesday, August 10 after 22 games and 91 at-bats for Mississippi. Grissom became the youngest player in AL/NL history to homer and swipe a bag in his debut.
- RHP William Woods, LHP Jared Shuster, RHP Freddy Tarnok, RHP Tyler Ferguson, RHP Darius Vines, RHP Odalvi Javier and C Hendrik Clementina were all promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett during the season. Woods (4/30) and Tarnok (8/17) both made their MLB debuts last season.
- After going 7-13 in April, the M-Braves turned it around with a league-best 16-10 record in May. In June, the club was 7-19, tying their club record for losses in June. The M-Braves went 16-8 in July. The 16 wins were 2nd in AA and T-5th in MiLB, and included a six-game sweep of Rocket City (first six-game sweep in club history). The M-Braves finished 10-15 in August, continuing the remarkable trend. September finally ended the trend, as the M-Braves finished the final month of the season 6-9


