LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was blanked by Hudson Valley, 3-0, on Saturday night...RHP **Drew Thorpe** set the Renegades' single-game strikeout record with 13 punch outs...He also set their franchise mark for single-season strikeouts with his performance...The right-hander tossed 8.0 innings of 2-hit, shutout ball earning his league-leading 10th win...Carried a perfect game-bid into the 6th when it was broken by a RF **Omar De Los Santos** single with 1 out...RHP **Joander Suárez** was phenomenal in a loss for the Cyclones, tying a season-high with 8 strikeouts over 6.0 innings...CF **Alex Ramírez** extended his on-base streak to 8 with a double in the 7th...CF **Spencer Jones** tallied a 2-run double and LF **Christopher Familia** added a solo home run for Hudson Valley.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Brooklyn has won 11-of-15 (.733) and 17-of-24 (.708) going into Sunday's series finale...The Cyclones are 16-7 in the second half and lead the North Division of the SAL by half a game over Aberdeen (15-7)...Brooklyn a half-game behind Hickory (16-6) for the best record in the circuit during the half.

BANANA'S FOR FOSTER: RHP **Cameron Foster** has found his groove on the bump over the last few weeks...Since the start of June, the 24-year-old holds a 2-0 record with a 2.51 ERA (8 ER in 28.2 IP) with 10 walks and 31 strikeouts over 6 starts...Foster's strikeout rate is up 3.6% from his overall numbers (26.5% from 22.9%) and his walk rate is down 1.5% (8.5% from 10.0%).

ACE GERVASE: RHP **Paul Gervase** has been as dominant as any relief pitcher in Minor League Baseball in 2023...Through 24 relief appearances, the 23-year-old is 1st and 2nd in ERA (1.19) among SAL and MiLB relievers, respectively (min. 35.0 IP)...The 2022 12th-round pick is 3rd in MiLB in opposing batting average (.127)...Since June 6, Gervase holds a 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP) with a hold and 4 saves over 11 relief outings...In MiLB, the former Louisiana State arm is 2nd in opposing batting average (.094) among MiLB relievers (min 15.0 IP), tied for 2nd in hits allowed (5), 5th in opposing OPS (.363), strikeouts-per-9 innings (15.75), and ERA (0.56)...He holds a strikeout rate of 43.8% in that time.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...The 23-year-old hurled a quality start on Saturday at Hudson Valley and set a new career-high with 7.0 innings of work in a July 8 defeat at Wilmington...Over his last 7 appearances (6 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 2-3 record, but a 3.82 ERA (13 ER in 30.2 IP), 12 walks (9.8 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (35.0 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 3 starts, to Cumaná, Venezuela native holds a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with 5 walks (7.7 BB%) and 24 strikeouts (36.9 K%)...In his first 9 appearances (8 starts), the right-hander was 1-4 with an 8.02 ERA (30 ER in 33.2 IP), 28 walks (16.5 BB%), and 39 strikeouts (231 K%).

I GOT YOUR SIX: OF **Alex Ramírez** became the first player in Cyclones history to record a 6-hit game with a 6-for-6 performance on Friday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old also stole 3 bases, scored 3 runs, drove in a tally, and robbed 3B **Marcos Cabrera** of a home run in the 2nd inning...Ramírez is 1-of-5 players in Minor League Baseball to compose a 6-hit game in 2023...Alex is the first player in Minor League Baseball since the stat portal began in 2005 to record 6+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...Ramírez is the first Cyclone with 5+ hits in a game since 2B **Luke Ritter** went 5-for-6 vs. Lowell on June 28, 2019...He is 1-of-2 players in franchise history (since 2005) with 5+ hits and 3+ stolen bases in a single game...CF **Gregory González** went 5-for-6 and stole 3 bases on August 18, 2005, vs. Williamsport...Since the start of June, Alex is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in runs scored (32), 3rd in pitches-per-plate appearance (4.006), and tied for 5th in walks (24) (min. 170 PA)...Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 3rd in franchise history in RBI (72) and is 19 behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He is 2nd in doubles (32), 3rd in hits (136), 3rd in total bases (200) and 4th in runs scored (72).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and stole second base on Friday night at Hudson Valley, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The 33 swipes break INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 3rd in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 103 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (108), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clásé** (108), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (108), and Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (105) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 61 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 42.

AROUND THE CAROUSEL: 2B **D'Andre Smith** picked up his first home run as a Cyclone with an inside-the-parker in the 7th on Friday night at Hudson Valley...It was the 2nd inside-the-park home run clubbed by Brooklyn in 2023...C **Kevin Parada** capped his first career multi-home run game with a 2-run inside-the-park home run in the 6th inning of June 23's win vs. Hudson Valley...They are the first 2 inside-the-park home runs by Cyclones players since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in the 2005 season...The first one in franchise history was clubbed by **Joe Giannetti** on July 19, 2001.

THE .500 CLUB: With Brooklyn's victory on Friday night, the Cyclones jumped over .500 on the season at 44-43...Brooklyn had not been over .500 since the 3rd game of the season...The Cyclones moved to 2-1 with a 4-2 win vs. Jersey Shore to close out the season-opening homestand on April 9.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn earned their 17th come-from-behind victory and 11th win in their final at-bat with an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...Friday night marked Brooklyn's second win in 2023 when trailing after 8 innings...The first came in July 7's win at Wilmington...The Cyclones came from 4 runs down to earn the victory on July 4, matching their largest deficit erased on the campaign...The 'Clones erased a 4-0 margin entering the 5th and a 4-1 deficit going into the 7th...Brooklyn also erased a 4-run ledger on Opening Day — April 7 — vs. Jersey Shore...The Cyclones trailed 4-0 after the 1st inning that day, ultimately topping the BlueClaws, 9-8, in 11 innings.

HIT 'EM UP: The Cyclones tallied a season-high 18 hits in their 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 18 knocks were the most by Brooklyn in a single game since they accrued 19 hits in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022.

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns to the road to open a 6-game road trip against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades posses 3 of new York's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF **Spencer Jones** (7), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (29)... Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Maimonides Park for the first time in 2023...Brooklyn captured the first series at Heritage Financial Park from May 16-21 and the first meeting on Coney Island from June 20-25...The Cyclones went 4-2 in both sets, taking 4-straight games to close out the most recent series...The Cyclones are 136-140 (.493) all-time against the Renegades dating back to their inaugural season in 2001.

CUTTING 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is amid his best stretch of baseball in 2023...Tidwell has earned the win in 5 of his last 6 outings with Brooklyn winning all 6 games...He has permitted just 7 runs on 25 hits over 38.0 innings...He has walked only 10 (6.9 BB%) and struck out 47 (32.4 K%) in those contests...Tidwell punched out a career-high and team-season-best-matching 11 in consecutive starts on July 6 at Wilmington and June 30 vs. Jersey Shore...This comes after he tied a then-career-best with 10 strikeouts on June 11 vs. Greenville...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 11 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 7-0 with a 1.70 ERA (11 ER in 58.1 IP) with just 35 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 30 and struck out 80 (34.0 K%)...Tidwell's holding opponents to a meager .172 batting average (35-204) against him...In that time, Tidwell is 2nd in the South Atlantic League and is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (80)...High-A Hudson Valley's RHP **Drew Thorpe** (87) leads the SAL and the minors...He is also 4th in batting average against (.172) and 3rd in ERA (1.70) since that date (min. 50.0 IP)...On the season in the SAL, the Loretto, Tenn. native leads in batting average against (.195), is tied for 2nd in wins (7), 3rd in strikeouts (107), 4th in ERA (3.29), and 10th in innings pitched (76.2).

PARADA POWER: C **Kevin Parada** registered his 2nd multi-home run game of the season on July 15 vs. Greensboro, tallying solo shots in the 1st and 5th innings...The Pasadena, Calif. native also accrued multiple blasts on June 23 vs. Hudson Valley...Kevin poked a solo home run in the 3rd and a 2-run inside-the-parker in the 6th...Since 2005, Parada is 1 of 2 Cyclones to record a pair of multi-home games in the same season...INF **Nick Evans** powered a pair of jacks on July 22, 2005, vs. Jamestown and again on August 24, 2005, at Williamsport...Dating back to June 6 vs. Greenville, the 21-year-old is slashing .303/.367/.545 with a .912 OPS and 151 wRC+ in 34 games...Parada has accrued 18 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 triples, 7 home runs, 22 RBI, 11 walks, and 3 hit-by-pitches...The former Georgia Tech Yellow Jacket enters Sunday tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (33) and doubles (19), 6th in total bases (139), and 7th in hits (82)...Since June 6, Parada is tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 2nd in total bases (72), tied for 5th in hits (40), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (15) and home runs (7), 8th in slugging (.545), and 10th in OPS (.912).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been scalding hot with the bat over the last few weeks...Since June 22 vs. Hudson Valley, the 21-year-old is slashing .299/.367/.558 with a .925 OPS and a 154 wRC+...In 21 games, Lugo is hitting .299 (23-77) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 4 home runs, 20 RBI, and 9 walks (10.0 BB%) to only 12 strikeouts (13.3 K%)...In that time, the right-handed swinger has raised his batting average by 38 points (181 to .219)...Among SAL players, Lugo is 2nd in RBI (20), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (11), 9th in slugging percentage (.558), and tied for 9th in total bases (43) since that date.

THE RHY-T STUFF: OF **Rhylan Thomas** made a spectacular game-saving catch to close out Brooklyn's 4-3 win at Hudson Valley on Thursday night...The 23-year-old also picked 2 hits and RBI on Friday and enters Saturday on a 6-game hitting streak...Thomas is 8-for-20 (.400) at the plate with a 1.005 OPS, 4 runs scored, a home run, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...In 9 games since July 4 at Wilmington, the former USC Trojan is 11-for-31 (.355) at the dish with a .852 OPS, 4 runs scored, a home run, 6 RBI, and 3 walks to only 2 strikeouts.

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** collected his first career multi-home run game for Brooklyn on Wednesday afternoon...The 22-year-old ripped a solo home run in the 4th and 6th innings, the latter of which traveled an estimated 464 feet...Consuegra is the 3rd different Cyclone to tally a multi-home run game in 2023, joining C **Drake Osborn** (6/17) and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 & 7/15)...He has also tallied 3-straight multi-hit games since Wednesday (6-for-13)...The Dominican native has picked up at least one hit in 14-of-18 games since being reinstated...In that time, Consuegra ranks tied for 5th in the circuit in home runs (4) and tied for 9th in extra-base hits (8).

JUNIOR MINT: INF **Junior Tilién** clubbed a go-ahead 3-run home run with 2 out in the 9th on July 7 at Wilmington as part of a multi-hit night...The 20-year-old has picked up a knock in 12 of his last 14 games entering Friday...Tilién is 17-for-his-last-54 (.315) with 8 runs scored, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, and 4 walks...During the streak, Tilién is slashing .315/.362/.574 with a .936 OPS and 149 wRC+.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on June 14...7 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2), OF **Alex Ramírez** (5), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (15), RHP **Christian Scott** (16), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (18), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (22)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 1), RHP **Mike Vasil** (4), OF **Matt Rudick** (13), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (14), RHP **Junior Santos** (19), RHP **José Butto** (23), RHP **Luis Montas** (24), OF **Rowdy Jordan** (25), and RHP **Matt Allan** (30)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

START ME UP: Foster is slated to make the 14th start of his season and pro career on Sunday afternoon...The 24-year-old did not start at McNeese State in 2022 and only made 4 total over 3 seasons...During 2 campaigns at Wharton (Texas) County Junior College registered just 8 starts in 23 appearances...Prior to this season, his last official start came on February 28, 2021, for McNeese State vs. Prairie View A&M University.
