the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It's the 12th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the sixth of 12 games in Virginia. With a victory, Gwinnett would win its first road series of the season.

VS. NORFOLK: The Stripers are 8-3 (.727) in 11 games vs. Norfolk (5-1 home, 3-2 road), their best record against an opponent so far this year. Gwinnett is 9-2-1 in 12 season series all-time vs. Norfolk (since 2009), and hasn't lost a season series since 2013 (went 7-14). Last year, the Stripers and Tides split the season series (6-6).

ON THE OFFENSIVE: Gwinnett leads the International League in team batting since 4/23, hitting .271 (276-for-1,018, 55 2B, 3 3B, 33 HR, 160 R, 148 RBI, 20 SB) over 31 games in that span. That's two points higher than Nashville. which ranks second at .269 in 30 games since 4/23.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 494 in 47 games (10.51 SO per game). That's 12 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 482 SO in 47G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 56) and Touki Toussaint (T-9th, 46) both rank among the IL top 10 in strikeouts through 5/27.

DELINO DE-STEALS: Delino DeShields Jr. drew three walks and stole two bases in a game for the second time this season last night (also did it on 5/10 at DUR). He now ranks among IL leaders in on-base percentage (.414) and stolen bases (T-11th, 10). DeShields has reached base safely in 29 of 34 games overall, batting .263 (26-for-99, 4 2B, 13 R, 10 RBI) with a team-high 24 walks.

A JOLT FROM JENISTA: After going homerless for 28 games from 4/12-5/25, Greyson Jenista has homered in two of his last three games (#5-6). His solo clout (off LHP Zac Lowther) helped Gwinnett to a 3-2 win in game two of Thursday's doubleheader, and his three-run blast (off RHP Conner Greene) staked the Stripers to a 5-0 lead last night. Gwinnett is 5-0 when Jenista homers this season.

PEREZ PRODUCING: Hernan Perez tallied a season-high three hits last night (3-for-5, HR, 2 R, 2 RBI, SB). Over his last six games, he's batting .368 (7-for-19, 2 2B, 1 HR, 5 R, 6 RBI, 1 SB, 1.087 OPS) with two multi-hit efforts.

THE GOOSE IS LOOSE: Phil Gosselin has notched hits in 15 of 18 games in May, batting .328 (22-for-67, 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 10 R, 9 RBI, 2 SB, .969 OPS). Overall, he has reached base safely in 34 of 38 games, hitting .300 (42for-140, 8 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 21 R, 17 RBI, 3 SB, .854 OPS).

• GWN Career: Over parts of four seasons with the club (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .296 (297-for-1,004, 59 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 134 R, 99 RBI, 10 SB, .770 OPS) with 82 multi-hit efforts in 273 games.

TODAY: The Stripers play the finale of a six-game series vs. **TROMP MASHING IN MAY:** Since 5/1, **Chadwick Tromp** ranks among IL leaders in RBI (T-2nd, 22), home runs (3rd, 8), extra-base hits (T-6th, 12), slugging percentage (7th, .658), total bases (T-8th, 48), and OPS (14th, .961).

> • Power Restored: In Game 2 on Thursday, he blasted a game-winning solo homer (#9) off LHP Kevin Smith for a last-at-bat 3-2 victory, his first clout since the final game of his 13-game hitting streak (.385 from 4/24-5/12), 11game RBI streak (23 RBI from 4/28-5/12), and ninegame extra-base hit streak (11 XBH from 5/1-5/12).

RISING WATERS: Since being reinstated from the 7-day IL on 5/3, **Drew Waters** is batting .300 (18-for-60, 4 2B, 2 HR, 9 R. 6 RBI, 1 SB, .790 OPS) in 15 games.

- Start It With a Bang: Both of his homers have come on the first pitch of the game (5/3 vs. CLT off LHP Wes Benjamin and 5/11 at DUR off RHP Tommy Romero), the third and fourth leadoff homers of his Triple-A career.
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he's batting .252 (144-for-571, 31 2B, 1 3B, 15 HR, 96 R, 54 RBI, 32 SB in 144G).

STREAK ENDS FOR VODNIK: Victor Vodnik allowed his first run of the season last night (1.1 IP, 2 H, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO). He had posted 10 consecutive scoreless outings (11.0 IP, 4 H, 6 BB, 17 SO) between Double-A Mississippi and Gwinnett from 4/26-5/26, going 2-for-2 in saves.

• Triple-A Debuts: Vodnik is the sixth player to make his Triple-A debut with Gwinnett in 2022, joining OF Justin Dean, OF Greyson Jenista, SS Braden Shewmake, RHP Allan Winans, and RHP Willilam Woods.

<u>DEMERITTE RETURNS:</u> Yesterday, the Braves optioned Travis Demeritte back to Gwinnett. Demeritte hit .213 (19for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with Atlanta from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 161 of 189 games (85.2%) since 2019, batting .284 (185-for-651, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 126 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .946 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons (20 in 2019, 21 in 2021), joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

- Recent Struggles: After going 1-0 with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER in 17.2 IP, 0 HR) in four games in April, is 1-1 with a 7.85 ERA (16 ER in 18.1 IP, 6 HR) over four starts in May.

Made two starts (0-0, 2.08 ERA, .200 BAA) before being recalled by Atlanta on 4/19 ... Did not appear in a game for the Braves before being optioned back to Gwinnett on 4/21 ... 4/22 at JAX: Made his first relief appearance of the year (4.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 4 SO in 3-2 loss) ... 4/27 vs. NOR: Earned his first win of the year (5.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO in 8-2 win) ... 5/21 vs. MEM: Logged season-high 6.1 innings (4 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 5 SO) for his second win.

2021 SEASON: Saw time with three MiLB teams (2-1, 3.62 ERA, 1.06 WHIP, .156 BAA in 9G, 6 starts) and Atlanta (3-3, 4.50 ERA, 1.30 WHIP, .234 BAA in 11G, 10 starts) ... Began the season on Atlanta's 60-day injured list with a right shoulder strain ... Made six rehab starts between High-A Rome (1G), Double-A Mississippi (1G), and Gwinnett (4G) from 6/15-7/13, posting a 2-1 record, 4.24 ERA, and 31 strikeouts ... 
