**Long Time, No See:** For the first time in 1,210 days, dating back to May 2, 2019, the Lansing Lugnuts take on the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in Midwest League action. The last time that the two clubs played, the MWL was classified at Single-A and the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Toronto Blue Jays. Last year, the Lugnuts changed affiliations from Toronto, with whom they had been affiliated since 2005, to the Oakland Athletics. Fun fact: May 2, 2019, a 10-4 Lugnuts win, was the last game in Lansing for 2022 American League All-Star catcher **Alejandro Kirk** before he was promoted to A-Adv. Dunedin. Also taking part in the game: current Brewer **Peter Strzelecki** appeared in relief for Wisconsin.

**Matchup:** Lansing is expected to use the tandem of starting right-hander **Grant Holman**, a 2021 sixth-round selection from California, followed by mammoth 6-foot-9 right-hander **Jorge Juan**, against Timber Rattlers right-hander **Carlos Rodriguez**. Last Tuesday, Juan started and tossed three hitless innings before Holman relieved and allowed one hit over four innings vs. Great Lakes.

**Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 11, Loons 7.** In the final game for acting manager **Veronica Alvarez**, replacing **Phil Pohl** during Pohl's scheduled vacation, the Nuts erupted for five runs in the sixth inning to rally past Great Lakes in front of 4,991 fans at Jackson Field. The Loons won four of six in the series.

**On Deck:** Today is the first day of 12 road games in 13 days to close out the 2022 road schedule. After this series concludes on Sunday, the Nuts enjoy a day off before proceeding to South Bend.

### LUGNOTES

**Welcome to the Show:** The first 2021 Lansing Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, **Norge Ruiz**, made his Major League debut Friday night for the Oakland Athletics, tossing 1 2/3 innings in relief and allowing four runs (two earned) in the A's 10-2 loss to Seattle. Born in La Habana, Cuba, the 28-year-old Ruiz made four appearances in relief for the Lugnuts last season, tossing 5 2/3 innings. This year, he had a 3.83 ERA in 30 appearances with the Las Vegas Aviators. He is the 171st Lugnut to reach The Show all time and the tenth to do so this season.

**Updated Prospect List:** MLB Pipeline has updated its Top 30 A's Prospects, with **Max Muncy** moving to No. 7, **Denzel Clarke** jumping up to No. 11, **Joey Estes** remaining stable at No. 16, **Euribiel Angeles** now at No. 16, **Brayan Buelvas** now at No. 23 and **Cooper Bowman** remaining No. 29. **Jorge Juan** fell off the list entirely. The Athletics' top five 2022 draft picks, all likely future Lugnuts, were each ranked: first-round catcher **Daniel Susac** at No. 5, second-round outfielder **Henry Bolte** at No. 6, compensatory second-round outfielder **Clark Elliott** at No. 13, third-round outfielder **Colby Thomas** at No. 16 and fourth-round pitcher **Jacob Watters** at No. 27.

**Transaction:** Entering today's opener, the Lugnuts placed 1B/OF **Patrick McColl** on the Covid Injured List.

**Running Men:** The Lugnuts stole a season high six bases on Sunday, with two apiece by **Denzel Clarke** and **Cooper Bowman**, giving the ballclub 31 steals in 38 attempts through 18 games in August, averaging over two stolen bases attempts per game. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had only eight stolen bases in April, 14 steals in May, 18 steals in June and 31 steals in July. The Lugnuts have now stolen 102 bases this year, the fourth lowest total in the league, though the Nuts' 62 steals combined between July and August is equal to the Great Lakes Loons' total steals for the entire season.

**Heating Up as a Unit:** The Nuts have the highest August team OBP in the Midwest League at .353 and the second highest batting average this month at .256. Additionally, Lansing leads the league this month in HBPs (18) and is tied for second in doubles (33) and third in runs (90).

**Amongst the League Leaders:** The Lugnuts are third in the Midwest League in overall team batting average (.245) and third in base hits (911). Reliever **Kumar Nambiar** has 39 appearances, second only to West Michigan's **Andrew Magno**. Infielder **Euribiel Angeles**, currently on the Injured List, is eighth with 96 base hits.

**Impact Felt:** Though he has been in Double-A Midland for several weeks now, 20-year-old **Tyler Soderstrom** continues to lead the Midwest League in RBIs (71) and is tied for 2nd in home runs (20), ranks 2nd in extra-base hits (42), 4th in total bases (172) and 5th in slugging (.513).

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

**Inside the Park and Out of This World:** On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Majors.

**Roster Crunch:** The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

**From Far and Wide:** The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); and **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22).

**To the Show:** Ten former Nuts have debuted in MLB this year, namely A's pitchers **Norge Ruiz** (2021), **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

**In a Nutshell:** Received 2022 Opening game start for Lugnuts... listed as a "Sleeper Arm We're Watching" in the A's system by Eric Longenhagen and Kevin Goldstein for Fangraphs ("Holman, a two-way guy at Cal, [is an] arm strength flier right now. The hope is Holman can add movement to his fastball")... spent May 10-Aug 2 on IL.

**Little League Hero:** One of the all-time great Little League World Series performers... coached by father Doug... 6'4, 166 lbs. at age 13, throwing 70s mph heat... opened up 2013 LLWS with an extra-inning no-hitter, crushing a game-winning grand slam to clinch the second game, and then delivering an extra-inning walk-off three-run homer in the third game... led Eastlake Little League to the LLWS championship game, where they fell 6-4 to Japan... Padres prospect Robert Hassell III also competed in the tournament as a member of the Southeast champ from Nashville.

**High School:** Recorded a 3.95 GPA at Eastlake H.S. ... career high school stats: 29-1, 1.10 ERA | .390 avg., 20 HR, 80 RBI... 2017 MaxPreps National Junior of the Year, 2017 California Mr. Baseball Runner Up... 2018 CIF SDS Pitcher of the Year... played one year on Eastlake H.S. varsity basketball team.

**Bear Down:** Starred as a two-way player at Cal... as a freshman, hit .272/.362/.456 as the DH while making 11 appearances, nine starts (37 1/3 IP, 4.82 ERA)... on May 4, 2019 at Utah, hit game-tying double, then pitched the 9th to notch the save... as a sophomore in Covid-shortened 2020, was Cal's starting first baseman and No. 2 pitcher, leading the Bears with 24 2/3 IP (3.28 ERA) while hitting .250/.333/.324... on March 10, 2020, after hitting his first home run earlier in the game, hit by a pitch in the face against San Jose State in the bottom of the 7th inning... that was his last ever at-bat in college baseball... named 2021 Baseball America Preseason All-America First Team, utility... as a full-time pitcher in injury-hampered junior year, 2021, delivered 10 weekend starts, 47 IP, 3.83 ERA, 20 BB, 46 K.

**Evaluation:** Rated by MLB.com as the No. 138 best prospect entering the 2021 draft... the MLB scouting report: "Holman has the chance to have a legitimate four-pitch mix, all coming from a strong, durable build that points to a potential starting-pitching profile. He touched 97 miles per hour as a reliever in the San Diego Collegiate League over the summer, and was regularly hitting 96 in bullpens this fall for Cal, throwing his fastball for heavy riding life. He already had a live slider and a splitter he uses as his off-speed offering and added a slower 12-to-6 curve that looks like it could be a usable offering as well. All of Holman pitches have a lot of action, and he has a feel to find the stroke zone with all of them. But not a lot of track record yet given his split focus, but he is a college arm with some serious upside, one who could climb boards in a hurry."

**Draft Day:** Selected 188th overall in the 6th round by Oakland, 2021, the first Golden Bear to be drafted... signed for \$375,000, higher than the recommended slot of \$255,000... second pitcher drafted by the A's, following third-rounder Mason Miller (Gardner-Webb).

**2021 - Professional Debut:** Appeared in six games, four starts, for Low-A Stockton in 2021... made pro debut vs. Inland Empire, August 25... struck out five Modesto Nuts in 2 1/3 innings, September 14... finished with his best outing, tossing four scoreless two-hit innings vs. Modesto, whiffing four, on September 19.

**2022 - Midwest League:** Earned honor of Lugnuts' Opening Day start, though it was pushed back one day by terrible Michigan weather... started Game 1 of doubleheader, April 9 vs. Lake County, tossing four innings, six hits, two runs, no walks, two strikeouts; both runs were scored in the fourth inning; outdueled by Gavin Williams (4 IP, 0 H, 6 K) in Lugnuts 3-0 loss... tossed immaculate inning on April 14, Game 2, at West Michigan, whiffing nine in five innings... followed up with six scoreless innings April 21 vs. Fort Wayne, fanning seven; allowed leadoff runner to reach in five of six innings... returned from the Injured List August 2 vs. West Michigan and did not escape the first inning; faced eight batters (32 pitches, 17 strikes), allowing three hits, two walks, one home run (Bryant Packard two-run HR), and four runs, while recording only two outs... Lugnuts fell behind 10-1 in the 2nd inning, rallied within 10-8 in the 7th, but ultimately lost 15-8.

**Welcome Back!** The 6'9 right-hander, the tallest player on the team, was reinstated from the Injured List in Single-A Stockton and promoted to the Lugnuts on August 4, 2022... Juan made two starts in 2021 for the Lugnuts (at Lake County and at home vs. Dayton) but landed on the Injured List; he returned on August 5, 2022, tossing 1 1/3 innings vs. West Michigan in a no-decision, allowing two runs in the 1st inning and a run in the 2nd inning (inherited/scored against Jake Walkinshaw).

**Last Start: August 16 vs. Great Lakes.** Juan was dominant for the second consecutive start... struck out the side in the first inning... recorded a perfect second inning, striking out Damon Keith... struck out Austin Gauthier to open the third inning; walked Luis Diaz with two outs, but Diaz was then caught stealing to end his outing... 40 pitches, 23 strikes... Lugnuts lost, 2-1.

**Prospecting:** Jorge was ranked MLB Pipeline's No. 24 prospect in the Oakland Athletics organization and No. 13 pitching prospect before falling off the rankings with the midseason update... had been ranked the A's No. 19 prospect entering the year by Baseball America ("Juan is built like a throwback NBA power forward").
