JUMBO SHRIMP BEST KNIGHTS IN SERIES FINALE

Home runs from Jesús Sánchez, Jacob Amaya and Jerar Encarnacion helped Jacksonville to a 5-2 win on Sunday over Charlotte. Sánchez and Amaya went back-to-back in the first inning to put Jacksonville ahead. A Carlos Perez second-inning shot and Elvis Andrus fourth-inning home run tied the score at two. Encarnacion broke the tie with a two-run long ball in the fifth, and Sánchez added an RBI single in the sixth to get things to 5-2. Devin Smeltzer worked 5.0 innings of two-run ball and the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen worked the final four frames unscathed.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 27 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 54 runs, 47 earned, on 101 hits (6.7 H/9) in 135.1 innings for a 3.13 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 149 strikeouts (9.9 K/9) against 74 walks (4.9 BB/9) during this recent run.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 18 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-66 (.348/.434/.697/1.131) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 17.7% of the time this season. His .207 BABIP is the fifth-lowest of the 189 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville outfielder Brian Miller has reached base in 16 of his last 17 games, with the lone miss being an 0-for-1 pinch-hitting appearance. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 22-for-60 (.367/.458/.517/.975) with five doubles, two triples, six RBIs and seven runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.5 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.6 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last two contests, Jacksonville has blasted nine long balls, including a season-high six on Saturday, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those nine home runs are the most in Triple-A over the last two games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 58 homers rank almost exactly in the middle of the pack in Triple-A, placing in a tie for 16th.

THE MAYOR OF STARKVILLE

An offseason trade acquisition from the New York Mets, Jacksonville outfielder Jake Mangum has had an outstanding start to the 2023 season. The former Mississippi State Bulldog is 49-for-156 (.314/.349/.474/.823) with 11 doubles, four triples, two home runs, 22 RBIs, six walks and 17 runs scored to start the campaign. Among the 128 qualified players in the IL, Mangum is tied for the second-highest line drive rate (33.1 percent) and eighthhighest opposite-field rate (41.7 percent). Those figures were at 28.2 and 32.2 percent, respectively, while playing for Triple-A Syracuse in 2022.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled mightly of late. Over their last 21 games, they've combined to surrender 78 runs. 75 earned, on 101 hits (12.3 H/9) in 74.0 innings for a 9.12 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville starters have walked 52 (6.3 BB/9) against only 55 strikeouts (6.9 K/9).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has lost its last five series openers heading into Monday's set lid-lifted at Durham. The Jumbo Shrimp have also fallen in four of their last five game twos of series' during this span... Jacksonville has gone just 26-38 (.406) against Durham in the last three seasons since rejoining the International League. The Bulls have outhomered the Jumbo Shrimp 93-76, and as a result, outscored them 351-276.



-Sánchez was originally signed by the Tampa Bay Rays in June 2014 as an international free agent. Sánchez was a consensus Top-100 prospect from 2018-20 before being traded by the Rays along with RHP Ryne Stanek to the Marlins on July 31, 2019 in exchange for RHPs Nick Anderson and Trevor Richards.
-Sánchez made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 21, 2020 against the Washington Nationals. In 10 games for Miami, he went just 1-for-25 at the plate with two RBIs and four walks.
