REGULAR SEASON BY THE NUMBERS

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game series against the Birmingham Barons at	
Trustmark Park. The two teams will meet a total of 12 times this season, with six games at	
Trustmark Park and six games at Regions Field from August 23-28.	

SERIES NOTES: In game four, Riley Delgado's walk-off single lifted the M-Braves over the Barons 6-5 in the ninth and ended their longest losing streak of the season at six games. Hendrik Clementina and Yariel Gonzalez each homered, and RHP Odalvi Javier picked up his first win with a scoreless ninth.

- In game three, the M-Braves went up 5-1, but the Barons scored five runs in the sixth to take their first lead of the game, one they did not relinquish in a 6-5 win. Justin Dean went 3-for-4 with a double and two steals, and Yariel Gonzalez smacked a three-run double in the fifth.
- In game two, The Barons were powered by a 10-run second inning where they tied a Southern League record with 10 consecutive hits. The M-Braves fell 11-2. RHP AJ Puckett struck out six batters and RHP Odalvi Javier tossed two scoreless innings in relief.
- The M-Braves dropped their first 2022 meeting against Birmingham 9-4. RHP Troy Bacon delivered three scoreless innings of relief, Dean tripled and scored twice and Alexander added two RBI in the loss. After the game was tied 1-1, Birmingham scored six unanswered runs and never relinquished the lead.
- SCORE FIRST, GO FIVE INNINGS: The M-Braves are 21-11 when scoring first in a game and 21-9 when the starting pitcher makes it at least five innings into the outing. In contrast, the club is 6-23 when opponents score first and 6-25 when the starter goes less than five innings.
- RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE: The relief core for the M-Braves leads the Southern League and is 4th in Double-A with a 3.94 ERA this season.
- THE M-BRAVES WENT TO JARED: Starter Jared Shuster has a 3.63 ERA through 12 starts, which ranks 8th in the Southern League. The 2020 Atlanta first-rounder ranks among the league leaders in OBA, (.199, T-3rd), WHIP (1.00, 4th), innings pitched (62.0, 1st), strikeouts (67, 2nd)
- THE SLUGBAUER TIES ALL-TIME HOME RUN LEADERS: 1B Drew Lugbauer has 14 home runs this season, and 32 overall with the M-Braves. His two-run homer on Thursday, June 9 tied him with Travis Demerritte and Connor Lien for the M-Braves record. He leads the Southern League in home runs ranking T-6th in Double-A, including a two-homer game on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched a club-record with six RBI.
- Lugbauer hit a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG, the M-Braves first walkoff since Wendell Rijo's single on 7/9/21. He is in league's top 10 in...XBH (29, 3rd), walks (31, 8th), doubles (15, T-5th) total bases (109, 4th), and runs scored (37, T-9th).
- ALEXANDER THE GREAT: INF CJ Alexander hit his 11th home run on Friday, June 10, ranking 7th in the league. He has two multi-homer games, May 13, at Chattanooga, and May 27 at Pensacola, his third and fourth since 2019. From May 27-June 1, Alexander homered five times in five games.
- Alexander leads the league, and ranks T-4th in Double-A baseball with 11 homers since May 1.
- BABA O' RILEY: INF Riey Delgado sits among the league leaders at 9th with a .292 batting average. He hit a walk-off single on Friday, June 17 to beat the Barons 6-5 and a winning two-run single in the ninth against Montgomery on Saturday, April 30. He lost an 11-game hit streak on Saturday, May 28, the team's third longest this season (Waddell, 12/M. Harris, 15), and hit .462 with six RBI and eight runs in that stretch.
- MAESE SAVES THE DAY: After logging a save in Pensacola on Tuesday, May 24, RHP Justin Maese leads the Southern League, and is T-3rd in Double-A, going 9-for-9 in save chances this season. He posts 42 strikeouts to just eight walks in 25.2 innings. He's also T-2nd in appearances with
- MAJOR LEAGUE DEBUTS: OF Michael Harris (5/28), LHP Joey Wentz (5/11), RHP William Woods (4/27) and Bryce Elder (4/12) have all made their big league debuts this season, making 156 total MLB debuts for the M-Braves since 2005.
- Harris II hit his first major league home run on Monday, June 13 to left center field at Nationals Park in Washington, D.C. He followed with another homer the next night. The outfielder just lost an eight-game hit streak with a .433 average, two homers, three doubles, a triple and eight RBI over the streak.
- Harris II is the 22nd M-Braves player promoted directly to Atlanta, and first since Max Fried made the jump on August 5, 2017...the first position player since Dansby Swanson on August 17, 2016. The first to jump from Mississippi to Atlanta was Brian McCann on June 10, 2005.

TODAY'S GAME

 Freddy Tarnok makes his 12th start of the season and his second career start against Birmingham. He last faced the Barons on August 8, 2021, tossing six shutout innings in a game the Braves ultimately lost 1-0 at Regions Field.

LAST TIME OUT

 Tarnok was unable to make it out of the first inning, leaving the bases loaded after allowing a run off a hit and three walks with two strikeouts at Rocket City last Sunday.

2021 SEASON

- Struck out a career-high 12 batters on July 29 at Pensacola, the first 12-strikeout game by an M-Braves pitcher since Ian Anderson struck out 14 on June 28, 2019 vs. Iackson
- In his M-Braves debut, he tossed a season-high 5.1 innings with nine strikeouts, one
 walk, two earned runs and three hits in a no decision on July 23 vs Biloxi
- Promoted to Mississippi onn July 20 from High-A Rome. In 7 games, 5 starts for Rome, Tarnok went 3-2 with a 4.76 ERA, 13 walks and 48 strikeouts
- Began the season on the GCL Braves roster, recovering from a lat injury, and transferred to Rome on June 9, making his first start on that day, with 4.0 shutout innings, one walk, eight strikeouts adn 58 pitches
- Struck out a career-high (at the time) 10 batters, walking only two, in his final Rome start on July 16 vs Greensboro
- Went 1-0 and did not allow a homer over 1.2 innings and three appearances during 2021 MLB spring training. He struck out three, walked one and had one save on 3/1 at MIN. His win was against Tampa on 3/14.

- Ended season ranked by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 11 prospect
