Fort Wayne took the lead in the bottom of the first on a leadoff homer by Jonny Homza, but the Captains bounced back with two runs in the third. Brayan Rocchio tied the game with an RBI double and Bryan Lavastida's RBI ground out gave the Captains a 2-1 lead. Seamus Curran tied the game for Fort Wayne with an RBI double in the fourth, but the Captains hit two homers in the fifth to take the lead again. Lavastida drilled a three-run, goahead homer to dead centerfield. Two batters later, George Valera hit a solo shot to center to extend the Captains' lead to 6-2. Homza hit another solo homer for Fort Wayne in the fifth to cut the Captains' lead to 6-3. Lake County added a run in the seventh on an RBI single by **Daniel Schneemann**. Rocchio capped the scoring with a home run to lead off the ninth. Captains starter Hunter Gaddis struck out seven and allowed three runs over five innings to earn the win. TinCaps reliever Edwuin Bencomo took the loss after allowing four runs over 2.2 innings.

TODAY'S STARTER: Xzavion Curry makes his High-A debut after dominating the Low-A East League (LAE) for the Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander leads all gualified LAE pitchers in ERA (1.07), FIP (1.94), WHIP (0.63), K-BB% (36.2%), batting average against (.135) and BABIP (.220). He is second in K% (40.4%) and LOB% (83.3%).

APPLESAUCE: The Captains are 6-1 against the TinCaps with a +24 run differential (38-14). Lake County is slashing .268/.332/.455 (.787 OPS) with nine home runs during the season series. José Tena leads the offense with a .348/.375/.783 slash line (1.158 OPS), including three home runs. The Captains' pitching staff has a cumulative 2.00 ERA and has averaged 12.7 K/9 (89 K, 63 IP), while holding Fort Wayne to a .167 average.

COMING ALIVE: The Captains ended May by suffering a six-game sweep at West Michigan, in which they averaged just 2.0 runs per game. Since then, the Captains have averaged 7.1 runs per game and have gone 5-2 to open June. Joe Naranjo is 7-for-18 (.389) with a team-leading seven walks for a .560 on-base percentage. Brayan Rocchio is 9-for-25 (.360) with two homers and four doubles for a .760 slugging percentage and a 1.167 OPS. Will Brennan is 9-for-27 (.333) with two homers, two doubles for a .630 slugging percentage and a 1.009 OPS.

BRENNAN BASHING: Captains OF Will Brennan is tied for the High-A Central League (HAC) league lead in doubles (11). He is fourth in batting average (.317), eighth in wRC+ (145), and ninth in OPS (.885).

LIGHTS OUT: Allen has the lowest ERA among qualified pitchers in the High-A Central League (HAC) at 1.63, the thirdlowest WHIP (0.90) and the fifth-lowest batting average against (.202).

SWING AWAY: The Captains' offense has walked just 115 times this season. That is the second-fewest in the High-A Central League. The Captains also have two of the nine lowest BB% rates among qualified hitters in the High-A Central League – Brayan Rocchio (4.2% - 3rd), José Tena (6.4% - 9th).

100: 2018 Captains RHP Eli Morgan became the 100th former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on May 28. Eight former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018) and Morgan. The record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year s nine (2013 and 2016).

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their infield defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

RED HOT START: Curry made five starts for Low-A Lynchburg to begin the 2021 season. At the time of his promotion, Curry was leading the Low-A East League (LAE) in ERA (1.07), FIP (1.94), WHIP (0.63), K-BB% (36.2%), batting average against (.135) and BABIP (.220). He was second in K% (40.4%) and LOB% (83.3%).

DURING 2020: Spent part of quarantine living and training with 2018-19 Captains outfielder **Will Benson** in Atlanta. Curry and Benson have known each other since they were seven years old. The two were part of a group of Atlanta area professional and college ballplayers who trained and played pick-up games together after the Spring Training shutdown. The group included 2020 American League Rookie of the Year Kyle Lewis and his Mariners outfield teammate Taylor Trammell, as well as Atlanta's No. 14 prospect Trey Harris. The Atlanta raining sessions began with a small group playing on a field behind a local church. As more players joined, they started playing full-fledged pick-up games and moved to LakePoint, where each player chipped in \$10 for field usage fees so the group could make use of the complex's eight major league-sized turf fields.

RAMBLIN' WRECK: Curry was Georgia Tech's Friday night starter each of his three seasons and became the first Yellow Jacket in the modern era (1973-present) to win three straight Opening Day starts. Since 2002, Curry ranks third at Georgia Tech in strikeouts looking (84) and fourth in total strikeouts (241). The right-hander was a Third-Team All-ACC selection as a junior in 2019.

SHOWING FLASHES: Curry recorded four double-digit strikeout performances in his junior season at Georgia Tech (2018). The right-hander struck out 11 at NC State, fanned 12 at home against Miami, struck out 12 again at home against Wake Forest and struck out 10 at home against Duke. His 12-K performance against Wake Forest was arguably the best start of his college career, in which Curry pitched a complete game, nine-inning, two-hit shutout. The following season, Curry had another marquee performance. Facing then-No. 4 Louisville on the road, Curry pitched eight innings and held the Cardinals to one run on one hit with nine strikeouts for the win. Curry retired 16 straight batters at one point.

TWO WAY: Curry registered six at-bats as a true freshman at Georgia Tech and went 3-for-6. He even started one game as a designated hitter. Prior to college, Curry was rated as the 27th ranked shortstop recruit in the country by *Perfect Game*.

HIGH SCHOOL: While at Mays High School in Atlanta, Curry was a 2016 *Perfect Game/Rawlings* Third-Team All-American and a 2016 *Perfect Game* Southeast All-Region First Team selection. Curry was also a 2015 *Perfect Game* underclass First-Team All-American and 2014 underclass high honorable mention All-American. Curry threw five no-hitters during his high school career and holds Mays school records for wins (32) and home runs (25). Mays was also the quarterback on the Mays High School football team for two years.
