### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Making his Triple-A debut at Louisville Slugger Field, Pittsburgh Pirates top prospect Paul Skenes punched out five across 3.0 perfect innings as the Louisville Bats defeated the Indianapolis Indians in walk-off fashion on Saturday afternoon, 4-3. Louisville scored all four of its runs via the long ball, with Michael Trautwein's solo shot with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning breaking a 3-3 tie. The Bats got on the board first in the fifth inning when Rece Hinds launched a three-run homer to left-center field. The top of the Indians order dominated the offense, with Nick Gonzales, Billy McKinney, Liover Peguero and Jake Lamb each logging two hits in the first four spots. With Gonzales and McKinney on base in the top of the seventh, Peguero and Lamb roped back-to-back RBI doubles to tie the game.

**SKKKKKENES SIZZLES:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated by the No. 3 prospect in Minor League Baseball, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) made his Triple-A debut at Louisville yesterday and punched out five across 3.0 perfect innings. Skenes' fastball topped out at 101.2 mph in his third inning of work, with four of his five strikeouts coming on triple-digit four-seamers. He threw 29 strikes on 46 total pitches. The 21-year-old was selected by the Pirates as the No. 1 overall pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft. Following a College World Series championship season at Louisiana State (Baton Rouge) University in which he was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, Skenes struck out 10 batters over 6.2 innings of professional ball with the FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton and Double-A Altoona.

**NICK HITS:** Nick Gonzales has wasted no time getting hot at the plate in the Indians first two games of 2024, recording two hits again yesterday for the second day in a row. He roped two singles, the first of which put him on base to score the first runs of the game for Indy during a three-run game-tying seventh inning. On Friday, he plated the first Indians runs of 2024 on a two-run home run. The 24-year-old infielder appeared in 99 games with Indy in 2023 and hit .281 (106-for-377) with 75 runs, 27 doubles, eight triples and 49 RBI. He tied for the International League lead in triples while also leading the team in runs. After making his major league debut on 6/23 at Miami, Gonzales appeared in 35 big-league games with a .209 batting average (24-for-115).

**PEGGY PUNCHED IT:** Liover Peguero has joined his double-play partner, Nick Gonzales, in swinging a hot bat through the first two games of the season. With a pair of runners on in the seventh inning, Peggy roped a two-run double down the left-field line to break up Louisville's shutout bid and bring the game within one run. Veteran Jake Lamb then stepped to the plate and drove in Peguero with a two-bagger, tying the game. In his first pair of games this season, Peguero is hitting .400 (4-for-10) with a double and three RBI. He appeared in just seven games with Indianapolis, sandwiched by time in Double-A Altoona and Pittsburgh. In 59 games with the big-league club, he hit .237 (47-for-198) with four doubles, one triple, seven home runs and 26 RBI.

**LAMB CHOPS:** After launching a ninth-inning home run on Friday, Jake Lamb continued to jump on run-scoring opportunities with a game-tying RBI double to score Liover Peguero in the seventh inning yesterday. In total, Lamb went 2-for-3 with that seventh-inning RBI double and a pair of walks. The 33-year-old leads a group of veterans for the Indians after being selected as NL All-Star during his 2017 campaign with Arizona, a season that also saw him named as the NL Player of the Week for the second time of his career on 5/22 and a four-hit performance during the NL Wild Card Game vs. Colorado.

**BAD LUCK:** After playing their third March regular-season game in franchise history, the Indians are now 0-3 in the third month of the calendar year. The Indians opened their 2023 season on 3/31 vs. the Omaha Storm Chasers at Victory Field and lost, 8-6, after putting up five runs in the opening frame. Indy has a chance to nab a March win today in the series finale at Louisville.

**TODAY:** The Indians will look for their first win and avoid an early-season three-game sweep at Louisville this afternoon in a 1:05 PM ET first pitch. Last season, the Indians finished with a 13-5 record against Louisville while going 9-3 on the road. Today features another notable pitching matchup, with Indians RHP Quinn Priester (0-0, ---) taking the mound in his season debut. Countering for the Bats is Reds rehabber, LHP Nick Lodolo (0-0, ---), who began the season on the injured list with left calf tenosynovitis. In seven total Triple-A starts, Lodolo has never faced Indianapolis.

**EASTER BASKETS:** Today marks the 17th time in the Victory Field era that the Indians are playing on Easter Sunday. In those games, they own an 8-8 record after defeating the Bats at Louisville Slugger Field, 8-1, on Easter Sunday (4/9) last season. Today marks the 10th time that the Indians' Easter contest comes on the road, with a 4-5 record in those road contests.

**QUINN SPINS:** Taking the mound for Indianapolis today is the squad's 2023 Pitcher of the Year and International League postseason All-Star, RHP Quinn Priester. The 23-year-old was excellent in the International League a year ago, going 9-4 with a 4.00 ERA (48er/108.0ip) and 116 strikeouts in 22 games (20 starts). Of those marks, he ranked among league leaders in wins (T-3rd) and strikeouts (5th). He also made 10 appearances (eight starts) with the Pirates after making his major league debut on 7/17 and went 3-3 with a 7.74 ERA (43er/50.0ip) and 36 strikeouts. Against Louisville,

**THE UNTOUCHABLE MR. JONES:** The Indians 2023 ace, right-handed pitcher Jared Jones, made his MLB debut with Pittsburgh yesterday afternoon and earned the win after a dazzling performance at Miami (5.2ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 10k). Jones is the 31st pitcher in AL/NL history and the fourth in Pirates franchise history (most since Tim Wakefield in 1992) to strike out 10 in his debut. He also had 22 swings-and-misses, the most by any MLB pitcher since 1992. With Indianapolis last season, the 22-year-old Jones went 4-5 with a 4.72 ERA (43er/82.0ip) and 99 strikeouts. Indianapolis sent 12 players to Pittsburgh for their major league debuts during the 2023 season, which is tied with 2016 for the most since Indianapolis became a Pirates affiliate in 2005.

## TODAY'S PITCHER

**Quinn Priester:** Right-hander Quinn Priester is set to make his season debut today in the series finale at Louisville.

**Against the Bats:** Priester is 1-1 with a 7.24 ERA (11er/13.2ip), eight walks and 13 strikeouts in three starts at Louisville in his career. He has never faced the Bats at Victory Field.

**QUINNING:** Priester won a career-high seven consecutive decisions in Triple-A from 5/4-8/25/23, going 7-0 with a 3.04 ERA (26er/77.0ip) and 74 strikeouts over 15 games (14 starts). During that stretch, he ranked among league qualifiers in ERA (2nd), batting average against (3rd, .233), wins (T-4th) and WHIP (6th, 1.25).

**IL POSTSEASON ALL-STAR:** Priester was named to the International League postseason All-Star team following his 2023 Triple-A campaign. He went 9-4 with a 4.00 ERA (48er/108.0ip) in 22 games (22 starts) and ranked among league leaders in wins (T-3rd) and strikeouts (5th, 116). He was the sixth Indians starting pitcher to be named to the IL postseason All-Star team, joining Fritz Ackley (1963), Ben Hendrickson (2004), Zach Duke (2005), Steven Brault (2017) and Mitch Keller (2019)

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by PIT as the 18th overall pick of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft ... selected to the 2021 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game and struck out White Sox prospect Yoelqui Cespedes ... Was named the 2021 High-A East Pitcher of the Year. ... Had his contract selected by PIT on 7/17 and made his MLB debut that night vs. CLE.
