ERIC IN THE HAASE: Eric Haase's first home run of the season in 14 games played with the Sounds was a walk-off, two-run home run in the bottom of the 9th inning to give the Sounds a 6-4 win over Gwinnett on Thursday night. It was the fourth overall walk-off win of the season for Nashville and the second walk-off home run along with Bobby Dalbec's 2-run homer on July 27th vs. Charlotte, which was Nashville's last walk-off win. It was the third home run in 2025 for Haase who hit his last on May 7 vs. Houston while with the Brewers and ended a 30-game homerless drought.

ZAM-AURA: Freddy Zamora ended the night 3-for-3 and fell a triple shy of the cycle on Thursday night. His 7th-inning opposite field home run was his fourth of the season and first since August 16th on the road in Durham. Not only that, but it was also his first career home run at First Horizon Park playing in his 82nd career home game with Nashville. Each of his first three Triple-A home runs came on the road in Memphis over the last two seasons before he finally broke his Auto Zone Park streak with his home run on the road in Durham. Thursday night was his third game this season with 3+ hits and his first since June 15th on the road in Norfolk.

THATS A FIRST: Raynel Delgado made his first career Triple-A start at first base and the 18th overall in his career. He had appeared in three games this season at first base but got his first start since the 2023 season while he was with Double-A Akron in the Guardians organization. He had made 105 starts this season between the other three infield spots for the Sounds and one start in left field earlier this season.

STREAKY GOOD: Daz Cameron's leadoff walk in the bottom of the first inning Thursday night extended his current on-base streak to a team-best 14 straight games dating back to August 21. During his current streak, Cameron is hitting .226 (12-for-53) with a pair of triples and three home runs. He has drawn 12 walks during the stretch with only 13 strikeouts.

RUN AND DONE: Right-hander Easton McGee had his streak of games and innings without an earned run come to an end Wednesday night. It ends at 17.0 IP and eight games after working the first 1.2 IP Wednesday without allowing an earned run. His streak with Nashville dates back to July 24. The 17.0 IP are tied along with Tyler Jay for the second-most consecutive innings without an earned run. During his streak, he allowed seven hits with 17 strikeouts and six walks before ultimately giving up a three-run home run to Jesus Bastidas in the top of the eighth that ended the streak.

SWIPING LEFT AND RIGHT: Jared Oliva continues to move up the Sounds single-season stolen base record list, getting three more on Tuesday night to tie Tommy Barrett for the third-most in Sounds history. Sitting at 53 with 9 games remaining in the 2025 season, Oliva now trails Otis Nixon (61, 1982) for second on the Sounds all-time list. His 53 steals this season are tied for the seventh most in the International League since 1988. Tuesday night was his second time with three stolen bases in a game this year, making him the first Nashville player to have multiple 3-steal games in 2025.

FOUR LOCK-O: Brandon Lockridge has a hit in six of his first seven games with Nashville after going 4-for-5 with a double, RBI, and run scored on Wednesday night. His third-inning double was his first extra base hit since August 24 vs. San Francisco while he was with the Brewers. It was his first Triple-A extra-base hit since July 23 vs. Triple-A Sugar Land while he was with the Padres organization before being dealt to the Brewers. In his six games since joining the Sounds, Lockridge is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with a double and four walks. His run on Wednesday gave him a run in each of his first six games with Nashville and seven-straight Triple-A games overall. Wednesday night was his first four-hit game since he set a single-game career-high with five hits on September 4, 2024, and the seventh career game of 4+ hits.
