FRES-NOTES

SHUTOUT IN STOCKTON: The Fresno Grizzlies (8-3) dominated the Stockton Ports (3-8) 9-0 Friday night from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno moved to 6-0 wearing the gray jerseys and 7-0 when scoring first. This was the Grizzlies first shutout win of the 2024 season. Fresno ace Jack Mahoney (2-1) relished the victory after six sensational innings of work. Mahoney allowed two hits and one walk while fanning five. He did not allow a hit until one out into the sixth frame. At one point, Mahoney retired 12 batters in a row (2nd-6th innings). Tyler Hoffman, Stu Flesland III and Jake Madden wrapped up the final three frames, punching out a pair of batters. The Grizzlies offense supported Mahoney and the staff by supplying nine runs on a season-high 13 hits with seven walks. The top of the Fresno lineup of Braylen Wimmer, Jake Snider and Andy Perez combined to go 6-for-14 with two homers, one double, nine RBI, five runs and a pair of walks. Besides the trio of players listed above, a couple more batters enjoyed fantastic nights. Jason Hinchman reached base three times, which included a pair of hits. Ben McCabe roped two doubles, one shy of a Grizzlies franchise record. EJ Andrews Jr. mustered two walks, a stolen base and a run in the middle of the order. Tevin Tucker recorded three runs thanks to two hits and a walk. Caleb Hobson beat out an infield single and walked once in the triumph.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the first of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the first set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 64-24 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 33-7 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

COUPET GETS THE NOD: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball.

GETTING INTO THE EARLY NUMBERS: The Grizzlies' pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters in nine of their first 11 games this season (10, 5x, 11, 2x, 13 and 14). Overall, Fresno arms have fanned 111 total batters in 2024. The Grizzlies offense has walked 67 times over their last nine contests, giving them 80 base-on-balls this year (2nd in the California League, 4th in Single-A).

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has started his 2024 campaign in the best way possible. Kaminska has not allowed a run over two starts (April 7-16), spanning eight and two-thirds innings. He has permitted six hits and one walk while fanning 10 batters (0.81 WHIP, .194 batting average against him).

KING OF THE (BRADY) HILL: Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill has appeared in four games, earning two saves out of the bullpen this season. In four shutout frames, he has allowed one hit and one walk while punching out seven.

COLLIN IS BALLIN': Grizzlies RHP Collin Baumgartner has appeared in four games out of the bullpen this season. Baumgartner is 1-0 with two holds and a 0.00 ERA. In five and two-thirds shutout frames, he has allowed one hit and one walk while punching out 10.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an impressive start to the season, going 11-for-30 (.367 AVG/.592 OBP/.667 SLG/1.259 OPS, best in the California League) with one homer, one triple, four doubles, nine RBI, 15 runs, 16 walks, two hit-by-pitches and two stolen bases. Snider's triple on April 7th (Sunday) in San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all 11 games to start this season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. Perez is 16-for-49 (.327 AVG/.365 OBP/.653 SLG/1.018 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), two triples, three doubles, California League-leading 17 RBI, eight runs and three walks. Perez's triple on April 17th (Wednesday) in Stockton was his ninth in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him four triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

WIMMER IS A WINNER: Grizzlies INF Braylen Wimmer has also had a spectacular start to the season, going 14-for-44 (.318 AVG/.444 OBP/.614 SLG/1.058 OPS) with a California League-leading four homers, one double, 10 RBI, California League-best 17 runs, nine walks and two stolen bases.

EJ AND THE SB: Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' OF EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 13 bases (two this year), one in 13 different games. Fresno is 13-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with 12 of the 13 games ending within five runs.

2024 (pro): Enters 2nd professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...Can generate more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curveball...Favors his low-80s slider, which has 2-plane depth, but his mid-70s curveball is a plus pitch in its own right...Fastball sits at 89-91 MPH and tops out at 93 MPH...Also owns a sinking mid-80s changeup.
