AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley has two career starts against Durham, both this season. He took the loss in his first start of the season on April 6 at First Horizon Park, allowing four runs in 4.1 innings. He picked up the win in his only other start at Durham on June 3, tossing a season-high 102 pitches.
