WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Single-A Fredericksburg scored four times in the 10th inning last night to beat Wilson (MIL), 7-3...**CF CRISTIAN VAQUERO** drove in two on a double in the frame, his second two-base hit of the night.

SPLIT DECISION: After conquering Syracuse in game one of Thursday's doubleheader, the Rochester Plates struggled to replicate their success in a low-scoring second leg, falling in a 2-0 shutout...they are now 0-3-4 (win-loss-split) in doubleheaders this season...in the opening leg, RHP **CHANDLER CHAM-PLAIN** picked up his seventh win of the season in a seven-strikeout performance, while 2B-3B **PHILLIP GLASSER** went 2-for-3 with two runs and an RBI, alongside a two-run performance from SS **SEAUER KING**...three other Plates registered hits in the 6-1 victory...Rochester suffered its first shutout loss of the season with just three total hits in game two, 2-0...the Red Wings look to bounce back tonight and take a 3-1 series lead...RHP **LUIS PERALES** will take the ball for Rochester against Mets RHP Robert Stock...
R After winning game one, the Red Wings moved to 61-41...this was the first time the team has been at least 20 games over .500 since 8/27/2017 (77-57).

LUIS LUIS: RHP **LUIS PERALES** will take the ball for Rochester tonight in what will be his 17th start (20th app.) of the season...the Venezuela native took the loss in his last outing on 7/25 at BUF, where he allowed two earned on two hits (1 HR) across 5.0 full innings, while striking out four and walking five...across four appearances (3 GS) in July, Peralas ranks seventh among all Triple-A pitchers (min. 15.0 IP) with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP)...he also ranks eighth with a .171 BAA...
R The former Boston Red Sox farmhand is holding left-handed hitters to a .174 BAA (26-for-149) this season, sixth-best among all Triple-A pitchers with at least 75 AB vs. LHH.

KING ME: SS **SEAUER KING** picked up a multi-hit performance in his first game since he was activated off the Injured List in game one of the doubleheader last night, going 2-for-3 at the plate with two doubles...the last time he hit multiple doubles in the same outing was 5/23 at WOR...the shortstop holds a .435 batting average in six games when hitting first in the Red Wings lineup (10-for-23) with five RBI and six XBH (2 HR, 4 2B)...across the entire season with Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, the Wake Forest product leads all full-season Nationals Minor Leaguers with a .310 batting average (84-for-271), ranks second with a .901 OPS, and fourth with a .388 OBP and .513 SLG...

R King is one of 40 players in full-season MiLB with at least 250 at-bats, and a batting average of .310 or higher...he is one of 21 across Double and Triple-A.

BROKEN GLASS CEILING: 2B-3B **PHILLIP GLASSER** went 2-for-3 with an RBI, a walk, and two runs scored in game one yesterday...he is now slashing .309/.373/.366 this season, leading all Red Wings hitters in batting average (min. 10 AB)...his .482 on-base percentage ranks 11th among International League hitters (min. 50 AB)...with runners in scoring position this season, the Canton, Ohio native ranks fifth among all Triple-A hitters (min. 50 AB w/ RISP) with a .395 batting average (30-for-76) with the 12th-highest OBP (.461).

ABI-NORMAL POWER: 1B **ABIMELEC ORTIZ** comes into tonight's contest looking for his third game in a row with an extra-base hit...the Puerto Rican native went a combined 3-for-5 with two doubles and one RBI in yesterday's twin billing...the former Texas Rangers farm hand is leading all qualified Washington Nationals minor leaguers in RBI (72), 2B (25), and XBH (42)...among International League hitters this month, the lefty slugger is third in doubles with eight...

R Ortiz is slashing .433/.469/.867 with three homers and 11 driven in against the Syracuse Mets this season...his AVG (5th), SLG (7th), and OPS (5th) all rank in the top ten among Triple-A hitters that have at least 30 at-bats against Syracuse pitching since the team changed its name from the Chiefs to Mets in 2019.

COULD HE BE ANY BETTER?: RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** earned his seventh win of the season and 31st of his professional career in game one of the double header yesterday, throwing four strikeouts and allowing only three hits and one run over 5.0 innings pitched in relief...the righty ranks third WHIP (1.04), T-3rd in wins (7), fourth in innings pitched (94.0), and fifth in ERA (3.93) and BAA (.231) across all International League qualified pitchers this season...LHP **ERIK TOLMAN** and LHP **JARED SIMPSON** together let up only one hit and struck out two while pitching 1.0 innings each to wrap up the victory.

CAUGHT STREAKING: Rochester was shut out for the first time this season in game two yesterday, snapping a 133-game streak of scoring at least one run...the Red Wings had not been held scoreless since a 5-0 loss to Syracuse on 8/16/2025...102 of those 133 games came this season, the longest streak in professional baseball in 2026.

BULLY-PEN: The Red Wings bullpen combined to allow just one earned run across 11.0 full innings of both games of yesterday's doubleheader...Rochester relievers lead all Triple-A teams and rank second in Minor League Baseball behind Single-A Kannapolis (CWS, 1.83) with a 1.93 ERA (13 ER/60.2 IP) since returning from the All-Star break on 7/17...they also lead all Triple-A bullpens with 72 strikeouts, and rank fifth with a .208 BAA...RHP **ROBERT CRANZ** finished game two with a scoreless inning, extending his scoreless appearance streak to six consecutive games since 7/5...RHP **ANDRY LARA** delivered 3.0 scoreless innings earlier in the contest, his longest scoreless relief outing since game one of a doubleheader on 7/2/2025 vs. Detroit, with Washington (3.0 IP)...

R Cranz's six consecutive scoreless outings are tied for the longest active streak on the team with RHP **JACK SINCLAIR**.

Entering sixth season of professional baseball, first with Nationals after being acquired from Boston in exchange for LHP Jake Bennett on 12/15/2025...originally signed with Boston as an international free agent on 7/2/2019...earned Arizona Fall League Rising Stars honors in 2025...named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on 6/18/2023 with Single-A Salem...Earned Florida Coast League Pitcher of the Month for July and Pitcher of the Week on 7/17 with FCL Red Sox in 2022.

- Slated to make his 17th start of the season (20th app.) in tonight's game against Syracuse...the righty has a 1.83 ERA this month, the fourth lowest among Triple-A pitchers (Min. 19 IP).
- Tallied his 250th career MiLB strikeout on 5/6 at SYR...is one strikeout away from 60 total on the season.
- Missed most of the 2025 season due to Tommy John surgery...made one start with Double-A Portland (BOS) before he was transferred to Triple-A Worcester on 9/16.
- Made his Triple-A debut on 9/17 against Rochester, striking out three batters in 1.0 inning of work.
- Made nine starts in 2024 for High-A Greenville (BOS, 7) and Double-A Portland (2) in 2024, going 2-2 with a 2.94 ERA (11 ER/33.2 IP), 56 strikeouts, 12 walks, a 1.31 WHIP, .250 BAA, and only one homer allowed...averaged 14.97 K/9, the 15th-highest mark in MiLB and the highest in the Red Sox system (min. 30.0 IP).
- In final outing with Greenville on May 21 at Greensboro (PIT), allowed only one hit in 5.0 scoreless innings while matching a career high with 12 strikeouts.
- Placed on the 7-Day Injured List on 6/9...on 6/27/2024, underwent Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Jeffrey Dugas at the Andrews Sports Medicine & Orthopedics Center in Birmingham, AL.
