## **LAST GAME**

The Baysox opened their series with a shutout of the Erie SeaWolves, 5-0, on Tuesday night. The Baysox took a 1-0 lead in the second on a Donta' Williams RBI double, before a two-run home run from Max Wagner extended the lead to 3-0 in the third. On the mound, right-handed stater Connor Gillispie stranded eight base runners through his five shutout frames, collecting five strikeouts en route to the win. Bowie padded its lead late, with an RBI single from Maxwell Costes and RBI double from Jackson Holliday in the seventh, while getting two shutout frames from each of Kade Strowd and Conner Loeprich to secure the eighth shutout win of the season for the Baysox.

## **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with an overall record of 63-51 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the SeaWolves are 26-20 in the second half, already first half champions in the Southwest division. Erie has excelled in 2023, sitting second in the Eastern League in team average (.246) and home runs (141) at the plate, while holding the second-highest fielding percentage (.980), and the best ERA (3.83) amongst a starting staff. The SeaWolves' roster includes seven of the top 30 prospects in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Jace Jung (No. 4 DET/No. 71 OVR), RHP Ty Madden (No. 6 DET), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 7 DET), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 12 DET), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 21 DET) IF Danny Serretti (No. 25 DET), and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28 DET).

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Adam Wolf is set to take the ball this evening for the SeaWolves. Wolf has transitioned to the Erie starting rotation in the month of August, after working primarily as a reliever the first four months of the 2023 season. Wolf has pitched to a 3.72 ERA through three starts in August (4 ER in 9.2 IP), but has not gone deeper than four innings in any of his starts. This is Wolf's second full season with Erie, working as both a reliever and starter last season. In his career against the Baysox, Wolf sports a 4.97 ERA (7 ER in 12.2 IP), including a 2.25 ERA (2 ER in 8 IP) in four appearances this season. Wolf was originally a fifth round pick of the Tigers in 2018 out of Louisville.

## ROAD WARRIORS

After losing each of their first two six-game series on the road this season, the Baysox have won four of their last six series away from home. Overall this season, Bowie is 22-16 away from home since its 4-10 start to begin the 2023 campaign. Those 22 road wins since 5/23 are second-most in the Eastern League. The road success from the Baysox has been powered by the pitching staff, who own a 3.94 ERA away from home this season - The best of any team at the Double-A level

#### HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Holliday has posted the second-highest batting average (.343) and highest on-base percentage (.421) in the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) since his Double-A debut on 7/14. His overall on base percentage of .454 across the three levels he's played in 2023 leads all of Minor League Baseball, while his nine triples are also the second-highest total across the minor leagues. Holliday is the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

### LET HIM COOK

IF/OF Billy Cook has done it all for Bowie in 2023. Cook leads all qualified active Baysox players in games played (100), home runs (18), RBI (65), on-base percentage(.320), slugging (.456), OPS (.776), and stolen bases (26). After a 3-for-4 performance on Tuesday night, Cook is now hitting .375 (18-for-48) against Erie this season, with a team-high three home runs, seven extra-base hits, and 14 RBI against the SeaWolves. Cook is currently on-pace to produce the second 20/20 season in Baysox franchise history and the first since DJ Stewart in 2017.

## ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. After claiming one-run victories on both Saturday and Sunday, The Baysox are 14-2 in their last 16 one-run games. Bowie is 24-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the fifth-most one-run games. Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 11 of the last 17 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

## LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's picked up right where he left off with Bowie in the month of August, hitting .338 with the Baysox. After Tuesday night, Beavers has collected eight multi-hit games in his first 16 at the Double-A level. In total, Beavers has multiple hits in 11 of 18 games dating back to the end of his time with Aberdeen.

## COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Rvan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
