Entering today, **3B ANDREW FISCHER** has recorded 28 home runs between High-A Wisconsin (20) and Double-A Biloxi (8)... Fischer is currently tied for the 3rd-most home runs by a Brewers MiLB player since 2000... It marks the most home runs in a season by a Brewers MiLB player since **1B HUNTER MORRIS** (28) in 2012.

☞ Fischer is 2 home runs away from the 17th 30 home run season in Brewers Minor League history... It would mark the 3rd 30 home run season since 1990.

### BURKE BOMBS ON REPEAT

**1B BLAKE BURKE** went 4-for-5 with 2 doubles, a home run and 7 RBI on Sunday in his 1st appearance since June 27... The home run, a 480-foot blast to center, marked the longest home run hit by a Shucker this season.

☞ The 7 RBI are tied for the 3rd-most in a game in franchise history (since 2015), and the most since July 20, 2024, when **INF/OF ERIC BROWN JR.** recorded 7 against the Montgomery Biscuits.

☞ Burke needs a home run and stolen base to become the 3rd player in Shuckers franchise history 20/20 season, and the 1st since **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023.

### WOOD WOULD

**C MATTHEW WOOD** extended his hit streak to 5 consecutive games with a home run on Tuesday at Knoxville... During the streak, Wood is 11-for-20 (.550) with 2 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI.

☞ Wood enters today among the Southern League leaders in OPS (3rd, .891), on-base percentage (5th, .394), walks (7th, 44) and slugging percentage (8th, .497).

☞ Since May 1 (44g), Wood owns a .272/.409/.537 slash line, a .946 OPS, 147 wRC+ and more walks (30) than strikeouts (21).

☞ Wood's 12 home runs are tied for the 3rd-most by a Brewers Double-A catcher this century (since 2000).

### I'M A BOEVE-LIEVER

Entering today, **1B/3B/OF MIKE BOEVE** has reached base in 25 of his last 26 games, including a hit in 18 of his last 20... Since May 1, Boeve owns a .332/.394/.482 slash line with an .876 OPS, 11 doubles, 6 home runs and a 132 wRC+.

☞ Boeve enters today among the Southern League leaders in hits (T-2nd, 82), average (4th, .295) and on-base percentage (7th, .378).

☞ Boeve has already set a career-high in home runs (7) and stolen bases (10)... Boeve is 2 games shy of tying his career high of 79, set in 2024 between High-A Wisconsin and Double-A Biloxi.

### JUST JOSH-ING AROUND

**OF JOSH ADAMCZEWSKI** has reached base in all 17 games at the Double-A level since making his debut on June 17... Over that span, Adamczewski is 21-for-63 (.333) with 6 doubles, 2 home runs, 9 walks and 14 RBI.

### THE FUTURE IS NOW!

**SS JESUS MADE** has been selected for the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game on July 12 in Philadelphia... Made is set to become the 12th Shucker to appear in the event in franchise history and the first since 2023, when **OF JACKSON CHOURIO**, **C JEFFERSON QUERO** and **RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI** were selected.

### HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR

**RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI** ('23-'24) and **RHP DREW RASMUSSEN** ('19) were each selected to the 2026 MLB All-Star Game on Saturday... It marks the 19th and 20th All-Star Game selections by a former Shuckers in franchise history.

### FROM THE SHUCKERS TO THE SHOW

**OF LUIS LARA** ('25) became the 89th former Shucker to make their MLB debut, debuting on Tuesday night against the St. Louis Cardinals... Lara went 1-for-4 with a single, 2 RBI and a walk... Lara is the 6th former Shucker to make their MLB debut this season, and the 4th member of the 2025 Shuckers to achieve the feat.

### BACK IN THE SADDLE

**MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 12 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,488 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

### TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

**RHP JARON DeBERRY** (6-4, 4.24) makes his team-leading 16th start of the season... DeBerry enters today among the Southern League leaders in opponents average (3rd, .217), ERA (3rd, 4.24), strikeouts (5th, 80) and innings pitched (7th, 76.1)... Across his last 9 starts (since May 12), DeBerry owns a 3.00 ERA (18r, 54.0ip) with a 30% strikeout rate and a .194 opponents average.
