SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 4-2, in 10 innings at The Diamond. It was their second straight 10-inning game after picking up a walk-off win on Sunday night. In the top of the third, Jaylen Palmer gave Binghamton a 1-0 lead with an RBI single. Carter Howell tied the game in the bottom of the third with an RBI single. In the sixth, Matt Higgins gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with an RBI single. Alex Ramirez tied the score in the top of the eighth with a solo homer. In the 10th, Stanley Consuegra hit a go-ahead triple and scored on a groundout by Palmer to give the Rumble Ponies a 4-2 lead. Richmond failed to score in the bottom of the 10th. Will Bednar started for the Flying Squirrels and threw two hitless innings. Dylan Cumming tied his career high with nine strikeouts over six relief innings, allowing two runs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the opener of a six-game series at PNG Field. This is the first of two triples to Altoona for Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels won two-of-six at The Diamond from June 4-9, dropping the final four games of the series. The Curve also return to Richmond for a six-game set from August 20-25 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season in Altoona from September 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 4-8 in their last 12 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.75 runs per game (191 runs/51 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (212 runs/45 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-5 in their last 16 road games since June 12. Richmond is 8-17 in its last 25 home games dating back to June 6.

THE CURVE are 1-8 in their last nine games since July 19 after going 9-1 in their previous 10 games from July 3-11. Altoona's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 1), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), INF/OF Charles McAdoo (No. 12), INF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 13) and LHP Hunter Barco (No. 16). MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list includes XX Altoona players, including Chandler (No. 1), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 8), Barco (No. 13), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26) and McAdoo (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 20th start of the season and his third this year against the Curve. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Rumble Ponies and allowed three runs over 6.2 innings, striking out six, in a loss. In his last five starts dating back to July 1, Bertrand has gone 3-1 with a 1.47 ERA (5 ER/30.2 IP). Bertrand faced the Curve on June 4 and threw six scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in a win. In the finale of that series on June 9, he allowed five runs over six innings in a loss. In the Eastern League this year, Bertrand is ranked first in double plays (14), first in groundball percentage (52.4%), tied for first in games started (19), second in innings pitched (107.1), sixth in ERA (3.27), sixth in WHIP (1.17) and eighth in walk percentage (6.9%). He has also made eight scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Drake Fellows makes his 12th Double-A appearance and his first against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Fellows worked 2.2 innings and allowed five runs in a loss at Erie on Wednesday. On the year, he has pitched 19 games, including 11 starts, between High-A Greensboro, Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis. Fellows was selected by the Padres in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Vanderbilt. On January 19, 2021, he was traded to the Pirates as part of a three-team deal that sent Joe Musgrove to San Diego and David Bednar to Pittsburgh.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 69 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Altoona is ranked second with 67. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 14 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on Saturday night against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: On Friday in his second Double-A game, Diego Velasquez hit a solo home run in the fourth inning for his first Double-A hit. He finished the night with three hits, adding an RBI single in the eighth inning. In his debut on Thursday, he walked twice and added a sacrifice bunt. Between Richmond and High-A Eugene this year, Velasquez has hit. 272, which is seventh-best in the Giants organization. He is also ranked fourth in hits (77), fourth in stolen bases (18), tied for sixth in triples (6), eighth in doubles (16), ninth in SLG (.392) and 10th in OBP (.356). With his debut on Thursday, Velasquez became the sixth-youngest player in Flying Squirrels history, the ninth player to debut for Richmond at age 20 or younger and the first player in team history born in 2003. On Saturday night, he made a diving stop to begin a double play that landed at No. 3 on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 38 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .322 (49-for-152) with three homers, eight doubles, eight walks and 18 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 28 games. In his last 48 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .310 (57-for-184) with six homers, nine doubles, 14 walks and 27 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 14-of-30 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .325 (38-for-117) in that stretch.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In his eight games with Richmond this year, **Wade Meckler** has picked up 10 hits, batting .333 (10-for-30). He first reached the Flying Squirrels last season and batted .336 (50-for-149) over 39 games, which as the third-highest average in the league (min. 170 PA) for the year. He hit .371 (115-for-310) in the minors last year, which was the highest in MilLB (min. 350 PA). It was the second straight year that a Flying Squirrels player led the minors in batting average, with **Vaun Brown** topping the charts (min. 350 PA) with a .346 average in 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,653), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Three of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Wade Meckler (No. 12), RHP Eric Silva (No. 21) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Meckler is rated the best hitter for average and best strike-zone discipline and LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Meckler (No. 16), Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randon Roupg (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
