TASTE OF THEIR OWN MEDICINE: The Omaha Storm Chasers fell behind 6-0 early on Wednesday after the Louisville Bats scored six runs on seven hits in the first two innings. The Chasers could not complete a comeback and fell, 8-5, to suffer just their fourth home loss of the season. **INF Emmanuel Rivera** homered for the second straight day and **OF Kyle Isbel** added an eighth-inning solo homer while **INF Alcides Escobar** extended his hitting streak to nine games. **LHP Jake Kalish** pitched 4.1 innings in long relief, including 3.2 scoreless innings before allowing a two-run homer. **RHP Tyler Zuber**, celebrating his 26th birthday, pitched a scoreless inning in his Werner Park debut.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 26-11 (.703), the Omaha Storm Chasers have the best record in Triple-A and the third-best record in Minor League Baseball, trailing the Bowie Baysox (26-10, .722), the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, and the Tampa Tarpons (27-11, .711), the Low-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. Omaha currently leads the Triple-A East Midwest Division by 6.0 games, which is tied for the largest divisional lead in Minor League Baseball with fellow Royals affiliate Quad Cities, which leads the High-A Central West by 6.0 games.

HOME RUN HEROES: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 75 home runs (37 games), averaging just over two home runs per game. Omaha has recorded 18 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, four five-homer games, and one seven-homer game (6/13 @ STP). The seven-homer game on 6/13 @ STP was a modern franchise record (2011-present). Omaha has recorded at least one home run in 24 of its last 26 games, including a 13-game homer streak from 5/16-6/1. **INF Ryan McBroom** currently leads the league with 12 home runs while **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** is second with 11 and **INF Gabriel Cancel** and **INF Emmanuel Rivera** are tied for third in the league with 10. Omaha is the only team in Minor League Baseball with four players with 10+ home runs.

OFFENSIVE ONSLAUGHT: Omaha recorded 14 hits on Tuesday to record a third straight game with 10+ hits. The Chasers have 17 games with 10+ hits through 37 games, including one 15-hit game and one 21-hit game. Omaha's .277 average leads Triple-A East and is tied for fourth in Minor League Baseball while the team's .514 slugging percentage leads Triple-A East and is third in MiLB. Omaha is also first in Triple-A East and third in MiLB in hits (351).

ELECTRIC ESKY: **INF Alcides Escobar** went 2-for-4 with two home runs on Tuesday to bring his season total to five home runs. It was his second career multi-homer game and first since July 14, 2012 when he hit two home runs with Kansas City against Chicago (AL). His five home runs with Omaha are five shy of his career high of 10 in 2019 with Triple-A Charlotte. Escobar's Major League career-best is seven in 2016. Since his 2-for-23 start in his first eight games, Escobar is batting .419/.455/.758 with six doubles, five home runs, and 13 RBIs in 16 games. Among Triple-A East players with a minimum of 90 plate appearances, Escobar ranks fourth in the league in AVG (.329) and eighth in slugging percentage (.588). He's batting .324 (12-for-37) with two home runs during an eight-game hitting streak.

RYAN ON A RAMPAGE: **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn**, who went 4-for-5 with a home run in Tuesday's series opener, was named Triple-A East Player of the Week on Monday after hitting .429 (9-for-21) with five home runs, nine RBIs, a .478 OBP and a 1.190 SLG in five games against St. Paul. O'Hearn recorded back-to-back multi-homer games on June 9 and 10, becoming the first Chasers to do so since **Brett Hayes** on Aug. 21 and 22, 2013, vs. New Orleans. The first of O'Hearn's five home runs came against RHP Kenta Maeda, who was making a rehab start, on Wednesday, and the second came in the eighth inning on Wednesday to help lift Omaha to a 5-2 win. He homered in back-to-back at-bats on Thursday to help Omaha to a 10-2 lead through two innings in an eventual 16-9 win, ultimately going 4-for-5 with two home runs and six RBIs. His final home run came in his first at-bat on Friday, giving him four homers in a six at-bat span. Since joining the Chasers on May 28, O'Hearn is batting .393 (24-for-61) with 11 home runs and 24 RBIs, reaching base safely in 14 of 15 games and hitting safely in 13 of 15.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Jakob Junis** makes his second start for Omaha this season and his first at Werner Park since Aug. 1, 2017, when he threw 6.0 innings of one-run ball against Fresno. He was named Omaha Pitcher of the Year in 2017 after posting a 2.92 ERA in 71.0 innings. Junis threw 2.1 innings in his last start on 6/12 @ STP, allowing three runs (one earned) on three hits while striking out four and walking none. The right-hander began the year with Kansas City, posting a 5.19 ERA in 15 appearances (five starts) with 35 strikeouts and 11 walks in 34.2 innings. He recorded a 4.37 ERA in 22.2 innings as a starter and a 6.75 ERA in 12.0 innings as a reliever. Junis made four consecutive starts from Apr. 7-27 before moving to the bullpen and pitching in relief of LHP Daniel Lynch in his Major League debut on May 3

FOR LOUISVILLE: **RHP Hunter Greene** makes his Triple-A debut with Louisville after going 5-0 with a 1.98 ERA in seven starts (all quality starts) with Double-A Chattanooga. In 41.0 innings, Greene struck out 60 and walked 14. The No. 5 prospect (and top pitching prospect) in the Reds organization and the No. 60 prospect in baseball according to *Baseball America*, Greene was the No. 2 overall pick in the 2017 MLB Draft out of high school in California.

JUNIS CAREER NOTES

- Began season with Kansas City, posting a 5.19 ERA in 15 appearances (five starts) with 35 strikeouts and 11 walks in 34.2 innings
- Recorded a 4.37 ERA in 22.2 innings as a starters (five starts) and a 6.75 ERA in 12.0 innings (12 appearances) as a reliever
- Began the 2020 season on the Injured List and made his season debut in the team's 10th game, ultimately making eight appearances (six starts) between two stints on the Injured List
- His final two appearances of 2020 were relief appearances, throwing a pair of scoreless innings on 9/23 vs. STL and 9/25 vs. DET
- Made a career-high 31 starts in 2019 and matched a career best with 164 strikeouts (also 2018), a mark that led the Royals
- Of his 164 strikeouts, over 70% came on his slider (115), the fourth-most strikeouts on sliders in the Major Leagues, trailing Patrick Corbin (161), Justin Verlander (127), and Matthew Boyd (118)
- Allowed 31 home runs in 31 starts, tied for sixth-most in the American League and one shy of his career high (2018)
- Had a career-high 10 strikeouts on 7/15 vs. CWS, all on his slider, to become the fourth pitcher in the Statcast era (2015-pres.) to strike out at least 10 batters with a slider in a single game (Jon Gray, Francisco Liriano, Chris Archer)
- Made his first Opening Day roster in 2018, eventually leading the Royals in starts (30), innings (177.0), and strikeouts (164)
- Named Royals Pitcher of the Month for August of 2017, his rookie year, by posting a 2.96 ERA in 27.1 innings that was tops among American League rookies (min. four starts)
- Posted a 2.92 ERA in 71.0 innings with Triple-A Omaha in 2017, earning Omaha Pitcher of the Year honors
- Named Northwest Arkansas Pitcher of the Year in 2016, ranking third in the Texas League with a 3.25 ERA in 119.0 innings
- Led the Carolina League in innings (155.2) and was second in strikeouts (123) with High-A Wilmington in 2015
- Bypassed a scholarship to NC State to sign with the Royals after being drafted out of Rock Falls High School (Ill.)
- Earned all-state honors in baseball and basketball as a senior in high school
