CARDINALS SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER IN TULSA FRIDAY NIGHT: The

Cardinals won two on Friday night in Tulsa, 9-4 and 7-4 over the Drillers at ONEOK Field. Edwin Nuñez set a new career high with 4.0 shutout innings in his game one start, while Nathan Church and Matt Lloyd both homered. Jeremy Rivas got the Cards on the board with a two-out, two-run double in the 2nd innning. In game two, the Cardinals jumped ahead with a four-run inning, and Rivas broke a 4-4 tie with a two-run single in the 3rd inning. Max Rajcic got the win for Springfield allowing 4 ER in 5.1 IP, but retiring 11 of the final 12 batters he faced to finish his outing.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals! **CARPENTER JOINS SPRINGFIELD FOR WEEKEND:** Cardinals INF **Matt Carpenter** joins Springfield for the weekend in a rehab appearance on his way back to the big leagues. **Carpenter** suffered a strained right oblique in early April, and went 3-for-10 in 3 games with St. Louis to start the season. The veteran played in 105 games with Springfield in 2010, batting .316 with 12 HR and 53 RBIs and 26 doubles. In 14 major league seasons, **Carpenter** has compiled 1,228 hits and 175 HR in 1,455 games.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 25 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in 15 of them. Of those 15 games, the Cards have won nine, making them 9-6 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, despite Springfield's opponent scoring first in 11 of 12 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals hold an 8-4 record at home this season.

BIRDS BDAST BEST DOUBLE-A OFFENSE: Despite being shut out for the first time this season and only managing three hits on Wednesday, Springfield's lineup still sits atop the Double-A level in several offensive categories. Through 25 games the Cardinals lead the three Double-A leagues with a .273 batting average; the Birmingham Barons are next at .265. The Cards also lead the the entire level in runs scored (148), hits (225) and RBIs (137). Springfield is tied for 2nd in OBP (.361) and 4th in OPS (.753). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with 15 sacrifice flies this season, three more than any other team in Double-A.

The Cardinals have reached double-digit hits in 8 of their 25 games so far, and have 8 or more knocks in 19 games.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats and put the ball in play. The Cardinals have struck out just 179 times in 25 games, the 2nd-fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals trail only the Spokane Indians (162 K's) for fewest whiffs in the minor leagues. The Indians, however, have played four fewer games than the Cardinals (21). The Birds are averaging just 7.2 K's per game.

STAFF LODKING TO GET BACK ON TRACK: Since the Cardinals' franchise-record nine-game winning streak to start the season, Springfield has struggled to prevent runs the way they did at the outset. Over their last 16 games since April 16, the Cards have a 6.24 ERA, the highest mark in the Texas League by nearly a run (Amarillo Sod Poodles, 5.25). Springfield's WHIP (1.63) and opponents batting average (.275) are also last in the league since that time. Additionally, the 21 home runs the Redbirds have allowed over their last 16 games is most in the circuit during that time. The Birds have allowed 31 long-balls this season, tied for the highest total in the league with the Sod Poodles.

Over their first nine games, Springfield's staff sported a 2.88 ERA, the 2nd-best mark in the league during that time. The Cardinals are 8-8 since starting the season 9-0.

TORRES A TERROR: Springfield leadoff man **Bryan Torres** has set the tone atop the Cardinals potent lineup, ranking among the leaders in the Texas League in 5 offensive categories: batting average (5th; .351), OBP (5th; .435), hits (t6th; 27), doubles (t7th; 7), and stolen bases (t2nd; 10). **Torres** has put up impressive numbers despite missing three games with a left thumb injury.

YEAGER BOMBS: Cardinals infielder **RJ Yeager** has been a top run producer for Springifeld this season, leading the club and ranking top-10 in the Texas League in home runs (5th; 5), RBIs (t3rd; 19), and total bases (42)

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Despite having a 13-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday afternoon, Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** ranks in the top-5 among qualified hitters in the Texas League in 4 different categories: RBIs (t1st; 21), hits (t2nd; 33), total bases (4th; 50), and runs (t4th; 19). **Church** has hit safely in 21 of his 23 games played and has struck out just 7 times in 109 plate appearances (6.4%).

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning last Tuesday against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 205.
