**BEC LAUNCHES HOME RUN LATE, BUT 'CATS FALL JUST SHORT:** Chris Bec hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth, his first of the season, but the Fisher Cats fell to Reading by one run for the second straight game. New Hampshire scored four runs in the third inning, but then surrendered five unanswered runs. Vinny Capra continued his hot streak, driving home two with a double in the third, and Chris Bec had his third straight multi-hit game. Mike Ellenbest, Graham Spraker, and Fitz Stadler all worked in relief of Reilly Hovis, but each relief pitcher gave up at least one run. Hovis went five innings, giving up two runs on three hits and striking out a season-high five.

**VINNY CAPRA NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** During the Fisher Cats' 4-2 road series win over the Hartford Yard Goats last week at Dunkin' Donuts Park, Capra hit .455 with two home runs, three doubles, two triples, nine RBI, and a blistering 1.584 OPS in six games. Capra is hitting .372 on the season with an OPS of 1.093, and his six home runs on the year is already a career high. His BABIP is an even .500. Capra becomes the second Fisher Cat to pick up a weekly award following Gabriel Moreno, who also picked up the player of the week award following a series with Hartford back in June.

**UP NEXT:** The Fisher Cats and Reading meet for the first time in 2021 this week. Next week, the Fisher Cats will meet Portland for games 23-28 in the season series with the Sea Dogs at Hadlock Field.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** July 22, 2014—In a stellar start from Scott Copeland, the Fisher Cats shut out Trenton 3-0 at Delta Dental Stadium. Copeland went eight scoreless, allowing just three singles. He walked one and struck out four for his sixth win. Gregory Infante worked the ninth for his 14<sup>th</sup> save. The Fisher Cats put together a Jon Berti walk, and Andy Burns single, and a Kevin Nolan single for the first run in the sixth. Burns and Nolan would single ahead of a two-run Sean Ochinko double in the eighth for the other runs.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays fell 7-4 to the Red Sox in their final game in Buffalo despite Vlad Guerrero Jr.'s 32<sup>nd</sup> homer. Cullen Large and Nash Knight had doubles for the Bisons...Vancouver fell 6-3 to Everett...Dunedin handled Lakeland 11-2 with two more homers from Orelvis Martinez...Phillies over the FCL Jays 7-3

## STARTERS:

Major League veteran Johnny Barbato will take the mound this evening. Barbato, who throws a four-seam fastball, a cutter, a slurve, and a changeup, is coming off of a 5.1 inning performance against the Yard Goats. Last series, Barbato picked up his first win, going one inning in relief after his previous start had been rained out. Barbato has transitioned nicely into the starter's role this season with the Fisher Cats, making the last three of New Hampshire's quality starts.

For Reading, Jack Perkins will get the start. A 23-year old out of Stetson, Perkins will be making his eighth start at the Double-A level since his promotion from advanced-A Jersey Shore back in June. Perkins played for the Ocean State Waves (NECBL) and the Chatham Anglers (CCBL) during his time in college. Last time out, Perkins gave up nine hits and five runs (all earned) against the Sea Dogs, picking up his first and only loss of the season.
