LAST OUTING: Rodriguez finished with a no-decision against Charlotte on May 24. He had eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings and allowed three earned runs in his third consecutive quality start.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's second career start against Memphis. His first came on April 12 where he allowed six earned runs across 5.1 innings in a loss.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Was Nashville's Opening Day starter at Toledo on March 29...took loss
- Earned first win of season on April 28 at Louisville (5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 6 BB, 1 K)...was just the fourth time a Sounds starter earned the win despite walking six since 2005 and the first since Johnny Hellweg on May 16, 2013 at Salt Lake
- Struck out nine in his best outing at the Triple-A level on May 4 vs. Norfolk
