FROM THE CROW'S NEST

GONE FISHIN': With their win in Game 1 of Friday's doubleheader, the Marauders clinched the head-to-head season series against the first-place Tarpons. Bradenton is 7-3 against Tampa this season and is on track to face the Tarpons in the best-of-five league championship series.

CLEAR THE DECK: The Marauders and Tarpons have combined for 21 home runs through four games in the series (Tampa 11, Bradenton 10). Tampa leads the league with 137 home runs and a .464 SLG, while the Marauders rank third with 97 home runs and a .393 SLG.

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodriguez went 0-for-3 in the first game of Friday's doubleheader, ending a 9-game hit streak. During the streak, he hit .438 with 13 RBI. Since the beginning of July (43 games), Rodriguez is batting .321 with a .421 OBP, .535 SLG, and a .956 OPS. He is currently second in the league with 91 hits (Jupiter's Victor Mesa Jr. leads with 101 hits).

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Jackson Glenn has reached base safely in each of his first 16 games at Low-A, batting .412 with a .523 OBP. The Pirates' fifth-round draft pick out of Dallas Baptist has hit safely in 15 of the 16 games, and has walked 13 times while striking out just 8 times.

MAGIC WANDI: Right-hander Wandi Montout turned in an effective month of August out of the Marauders bullpen, posting a 1.69 ERA while holding opponents to a .205 batting average in 7 appearances. The 24-year-old from the Dominican Republic has allowed an earned run in just 2 of his last 10 appearances, stretching back to July 23 at St. Lucie.

THE OPPONENT: The Tarpons are coming off a 4-games-to-3 series loss in Clearwater. Tampa has held sole or partial possession of first place in the West Division for the entire season, with the Marauders last tying for first place on July 1. The Tarpons are 36-22 on the road and own Minor League Baseball's second-best run differential at +228 (the Charleston River-Dogs lead at +236).

TOP PROSPECTS: Per midseason ranking updates, the Marauders roster currently includes four prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#15), **Endy Rodriguez** (#19), and **Maikol Escotto** (#20). Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the Joe Musgrove trade in January, while Escotto was one of four prospects obtained from the Yankees in the Jameson Taillon trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 1,138 strikeouts are 6th in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,277)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +95 (Tampa's +228 is second in all of MiLB)... Eight Marauders players rank within the league's top 10 in home runs: **Jase Bowen** and **Hudson Head** (14 HR, T-2nd), **Endy Rodriguez** (12 HR, T-3rd), **Jack Herman** (11 HR, T-4th), **Daniel Lopez** and **Sammy Siani** (8 HR, T-7th, and **Maikol Escotto** and **Alexander Mojica** (7 HR, T-8th).
