SECOND HALF STARTS WITH 20-HIT ROUGHRIDERS WIN:

Behind a season-high 20 hits, the Frisco RoughRiders dropped the Amarillo Sod Poodles 7-3 to start the second half on Tuesday night from HODGETOWN. After neither team scored in the first three innings, Frisco (1-0, 40-29) found the scoreboard in the fourth with two runs against Amarillo (0-1, 36-33) starter Daniel Eagen (2-1), thanks to RBIs from **Marcus Lee Sang** and **Frainyer Chavez**. In the fifth inning, **Malcolm Moore** hammered his first career Double-A home run to make it 3-0. Then, Chavez and **Rafe Perich** both blasted two-run shots in the sixth to extend the lead to 7-0. Following six scoreless innings, Frisco starter **Aidan Curry** took the mound in the seventh and, despite allowing his first three runs, set his career high in innings for a second consecutive start, covering 6.2 innings for the Riders. Curry surrendered just four hits and struck out five. Up 7-3, **Anthony Susac** and **Cole Stasio** combined to close out the win with scoreless relief work.

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on Thursday, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567), their 8th-best winning percentage in franchise history and their best since 2024 (.647).

CHAVEZ IN CHARGE:

RoughRiders infielder **Frainyer Chavez** has been on fire at the plate. In his 29 games, he is hitting .355 (38-for-107)/.473/.579/1.052 with 12 doubles, 4 home runs, 17 RBIs, 23 walks, 16 strikeouts and 25 runs scored. He hit his third leadoff home run of the season in game two of the doubleheader on June 17th. He now has his new career high with 9 home runs and did so in 33 fewer games that he hit 8 in 2025. Chavez is 8th in the Texas League in batting average (.288), 7th in OBP (.402), 3rd in hits (74), 3rd in doubles (18), 3rd in walks (46), T-6th in extra-base hits (27) and 2nd in runs scored (56).

THOSE OTHER PRAIRIE DOGS:

The Riders return to HODGETOWN for their second and final trip of season after going 3-3 in Amarillo in April. In their first 7 games, the Riders are hitting .345 (91-for-264)/.432/.614/1.046 with 17 home runs while averaging 8.7 runs per game. Since 2019 when Amarillo entered the league, the Riders have played more games than another other visiting team. In their 90 contests at Amarillo, the Riders are averaging 6.5 runs per game and 1.8 home runs per game. On the mound, Frisco also has the best ERA of any team (5.42 ERA).

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been great lately and is now 2nd in Double-A with a 3.68 ERA and 1st in the Texas League. Over the last 24 games, the Riders have the best bullpen ERA in the Texas League (2.79). Last week in San Antonio, Frisco threw 24.2 innings from the arm barn, allowing just eight runs (2.92ERA). In the last 13 games, the starters have also dominated, going 4-2 with a 3.49 ERA, the second-best ERA in the Texas League.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had an incredibly clutch introduction to his new team, homering 6 times in his first 22 games with the RoughRiders. All of but one of his 6 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including a game-tying home run in the 9th and a walk-off home run in the 9th. His 17 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization. Between High-A Hub City and Frisco, he won May Texas Rangers Player of the Month, hitting .327/.427/.714/1.141 with 11 home runs and 32 RBIs.

ONE-RUN MADNESS LATE:

The RoughRiders are just 9-12 in one-run games this year. Out of the 12 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 6 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 3 of the 12 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen. The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (153 runs) and the 2nd-best team in Double-A in ERA in the 7th inning or later (3.41).

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

Frisco's 56 runs in the first inning this year are 5th in the minors, hitting .283 (77-for-272) in the first with 13 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 27 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 14 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 18-28 (including a combined 8-10 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 22-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 16-16 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 69 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 628 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.270) and 2nd in runs (433, 6.3 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 44 percent of their games (30-of-69). The Riders are 5th in the Texas League in homers (86), 1st in doubles (126), 3rd in SLG (.442) and 2nd in OPS (.807).

ABOUT BLAKE

-Australian native pitched for Team Australia in both the 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classics. In 2023, he threw 1.0 scoreless inning before tossing two scoreless outings (2.1 innings) in 2026, including inducing a lineup to right field from Shohei Ohtani.

-Before the WBC, he was a member of the Australian National Team at the U-15 baseball World Cup in Iwaki, Japan in 2016.

-Pitched for the U-18 Australian Team against extended Spring Training Major League teams in 2018, leading to his signing by the Mariners on June 19th, 2018.

-After seven years with the Mariners, he was released in August of 2024 and signed by the Pirates, where he pitched for 2025 as well after resigning in the offseason.

-He elected free agency following 2025 and signed with the Rangers on January 23rd, 2026.

2026 SEASON

-Enters the season in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-On May 13th at Midland, threw 7.1 shutout innings, his longest outing of his career. He became the second RoughRiders starter has recorded an in the 8th since 2018 (Nick Krauth on 9/10/23: 7.1 IP).

-Between May 13th and 20th, threw first two quality starts of his career, 0.68 ERA (1ER/13.1IP). Between May 13th and June 10th, went 3-0 with a 1.48 ERA (4ER/24.1IP) with just 2 BB/16K. Held opp to .193 BA.

2025 SEASON

-Among MiLB pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, he was 4th in the minors with a 1.76 ERA.

-Had just a 0.97 ERA through his first 28 games (six starts), allowing earned runs in just six of those outings.

-In his last 9G/6GS, went 1-2 with a 3.62 ERA.

2024 SEASON

-Pitched between Seattle and Pittsburgh organizations.

-2.35 ERA on the season over 38.1 IP was 84th in all of MiLB among relievers (0 starts) with at least 30.0 IP.

2023 SEASON

-All 35 games were in relief in 2023 for Low-A Modesto, finishing fifth on the team in appearances.

-Held opponents to a .221/.324/.293/.617 slashline

2022 SEASON

-Split time between four levels, including two games in Triple-A Tacoma, striking out 37 batters in 29.1 innings.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

PITCHING COACH

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

BENCH COACH

Pronounced "George"

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

DEVELOPMENT COACH

JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

ATHLETIC TRAINER



KILEY BROWN

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).
