SPRINGDALE, AR – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals won in walk-off fashion for the third time this season, as **Diego Hernández** drove home **Jake Means** in the bottom of the ninth inning for a 9-8 victory over the San Antonio Missions.

- Tyler Gentry** singled home a run in the first, then a two-run double from **CJ Alexander** capped a four-run second inning. Alexander added another run in the fourth, as he drew a bases-loaded walk that knocked former Naturals pitcher **Nolan Watson** out of the game, as the Missions' starter loaded the bases and couldn't get an out in the fourth ... **Robbie Glendinning** drove in a run with a sacrifice fly in the fourth to stretch the lead to 7-0, but the game was far from over.
- The Missions tagged Naturals starter **Andrew Hoffmann** for five runs in the fifth inning, though just two were earned. Hoffman cruised through four scoreless innings to start, finishing the night with three strikeouts over 5.0 frames ... San Antonio added another unearned run in the sixth off reliever **Zach Haake**, who allowed just that unearned run over 2.2 innings, pitching into the eighth with two strikeouts.
- John Rave** added an insurance run in the eighth with a home run, his second of the week and 13th this season with the Naturals, a solo shot that proved to be crucial insurance in making the score 8-6.
- San Antonio scored twice to tie the game in the top of the ninth on the third Northwest Arkansas error of the night, as right-hander **Kasey Kalich** was unable to secure a four-out save.
- Means led off the bottom of the ninth with a walk, advanced to second on a wild pitch then was moved to third on a sacrifice bunt by **Angelo Castellano**. After **Tucker Bradley** was intentionally walked, Hernández chopped a ball to the Naturals' second baseman and Means scored ahead of the throw for 9-8 win, snapping a seven-game losing streak.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 7-5 all-time when playing on August 20

On August 20, 2013, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals 21-6 at Hammons Field, both the most runs the team has ever scored in one game and tied for the largest margin of victory in a game in franchise history ... the Naturals scored three runs in the 1st, six in the 6th, five in the 8th and seven in the 9th and collectively clubbed four home runs, while left fielder **Lane Adams** drove in six runs and five total players had two or more RBI ... in the eighth inning, **Cheslor Cuthbert** pinch-hit for shortstop **Orlando Calixte** and connected on a three-run home run, just the second pinch-hit homer in Naturals history.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 13 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 4 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Jake Means and John Rave.**

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 35-9, while when scoring six runs or less, just 10-58.
- The Naturals are 31-15 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 14-51.
- The Naturals are 42-14 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-52 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 29-21, whereas 16-45 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 6-17 in one-run games this season, meaning 17 of their 66 losses (25.76%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 22 losses this season (including 13 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 111 games, the Naturals have stolen 141 bases in 177 attempts (average 1.27 steals/game, 79.66% success rate).

- 141 steals is second in the Texas League, ranks eighth in Double-A and tied 33rd in the Minors.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 73 of 111 games this season (65.77%), including 35 games with two or more steals ... the team stole a season-high six bases on July 6 vs. Tulsa with a pair of five-steal games as well this season.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 17 times, meaning 34 of 141 steals this year (24.11%) have come on a double-steal.
- Naturals players have stolen multiple bases in a game 14 times, SIX of those occasions being Garcia ... **Tucker Bradley** had the first three-steal game of the season (and of his career) on July 9 vs. Tulsa.
- Maikel Garcia's** 27 steals (in 30 attempts) still ranks fifth in the Texas League, **Nick Loftin's** 24 (in 27 attempts) ranks eighth in the league.

TUCK(ER) AND ROLL

Naturals outfielder **Tucker Bradley** has been consistent from the start of the season and established himself as one of the team's most reliable hitters.

- Bradley has reached base at least once in 78 of 96 games played this season (81.25%) and reached base multiple times on a team-best 50 occasions ... he has hits in 68 of 96 games and has a team-best 30 multi-hit games, as well as 14 multi-run games and nine multi-RBI games.
- Bradley's .301 batting average leagues qualified Naturals hitters and ranks ninth in the Texas League ... his .301 average and .383 on-base percentage ranks third among Kansas City's minor league hitters, as do his 105 hits and 22 doubles, while his 154 total bases rank seventh, 60 runs scored are tied seventh, a .824 OPS is ninth and a .441 slugging percentage is 10th.
- The Georgia native has hit first in the order 28 games this year, which ranks second behind Maikel Garcia (76) ... when hitting first, Bradley is a .298 hitter (34-for-114) with a .394 on-base percentage and .806 OPS ... when leading off innings, he hits .305 (29-for-95) with a .389 on-base percentage.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder **Tyler Gentry** has been one of the best hitters in the Kansas City Royals' system this season, with an incredible impact since joining the Naturals in June.

- Among qualified full-season Minor League hitters, Gentry ranks FIFTH in batting average (.329)* when you combine his stats between Northwest Arkansas and Quad Cities (A+).
- He is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.329), slugging percentage (.548) and OPS (.977), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.429) ... his 17 home runs between the River Bandits and Naturals are tied third in the system, while 64 runs batted in are sixth.
- Gentry has reached base in 44 of 49 games (89.80%) and has hits in 34 of his 49 games with the Naturals, with already 19 multi-hit games.
- In 49 games since his call-up to Double-A on June 14, Gentry is batting .324 (59-for-182) with nine doubles, 12 home runs and 41 runs batted in, with a .997 OPS ... he's driven in at least one run in 23 of 49 games, with 10 multi-RBI games.
- Gentry leads the Naturals in nearly every category since joining the team, with the highest average (.324), most total bases (104), most home runs (12) and most runs batted in on the team (41) ... 997 OPS is third in the Texas League since he joined the league, his 41 RBIs are tied for the third-most, 104 total bases are fifth and 12 homers rank tied fifth since his arrival in the circuit.
- His 18-game on-base streak between June 26 and July 17 is the longest for a Naturals player this season ... in that span, he hit .382 (26-for-68) with 10 extra-base hits and 12 walks, with an on-base percentage of .459 in that span.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has quickly heated up at the plate since joining the Naturals in a trade last month from Atlanta.

- Over 27 games with the Naturals, the corner infielder is hitting .259 (29-for-112) with 13 extra-base hits (eight home runs) and 30 runs batted in, with 19 runs scored as well.
- He has hits in 17 of 27 games with the Naturals, 11 of which are multi-hit performances, while he's driven in runs in 11 of 27 games, including already EIGHT multi-RBI games.
- Over 14 games in the month of August, Alexander is hitting .305 (18-for-59) with seven home runs and 22 runs batted in ... *seven homers, 19 RBI and 42 total bases all lead the Texas League this month ... among full-season Minor League hitters, he ranks tied second in August in home runs, third in runs batted in and tied 11th in RBI.*
- CJ homered in four straight games against Tulsa, August 3 to 6 ... he is the third Natural this season and just the sixth all-time to homer in four consecutive games.
- Alexander began his Naturals tenure 0-for-12 over his first three games, then homered on July 16 @ Corpus Christi for his first hit with the team and went 4-for-10 in his next two games.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman **Robbie Glendinning** has returned to form, with a hot stretch that has carried through July into August.

- Glendinning's 67 runs batted in this season rank fifth in the Texas League, while 67 runs scored are tied for the eighth-most in the league.
- He has reached base in 85 of 95 games played this season (89.47%), reaching multiple times in 45 games this season ... he has hits in 62 of 95 games, including 26 multi-hit games this season.
- Among Royals minor league hitters, Glendinning ranks as one of the top hitters in nearly every category ... he is tied second in the system with 67 runs batted in, third with 37 extra-base hits and 67 runs scored, tied third in the system with 17 home runs, fourth with 164 total bases and tied fourth with 53 walks ... his .836 OPS ranks as the sixth-best in the organization, while a .467 slugging percentage is seventh in the organization, and his .369 on-base percentage and .262 batting average both rank ninth in the system.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
- June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry** ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (4)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
- June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
- July 25 to July 31: LHP Dante Biasi** ... threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 27 @ Wichita in an eventual 5-0 shutout win ... held the Wind Surge to just one hit and three walks while striking out five, on 79 pitches, his second straight scoreless start.
