These are the only meetings between the two teams this season; Cedar Rapids won the first two games by a combined 22-10 score, the Lugnuts took the next two by a combined 12-1 score, and the Kernels struck back for a 10-6 victory last night.

Last Night: Kernels 10, Lugnuts 6. Cedar Rapids built an early 4-0 lead, watched the Lugnuts score five runs in the fourth inning, and rallied back for the Saturday night win in front of 7,477. First baseman Kevin Maitan went 4-for-5 with a go-ahead three-run double in the fifth inning, leading a 14-hit attack, while Lansing third baseman Colby Halter went 3-for-4 in a 12-hit barrage for the Lugnuts in the loss.

On Father's Day in 2017, the ceremonial first pitch was delivered by Vladimir Guerrero, Sr. to son Vladdy Jr.

Postseason Update: Last night, the Lake County Captains walked off the Fort Wayne TinCaps in 10 innings, 2-1, to clinch the first half East Division title. A Cedar Rapids loss today or Wisconsin win today would give the Timber Rattlers the West title. Following Thursday's slate of games, every Midwest League team's record will reset to 0-0 for the 66-game second half, with a second playoff berth up for the earning.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.262), runs scored (337), base hits (543), total bases (843), doubles (112), triples (28), RBIs (309), slugging percentage (.406) and OPS (.759), ranking 2nd in on-base percentage (.353) to Lake County (.354).

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 25), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 28) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 30).

History: Jake Garland (5 innings), Grant Judkins (2 2/3 innings) and Colton Johnson (1 1/3 innings) tossed the 4th no-hitter in franchise history on Thursday, June 13, blanking Cedar Rapids, 8-0, the first no-hitter in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of Dayton in which **Donnie Hood** hit for the cycle, the first time ever a team had thrown a no-hitter and hit for the cycle.

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher Grant Holman fired another scoreless inning last night for Triple-A Las Vegas, giving him 25 1/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, the most for any pitcher in all of Minor League Baseball.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Jason Leblebijian homered twice and Richard Ureña and Chris Carlson homered once apiece, as the Lugnuts destroyed Bowling Green, 13-3, at Cooley Law School Stadium. With five games left in the first half, the Lugs broke a first-place tie and took a one-game lead on the Hot Rods. Anthony Alford went 4-for-5 with a double and a triple, and Starlyn Suriel pitched six shutout innings.

2017: Bo Bichette singled, doubled, homered and singled. Then he singled, doubled, struck out and singled again. Eight at-bats, seven hits, five runs batted in, all in a doubleheader's worth of excitement at South Bend, swept by the Lugnuts 8-5 and 6-1. In the process, Bichette brought his batting average up to an even .400. Game 1 included a wacky five-run sixth inning that brought the Nuts from 5-3 down, taking the lead on a fluke Nick Sinay RBI single — Sinay did not swing the bat, but Jared Cheek's fastball smacked off the knob and rebounded into play, bringing in Christian Williams with the tie-breaking run.
