SIX-RUN FOURTH SPURS VICTORY

Maximo Acosta's home run highlighted a six-run fourth inning on Tuesday that led Jacksonville to a 6-2 win at Nashville. The Sounds scored in their first at-bats and took that 1-0 advantage into the fourth. Shane Sasaki's RBI single knotted the score at one before Tony Bullard gave the Jumbo Shrimp the lead with a sacrifice fly. Acosta bashed a three-run home run, and later in the inning, Devvison De Los Santos notched an RBI single to make it 6-1. Ethan Murray collected an RBI base hit for the Sounds in the bottom of the fourth, but they could get no closer.

24K MAGIC

The Jumbo Shrimp have now won seven of their last eight contests heading into play on Wednesday, pushing their overall record to 66-42. Thus, Jacksonville has climbed 24 games over .500 for the first time since the 2009 Jacksonville Suns closed out that campaign with an 82-58 record. Should the club win Wednesday's contest at Nashville, Jacksonville would rise to 25 games over .500 for the first time since August 23, 2007, when the Jacksonville Suns were 77-52.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 69 round-trippers over the last 45 games since June 10, tied for the most in Triple-A (Reno) during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 31 of these 45 games, a rate of 68.9 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 216 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank sixth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 20 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 211, 8th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 216 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 108 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 418.0 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the third-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.72 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 522.1, or 55.5 percent, of the club's 940.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the third-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.64) and BAA (.212). Over the last 13 games, the club's bullpen has worked 67.1 innings (5.2 per game), yielding only 20 runs, 19 earned, on 38 hits (5.1 H/9) for a 2.53 ERA. They have combined to strike out 81 (10.8 K/9) against 20 walks (2.7 BB/9). During this stretch, a Jumbo Shrimp starter has worked 2.0 innings or fewer four times, including three 1.0-inning stints, and Jacksonville has won each contest.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games this year. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 60 games, Berry has nearly drawn more walks (28) than strikeouts (31) while going 56-for-189 (.296/.390/.476/.866) at the plate with 14 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 31 RBIs and 31 runs scored.

SHRIMP BITES

Ryan Gusto started Tuesday's contest for Jacksonville, becoming the club's 28th different starting pitcher this season, which matches the franchise record... The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 44-22 (.667) in games decided by three runs or fewer, the most such wins in Triple-A. In one-run affairs, Jacksonville is 23-9, matching Indianapolis and Montgomery for the most victories in one-run games in Mil.B... Maximo Acosta has three homers and 10 RBIs in his last seven games.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2025 SEASON

-Monteverde made his major league debut on April 19 for the Marlins in a game at the Philadelphia Phillies. He pitched 3.2 innings, striking out four.

2024 SEASON

-Held left-handed batters to a .247/.286/.425/.711 line in 158 plate appearances. However, right-handed hitters slashed .264/.340/.508/.848 against him in 335 plate appearances

-With the bases empty, opponents had a .227/.288/.433/.721 batting line against Monteverde. However, with runners on, that swelled to .314/.383/.566/.949.

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw.

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
