TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque claimed the series and second half opener last night with an 8-4 triumph ... The Isotopes have won three of the last four games against Salt Lake in Albuquerque Karl Kauffmann is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Davis Daniel is expected to start for the Bees

SERIES OPENERS: Albuquerque claimed its second-straight series opening victory last night, third on the year and first at home. The club hadn't won two-straight series openers since Aug. 22 and 29, 2023, at OKC (9-6) and at SAC (5-0).

DUBS: The Isotopes have won four of their last five contests and nine of 12

DINGERS: Albuquerque belted two dingers last night and have homered in 12-straight games (23 during stretch), the longest streak since June 6-18, 2023 (12).

STOLEN BASES: The Isotopes swiped four bags last night, the fifth time in 2024 the club has stolen at least four bags (high: six, May 8 at El Paso) and most since June 1 vs. Oklahoma Čity (also four).

NOW THAT'S QUALITY: Noah Davis tossed the club's eighth quality start of the season yesterday and second in three games (other: Tanner Gordon, June 22 at Oklahoma City). His eight strikeouts are tied for the second-most by an Isotopes starter, one off his season and the team-high (April 14 vs. Sugar Land).

OPENING FRAME: The Isotopes plated five runs in the first inning yesterday, the second-highest total of the season (most: seven, April 20 vs. El Paso).

XBH: The Isotopes tallied just two extra-base hits last night, the 21st time being held to two or fewer. However, the club won their first game in 2024 recording two or fewer extra-base hits.

KEEPIN' IT 100: For the year, the Isotopes have tallied 102 home runs and 104 stole bases. No other MiLB or MLB team has reached triple digits in both categories yet in 2024.

BY WAY OF THE K: Last night, the Isotopes pitching staff fanned 12 batters, the sixth time in 2024 with at least 12 and three shy of the season-high (April 12 vs. Sugar Land) ... Offensively, despite scoring eight runs, the Isotopes struck out 12 times. The club has tallied double-digit strikeouts in four of their last six games.

OPPOSING STARTER: Reid Detmers fanned 10 Isotopes over 6.0 innings last night, tied for the second-most by an opposing starter (most: Oklahoma City's Ryan Wrobleski, 11, June 22). MR. JONES: Greg Jones tallied two hits last night for his sixth multi-hit contest of the year and third-straight. Over his last three games since his demotion from Colorado, he is 6-for-13 with a homer, one RBI and four runs scored. Recorded two steals for the sixth time in 2024 (last: June 1 vs. Oklahoma City).

GRANNY: Grant Lavigne belted his 11th homer of the year last night and fourth since June 18. Recorded his second homer off a lefty. Tallied his second three RBI game of the year, a seasonhigh (also: May 7 at El Paso).

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo smacked his ninth homer of the year yesterday and second in three games. Has an RBI in three-straight games for the fourth time in 2024.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk recorded two singles yesterday for his 23rd multi-hit contest of the year and his eighth in June. Has a hit in five of his last six games (8x23) ... His 24 doubles are 3rd-most in all of MiLB.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall extended his hitting streak to eight games Sunday with a 2-for-4 afternoon, including an RBI single in the sixth inning. Stovall is 13-for-32 with four doubles, two homers and seven RBI during the stretch. ... Is the third-longest active streak in the PCL.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron has a hit in four-straight games all with just one hit ... Is 4-for-17 with just one homer and two RBI Has a hit in eight of his last nine contests with three multi-hit games.

JC: Julio Carreras ended a three-game hitless streak last night with a single ... Swiped his 20th bag of the season last Wednesday, establishing a new career high.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver tallied his 13th multi-hit game of the season last night with two singles ... Has four multi-hit efforts since June 12 (nine games).

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 7th in average (.305) ... Aaron Schunk is 2nd in doubles (24), T-8th in XBH (33) and 10th in hits (80) ... Julio Carreras is 6th in SB (20).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in triples (35), and total bases (1,275), 2nd in hits (740), slugging (.477) average (.277), 3rd in OPS (.834) and 7th in runs (446).

ERROR 404: Julio Carreras has 14th miscues on the season while teammate Grant Lavigne (16) has the most errors of any Triple-A players.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
