Today is the opener in a seven-game, six-day series between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Dayton Dragons, including a Grand Slam School Day doubleheader tomorrow. The Nuts and Dragons opened the season against one another, splitting the first two games before the scheduled finale was postponed.

¡Vamos Locos! It's the second of 11 Copa de la Diversión games for the Lansing Locos, an identity dating back to 2019 and chosen to reflect the fans' rallying cry of "Let's Go Nuts!" with ¡Vamos Locos! The logo features the potoo bird, or "ghost bird." The Lugnuts play as the Locos every home Tuesday on Tacos & Tallboys. New this year: pink sleeves on the gem-blue uniforms.

Last Game, Sunday: River Bandits 9, Lugnuts 5. Lansing wiped out a 4-0 deficit with a five-run rally in the top of the sixth, only to see Quad Cities rally for five unanswered runs in the Sunday afternoon finale. The Bandits won four of six games in the series, handing Lansing a second consecutive series loss.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has No. 8 (Devin Taylor), No. 16 (Steven Echavarria), No. 19 (Zane Taylor), No. 26 (Nate Nankil) and No. 30 (Bobby Boser) on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects.

Transactions: Entering this series, Lansing infielder Jared Sprague-Lott and outfielder Gavin Turley were assigned to Single-A Stockton, replaced by infielder Ali Camarillo (from Stockton) and outfielder Pedro Pineda (from the Arizona Complex League).

Comeback Nuts: The Lugnuts rallied from ninth-inning deficits last Wednesday (tying the game at 5-5 on a Davis Diaz two-out, two-strike RBI single), Friday (scoring six runs to turn a 5-1 deficit into a 7-6 win) and Saturday (tying the game at 1-1 before ultimately falling in 10 innings), then erased a 4-0 deficit on Sunday.

Going Deep: Lansing's starting rotation has tossed the most innings in the Midwest League (93 2/3, averaging 4 2/3 innings per start). Last week, Jackson Finley and Steven Echavarria tossed back-to-back quality starts of 6-IP, 3-R. Individually, Kyle Robinson ranks 5th in the Midwest League in ERA (2.84), 5th in innings pitched (19.0) and 5th in WHIP (1.11). Steven Echavarria ranks 4th in lowest batting average allowed (.171) and 4th in innings (19 1/3). Zane Taylor is 4th in ERA (1.96).

All Aboard: Shortstop Bobby Boser has reached base in 18 straight games (20 hits, 12 walks and four HBPs). Davis Diaz has reached base in 16 straight games (20 hits, 15 walks, one HBP).

Milestone Watch: Lansing is nine wins away from the 2,000 in Lugnuts history and 3 players away from 1,000 players all-time.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Miller Time: The most dominant former Lugnut in the Majors is untouchable Padres closer / 2022 Lugnut Mason Miller... but Mason had his 35 2/3-inning scoreless streak stopped yesterday, giving up two runs on three hits in an inning in a 9-7 win over the Cubs. Of his 37 appearances since joining the Padres, 35 have been scoreless – not including his four scoreless innings in the WBC for Team USA.

Major League Nut: The 201st Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues, 2023 Lugnuts catcher Daniel Susac, has opened his career batting .478 (11-for-23) with two doubles and a triple through 11 games with the Giants. Debuting on April 1, Susac hit safely in his first five at-bats, setting a new Giants modern-day franchise record and coming up one shy of the Major League modern-day franchise record set by Boston OF Ted Cox in 1977. Susac was taken in the Rule 5 Draft by Minnesota and traded to San Francisco.

APRIL 28TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: Brad Mills struck out 11 Quad Cities River Bandits in just 4 2/3 innings, but Justin Roberson capped a two-run rally in the bottom of the 9th with a game-winning RBI single, pushing the Bandits to a 4-3 victory. It was the second straight game that the Lugnuts had been walked off. The game was played at Veteran Memorial Stadium in Cedar Rapids due to flooding in Davenport, with the next two games held in Clinton and Iowa City.

2011: During warm-ups before the start of the third inning in Game 2 of a doubleheader Lugnuts 3B Bryson Namba, taking grounders, got into a fight with Whitecaps pitcher Bruce Rondon, in the dugout. Both players were ejected. The Lugnuts swept, 4-0 and 4-2.

2024: Jonny Butler led off the bottom of the tenth inning with a game-winning two-run homer off Easton Sikorski, launching the Nuts to a 10-9 walkoff win over Dayton.
