FROM THE CROWS NEST

 $\textbf{GROUND BALL MACHINE: RHP Carlson Reed} \ \text{takes on the hill on Thursday night against Dunedin. Entering Thursday, Reed owns the best GB% (54.9) among all Pittsburgh Pirates Minor Leaguers (min. 30 IP) and sits fifth-best in the FSL.$

FLYING AROUND: On Wednesday night, the Marauders stole a season-high bases against the Dunedin Blue Jays. So far in the first two games of this week's series, Bradenton is a perfect 9-for-9 in stolen base attempts, the most in MiLB during this span. The Fort Myers Mighty Mussels and Jupiter Hammerheads sit in a close second with eight stolen bases.

TUESDAY'S ARE FOR SERGIO: Over the past two Tuesday's games, Marauders **OF Sergio Campana** has been on a tear. On 5/14 @ Tampa, Campana recorded a season-high three hits, going 3-for-4 with two stolen bases. He followed that up with a 2-for-4 night with a double and his first HR of the season on Tuesday against Dunedin.

CHECKMATE: Over the last four games, **OF Braylon Bishop** has been a tough out at the plate. The Marauders outfielder 7-for-15 with two doubles, a triple, one HR, six RBIs, and four runs scored. Bishop played in just four games before being placed on the injured list on April 12. He was activated last Monday and played in two games during last week's series. The home run on Tuesday was Bishop's first since 8/21/23 against the FCL Rays.

HEATING UP: Esmerlyn Valdez 19-game on-base streak came to an end on Tuesday against Dunedin. During the streak, Valdez hit .246/.372/.446 with four doubles, three home runs, 14 RBIs, eight walks, and 12 runs scored. Jesus Castillo previously owned the longest on-base streak by a Marauder this year when he reached base safely in his first 15 games of the season. It is the longest streak in the FSL, now tied with Jean Joseph (DUN). Lonnie White Jr held the longest streak by a Marauder last season after reaching in 29 straight from 7/18 - 9/1.

THE AX MAN: In his Single-A debut on Friday, **C Axiel Plaz** went 2-for-4 with a solo-home run in the seventh inning. The 18-year-old followed that up by clubbing a 454-foot home run on Saturday night, the longest ball hit by any player in the FSL this season. For the second straight night, Plaz had the hardest hit ball in the FSL at 112.5 MPH. The Marauders catcher was listed as the Pirates' No. 28 prospect by Baseball America last season.

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders clubbed two more home runs on Tueday night against Dunedin to bring their team total up to a 15 home runs in 19 games durign the month of May, tied for the most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with the Fredericksburg Nationals (WAS) hitting 18 longballs in 19 games this month.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturdays loss against Tampa marked their 17th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 9-8 record in those games with 29 of their first 41 (70.7%) games having been decided by three runs or less.

Last Time Out: In his most efficient outing of the year, Reed tossed a career-high six frames where he allowed just one run on a solo-home run from Jackson Castillo with two outs in the fourth inning. He induced six groundouts including a pair of double play balls. He became just the second Marauders pitcher, joining Michael Kennedy, to have thrown six innings in a start this season.

2024 Highlights:

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.
- Struck out a career-high eight vs DAY (4/20)
- •In a career-high six innings, allowed just one run in a 3-1 win vs Tampa (5/16)...also needed just 69 pitches in his outing. Became second Marauder this season, joining Michael Kennedy, to toss six innings.
- •Enters start on 5/23 with the best GB% in the Pirates org. and fifth-best in the FSL among pitchers who at least 30.0 innings thrown.

Personal:

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America...moved up to No. 25 in May re-rankings
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan.
- •Inspiration to become a pitcher came from older players such as Satchel Paige. Read a few books about him growing up and took an interest.
- · Grew up playing the saxophone.
