Naturals Ride to Series win in Frisco

SPRINGDALE, AR — After a starting pitching duel for the first six innings, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals forced extra innings with the Amarillo Sod Poodles, but a late rally in the bottom of the 11th came up short, as the Sod Poodles took the series opener, 6-5 on Tuesday afternoon at Arvest Ballpark.

- Northwest Arkansas starter Drew Parrish pitched 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit without a walk while striking out six, going toe-to-toe with Amarillo starter Drey Jamison.
- The Sod Poodles struck reliever **Stephen Woods Jr.** for a run in the seventh and led 1-0 going into the bottom of the ninth. Down to their final out, the Naturals rallied and sent four straight to the plate with two outs, with **Sebastian Rivero** doubling in **Michael Massey** to tie the score at 1-1 and force extras.
- Massey was a bright spot in the order for the Naturals, going 3-for-5 at the plate, with a two-out double in the ninth that kickstarted the rally ... left fielder **John Rave** also found success at the plate, going 2-for-3 with a double and two walks, reaching base in four of his five plate appearances.
- Zach Willeman pitched scoreless ninth and 10th innings for the Naturals, but the Naturals left the winning run on third base for the second straight inning and send the game to the 11th.
- Placed runner Nick Loftin scored on a sac fly from Rivero to bring the Naturals within four. Seuly Matias was hit by a pitch before Rivero drove in the run, then Rave drew a walk to bring Robbie Glendinning to the plate, who blasted a three-run homer to left field and bring the Naturals within a run.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 8-4 all-time when playing on April 27

On April 27, 2008, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off for the first time in franchise history, a 6-5 win over the Arkansas Travelers in 13 innings at Arvest Ballpark. Down 5-4 with one out in the bottom of the ninth, Jose Duarte singled home Ovandy Suero to tie the game. Two batters later, Adam Donachie was thrown out at home trying to score the winning run on ground ball to first base. After scoreless 10th, 11th and 12th nnings, the Travs scored a run in the top of the 13th and the Naturals responded with two in the bottom half to win it, as Angel Sanchez drove home Suero and Juan Richardson singled in Donachie to win the game

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Ándres Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder **Seuly Matias**.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP **Drew Parrish** started yesterday and will go again Sunday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP **Anthony Veneziano** starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** starts tomorrow for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- RHP Alec Marsh stars Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball. No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

Toolsy Team

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 15 games, the Naturals have stolen 25 bases in 28 attempts (average 1.56 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 5 times*.

- 25 steals ranks third in the Texas League, while a 89,29% success rate on steals is 15th out of 120 Minor League teams and 8th among teams with at least 20 successful steals and fourth in Double-A.
- Maikel Garcia's seven steals ranks tied for third in the league.

Gar-see ya on Base

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and has drawn four walks across in his last three games, is second in the Texas League with 14 walks.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 67 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 28 times, for a .418 on-base percentage (14 hits + 14 walks).
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied for third in walks (14) and tied 3rd in steals (7).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia has gone hitless in his last four games and is 0 for his last 17 at the plate, with four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped nearly 100 points.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- The native of Perth, Western Australia has reached base in all 13 games he's played started the season, hitting .286 (12-for-42) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs and 12 walks, giving him a .455 on-base percentage.
- Glendinning is the ONLY Natural that has reached base in every game played this season, his 13-game on-base streak is tied with Maikel Garcia for the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth in the Texas League.
- Among nine qualified Naturals hitter, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in batting average (.286), on-base percentage (.455), slugging percentage (.548) and OPS (1.003), while ranking tied for the team lead with 11 runs batted in, is second in runs scored (12) and third in walks (12)... his .471 OBP ranks tied sixth in the Texas League.

My Name is Del Ro

Right-hander **Yefri Del Rosario** has pitched 11.1 scoreless innings across four appearances to begin the season, the last Naturals pitcher that is yet to allow a run this year.

- Across four relief appearances, Del Rosario has thrown 11.1 scoreless innings, on 9 hits and 5 walks, with eight strikeouts.
- 11.1 innings is far and away the longest scoreless streak among all Double-A pitchers so far this season, the next closest being two players with 9.2 scoreless innings ... with that, it is also the longest in the Texas League this season, the next closest being three players tied with 8.2 innings.
- Only one Naturals pitcher has gotten through the end of April having not surrendered a run, Blaine Hardy in 2010, when the lefty pitched in 6 April games and threw 15.0 scoreless innings on 7 hits allowed with 8 strikeouts.
- The last pitcher to go through all of April and not allow an earned run in more than 10.0 innings is Blake Johnson in 2011, when the righty threw 16.2 innings across 7 April games and surrendered one unearned run on 11 hits with 14 strikeouts.

#6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).
- Núñez played for parts of 12 seasons in the Majors with the Pirates (1997-2004), Cardinals (2005), Phillies (2006-2007) and Mets (2008). #27 CHRISTIAN COLON - Assistant HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.

- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
