AMAYA POWERS SHRIMP TO 3-2 WIN

Jacob Amaya smashed two home runs and Chi Chi González worked 7.0 shutout innings Tuesday to lead Jacksonville to a 3-2 win over Nashville. Jerar Encarnacion and Amaya socked back-to-back shots in the second for the game's first runs, and Amaya added another solo homer in the fourth to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 3-2 lead. The Sounds finally got on the board in the eighth with a pair of runs on RBI doubles by Sal Frelick and Abraham Toro, but Will Stewart locked down the ninth for his first career save.

THE SOUND(S) OF MUSIC

After owning the Nashville Sounds in 2021 with a 5-1 record, the Jumbo Shrimp struggled in 2022 against the eventual IL West Champs. In 18 contests last season, Jacksonville finished six games below .500, winning just six total affairs for a .333 winning percentage. Nashville owned Jumbo Shrimp pitching, slashing .303/.373/.451/.824 with 42 XBHs (21 2B, 1 3B, 20 HR). Of the 10 International League teams the Jumbo Shrimp matched up against in 2022, the pitching staff owned the second-worst ERA (5.52) against Nashville

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through 11 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 18-for-48, slashing a robust .375/.404/.708/1.112 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 RBIs and seven runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for fifth in the International League in RBIs, seventh in batting average, 10th in slugging, tied for 11th in home runs, 13th in OPS and tied for 13th in hits. The Houston, Texas native has hits in six consecutive games entering play on Wednesday.

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in eight of their last nine games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 19 runs, 17 earned, on 43 hits in 46.2 innings for a 3.28 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registered just 32 punchouts (6.2 K/9). However, they have only issued 11 walks during this run, a rate of 2.1 per nine innings.

BYF-BYF BURDICK

Coming into 2023, **Peyton Burdick** hadn't recorded a multihomer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season, and his seven on the season lead the International League. Burdick is also tied for second in the IL in extra-base hits (12), tied for third in hits (21), tied for fifth in both RBIs (15) and runs scored (15), seventh in slugging (.754), eighth in OPS (1.166) and 22nd in batting average (.344). Heading into play on Wednesday, Burdick has a hit in 14 consecutive games, the longest such streak in the circuit.

LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on April 14, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. Still though, over their 15 games played, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats 10 times. Jacksonville has scored first over their opponent in nine of their 15 games thus far in 2023, going 7-2 (.778) when doing so. Conversely, the club has struggled when falling behind, going just 1-5 (.167). The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times during the 2022 season (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

In 13 of the club's 15 contests thus far in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have had their leadoff man reach base to start the game. Of those 13 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Nine of those 13 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits. Of those other four leadoff baserunners, three were via walks and one on an error.

ABOUT SEAN

-Native of Seaford N.Y., Nolin has pitched in 18 Major League games, including 12 starts with the Toronto Blue Jays, Washington Nationals and Oakland Athletics. He owns a career record of 1-5 with a 5.74 ERA in 58.0 Major League innings.

-Nolin was drafted three times. The Milwaukee Brewers picked him in the 50th round of the 2008 draft out of Seaford High School in New York. He opted to attend San Jacinto College, and following his first season there, he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 48th round of the 2009 draft. He decided to return to San Jacinto again and was picked by the Toronto Blue Jays in the sixth round of the 2010 draft. He then signed with the Blue Jays, beginning his professional career.

-Nolin made his Major League debut on May 24, 2013 for the Blue Jays in a game against the Baltimore Orioles at the Rogers Centre. He pitched 1.1 innings in a 10-6 leas

-When Nolan piched in South Korea, he collobarted with the oringzation Free Korean Dogs to help spread awareness about the dog and cat meat trade.

-Growing up on Long Island, Nolin was a fan of the New York Yankees and his favorite pitcher was Andy Pettitte, who he modled his game after.

2023 SEASON

-Nolin was trasnfered to Jacksonville from the FCL Marlins on April 18th. He made his Jacksonville debut the next day against Nashville at 121 Financial Ballpark.

2022 SEASON

-Nolin made 21 starts for the Kia Tigers, posting an 8-8 record and 2.47 ERA with 108 strikeouts in 124.0 innings pitched.

2021 SEASON

- -On August 11, 2021, the Nationals selected Nolin's contract, marking his first appearance in MLB in six years.
- -Nolin made 10 appearances for the Nationals, going 0-2 with a 4.39 ERA and 20 strikeouts.
