Today's Game: The Sounds take on the Stripers in game two of the series this afternoon at Coolray Field. Gwinnett took the first game, 13-9, thanks to a plethora of runs late in the contest. Right-hander Taylor Clarke gets the start for Nashville. Allan Winans will be on the bump for the Braves affiliate.

Taylor Clarke: The 31-year-old makes his eighth appearance and sixth start on the season. Clarke is 1-0 with a 2.95 ERA (18.1 IP/6 ER) to start his career in the Brewers organization. He last pitched on June 7 vs. Louisville, allowing three runs (all earned) on three hits with five strikeouts in 4.1 innings. Through his first two starts, Clarke was used as an opener before appearing out of the bullpen twice. He's since being "stretched out" with the intention of becoming a traditional starting pitcher. Clarke was acquired by Milwaukee in a trade that sent former Sound shortstop Cam Devanney and right-hander Ryan Brady to Kansas City on December 14, 2023. He pitched a couple seasons (2022-23) with the Royals and three seasons (2019-21) with Arizona, going 15-15 with a 5.03 ERA (279.1 IP/156 ER) in 183 games (22 starts) in the big leagues. The right-hander was originally drafted by the Diamondbacks in the third round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

Allan Winans: The 28-year-old makes his 10th start of the season with Gwinnett. He's 3-3 with a 3.86 ERA (46.2 IP/20 ER) with the Stripers. Winans took home the International League Pitcher of the Week award after striking out eight and allowing just one hit over six scoreless innings on June 5 at Durham. Despite his terrific outing, the Bulls would score five runs in the eighth inning to win 5-3. Winans was one of the pitchers named an International League Postseason All-Star after going 9-4 with a 2.85 ERA in 23 appearances (17 starts) with Gwinnett a season ago. He's also made seven starts with Atlanta, going 1-3 with a 6.03 ERA since making his Major League debut last season. The right-hander out of Campbell University was originally drafted by the Mets in the 17th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

Paint it Black: Tyler Black was back in the lineup last night and contributed a couple of doubles and RBI in the leadoff spot. The Canadian has a seven-game hitting streak, his longest of the season. Black is batting .333 (11-for-33) with four doubles, 13 RBI and seven runs scored since the streak began on May 31 at Memphis.

So You're Saying...There's a Chance: With both the Sounds and Omaha losing last night, Nashville remains nine games back from the league leaders with 11 games remaining in the first half. The Storm Chasers currently hold a 3.5-game lead over second place Syracuse in the first half standings. The first half winner will host the International League Championship Series.

I.C. What You Mean: Outfielder Isaac Collins added two hits with an RBI hit by pitch in last night's loss. He's hit safely and recorded an RBI in each of the last seven games, going 12-for-26 with three doubles, 11 RBI and five runs scored. He has the longest active RBI streak in the league at seven games. It's also tied for the longest all season with Heston Kjerstad's seven-game streak from May 16-23. The former Creighton University Bluejay ranks among International League leaders in doubles (2nd, 18), runs (T-3rd, 43) and extra-base hits (T-5th, 27) on the season.

C-Rod to the Show: Last night, Carlos Rodríguez had his contract selected by Milwaukee and will make his Major League debut tonight vs. Toronto. He becomes the 12th Nicaraguan to play in the big leagues and the first Nicaraguan native to play for Milwaukee. Rodríguez becomes the seventh Nashville Sound to make his Major League debut with Milwaukee in 2024, joining the likes of Jackson Chourio, Tobias Myers, Tyler Black, Robert Gasser, Chris Roller and James Meeke. The right-hander is 4-5 with a 5.17 ERA (62.2 IP/36 ER) in 12 appearances (11 starts) with Nashville this season and went 4-1 with a 3.38 ERA (40.0 IP/15 ER) across his last seven starts.

Mejía Mashing: Francisco Mejía stayed hot at the plate on Sunday, going 3-for-4 with a home run and four RBI. Mejía has the longest active hitting streak by a Sound at seven games. The switch hitter is batting .464 (13-for-28) with a double, four home runs, 10 RBI, seven runs and a 1.444 OPS since the streak began on May 31.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 717-613 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,309-2,133 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

- Earned second-career MLB save on April 28 at Chicago-AL with a scoreless ninth...was the first player in MLB history to record each of his first two saves against each Chicago teams

- Was a Southern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017 with Jackson and a 2016 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in the Diamondbacks organization
