SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES STARTING OFF HOT: RHP James Meeker tossed a career-high five shutout innings during Tuesday's series opener against

the Blue Wahoos... His performance continued a streak of 11 shutout innings from the Shuckers' rotation, started by RHP

RIGHT BACK AT HOME: For today's starter, RHP Carlos Rodriguez, today marks his first start in the state of Florida since

the opening game of the 2023 World Baseball Classic against Puerto Rico on March 11 at Loan Depot Park in Miami... He

allowed one run over four innings and struck out three, including former all-star INF Javier Baez... Today marks his first regular season start in Florida since April 7, 2021 with Florida SouthWestern State College against Polk State College...

T.J. Shook on Monday... Over that span, the pair combined to allow three hits, no walks and strike out 13.

After being born in Nicaragua, Rodriguez graduated from Miami Christian High School in 2020.

Today marks RHP Carlos Rodriguez's second start in his home state since being

drafted in 2021.

HOTTER THAN THE SURFACE OF THE SUN: C Jeferson Quero enters today with an eight-game hit streak and a 15-game on-
base streak His hit streak is currently one away from tying his career-high, while his on-base streak is a new career-
best Over his eight-game hit streak, the catcher has gone 15-30 (.500) with three home runs, six RBI and five walks
Over his 15-game on-base streak, which dates back to June 11, he's raised his average from .258 to .294, a 36-point
increase He also has a 12% strikeout rate over that span, six percent lower than his season average.

HE JUST KEEPS HITTING: Entering today, INF Freddy Zamora is one game shy of tying his career-long hit streak, set during the 2021 season... He enters today with a nine-game hit streak dating back to June 23... Over that span, he has tallied four multi-hit games, going 14-33 (.424) at the plate... He has also smashed three doubles and a home run while drawing five walks over that span.

AWARD-WINNING PERFORMANCES: C/INF Wes Clarke was named the Brewers' Minor League Co-Player of the Month for June... Clarke became the third Shuckers player in 2023 to be honored by the Brewers' organization... In June, Clarke had a .404 on-base percentage, a .453 slugging percentage and drew 21 walks in 21 games... He also led the Brewers' organization in June in RBI (19), was tied for the lead in walks (21) and was second in home runs (5).

OFF TO SEATTLE: On Monday, June 26, C Jeferson Quero and INF Jackson Chourio were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ [4-2, 3.09]: RHP Carlos Rodriguez will make his 15th start of the year and third against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos... In his last start, Rodriguez became the second Southern League pitcher to reach 90 strikeouts in 2023, striking out seven over 4.1 innings... The Florida native has dominated against left-handed batters in 2023, limiting them to a .163 average and a 28% strikeout rate... Left-handed hitters' .163 average against Rodriguez is the seventh-lowest against any pitcher in Minor League Baseball.
