LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox split Saturday's doubleheader against Hartford by taking game one 5-4, before falling 9-0 in game two. Bowie snatched the lead late in game one after Silas Ardoin ripped a go-ahead RBI double into the wind in right off Hartford right-hander Jaden Hill to score Jud Fabian and give Bowie a 5-4 win. Right-hander Dylan Heid threw 2.2 innings of scoreless relief and southpaw Trey McGough collected the final three outs to slam the door shut in game one for Bowie. Game two did not go the way of the Baysox from the get-go. Right-handed starter Ryan Long allowed nine hits through 3.2 innings, including a pair of home runs. In total, the Yard Goats tallied nine runs on 15 hits in Saturday's game two. Offensively, the Baysox were kept quiet in game two, managing just three hits in the contest.

A GLANCE AT THE GOATS

The Hartford Yard Goats are coming off a 57-76 campaign in 2023, finishing last overall in the Northeast division. The Baysox took two of three from the Yard Goats at Dunkin' Park to open last season in the only meeting between the two teams. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, Hartford is led by first-year skipper Bobby Meacham. The Yard Goats roster includes four of the Rockies' top-six prospects, per MLB Pipeline - 2B Adael Amador (No. 1 COL), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 COL), IF/OF Sterlin Thompson (No. 5 COL), and OF Zac Veen (No. 6 COL).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jarrod Cande gets the ball in the series finale for Hartford. Cande makes his second start of the season and of the series after making his Double-A debut on Tuesday vs Bowie. The 24-year-old threw 4.0 innings and gave up four hits, two runs, one walk and struck out two in a no-decision. The Tampa, Fla. native spent all of last year in High-A Spokane where he struck out 109 batters in 105.1 innings to a 3.25 ERA. Cande played collegiately at Santa Fe College and Florida Southern.

FREDDY IS READY

INF Frederick Bencosme has impressed in his first few games at the Double-A level. The Orioles No. 27 prospect smacked his first Double-A homer in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader, a three-run shot in the second inning. In his first seven games at Double-A, Bencosme is batting .320 (8-for-25) with a double, homer, six RBI, and two stolen bases with only three strikeouts. The 21-year-old middle infielder is a native of Moca in the Dominican Republic.

WAY OF THE K

The Baysox pitching staff is second in the Eastern League in strikeouts through the first few games of the season, with 83 of them through eight games. The Baysox have accumulated double-digit strikeout totals in six of the eight games this season, with relievers totaling a league-high 50 punchouts.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers is off to a solid start in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect owns the longest active hitting streak on the team at six consecutive games, which is good for a tie for second in the league. The 2022 O's first rounder won Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month in August 2023 for his debut month at the Double-A level, after hitting .337 with a .443 OBP. The outfielder's .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

FAMILIAR FACES

The Baysox have a couple individuals returning close to home this week. Both IF TT Bowens and first-year manager Roberto Mercado are Connecticut natives. Before joining the Orioles' organization in 2022, Mercado coached for 17 seasons at New Britain High School and led them to three conference championships, while also serving as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He currently resides in the offseason with his family in the Dunkin' Park area. Bowens is a New London native and played four years collegiately at Central Connecticut State, winning a pair of conference championships, before signing with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent, following the shortened 2020 draft.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26. Struck out five over four scoreless innings against Erie on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Acquired by the Orioles from the Athletics organization on 1/26/23 in a trade where Cole Irvin also joined Baltimore in exchange for SS Darelle Hernaiz. 2022: Led the A's organization in strikeouts and had the second-most starts and innings. Became primarily a starter in the A's organization, splitting time between Single-A Stockton and High-A Lansing. Started 15 games for Stockton and pitched across 86.2 innings to a 4.78 ERA. After getting called up to Lansing on 7/26/22, had a stronger finish to the season, pitching to a 4.31 ERA across 7 starts and holding opponents to a .236 average. 2021: Allowed 6 ER through 16 innings for Lansing in his debut season. The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

A familiar face in Bowie, Facticeau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facticeau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
