game series vs. the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Miami Marlins) at 121 Financial Park. It is the 10th of 24 meetings between the two clubs this season, and the 10th of 12 games the Stripers will play in Jacksonville.

VS. JACKSONVILLE: Following last night's win, Gwinnett is 3-6 (.333) all-time in the state of Florida. The Stripers went 1-5 (.167) on their first trip to Jacksonville from 4/19-24, 2022, and were outscored 35-19 in that series (only win was on 4/23, 10-8 in 10 innings). Entering this week, the Stripers were 1-2-0 in three series all-time vs. Jacksonville.

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager last night, improving to 100-86 (.538) in 186 games at Gwinnett's helm since 2021. He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 wins from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 wins from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 wins from 2017-19).

EXTRA, EXTRA: Ryan Casteel tallied a season-high three RBI last night (2-for-4, 2-run 2B, solo HR). Of his 12 hits this season, eight have been for extra bases (2 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR). Career with Gwinnett, 22 of his 47 hits (46.8%) over 84 games have been XBH (8 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR).

STIFLING STARTERS: Including last night's spot start by Nolan Kingham (ND, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 7 SO), Stripers' starting pitchers (Kingham, Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa) are 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10 ER in 53.1 IP, 34 H, 15 BB, 58 SO) and five quality starts over the last nine games (team is 5-4).

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 595 in 57 games (10.44 SO per game). That's 16 more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 579 SO in 57G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (2nd, 73), Huascar Ynoa (T-12th, 49) and Touki Toussaint (T-16th, 48) all rank in the IL top 20 in strikeouts.

MULLDOZING: Wednesday night, Kyle Muller became the first Stripers pitcher to record consecutive quality starts this season, logging 6.0 innings (6 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 9 SO) in a no-decision. He is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER in 13.0 IP), .213 BAA, and 17 strikeouts over two starts in June, including a season-high 7.0-inning effort in a win on 6/2 vs. Louisville (4 H. 1 ER. 1 BB. 8 SO in 5-3 victory).

- IL Leaderboard: He currently ranks among the IL top 15 in strikeouts (2nd, 73), ERA (5th, 3.09), innings (T-8th, 55.1), BAA (12th, .239), and WHIP (13th, 1.27).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 8-7 with a 3.27 ERA (49 ER in 135.0 IP), .230 BAA, and 166 strikeouts (11.07 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 27 starts.

RISING WATERS: Drew Waters tallied his second four-hit game of the season on Tuesday (4-for-5, HR, 2 R, RBI), his first since his 2022 Stripers debut on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (4-for-4, leadoff HR, 2 R, 2 RBI). The switch-hitting Waters is batting .268 (26-for-97, 5 2B, 3 HR, 15 R, 8 RBI, 1 SB) in 25 games overall, including .471 (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.176 OPS) vs. LHP and .159 (1 2B, 2 HR, .467 OPS) vs. RHP.

• GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, he is batting .250 (152-for-608, 32 2B, 1 3B, 16 HR, 102 R, 56 RBI, 32 SB, 711 OPS) in 154 games.

TONIGHT: The Gwinnett Stripers play game four of a six-27 games since 5/1, batting .324 (33-for-102, 9 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 15 RBI, .910 OPS) in that stretch. He ranks 14th in the IL with a .303 average (53-for-175, 12 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 23 RBI, 4 SB, .842 OPS) in 47 games.

- GWN Career: In 282 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .296 (308-for-1039, 63 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 105 RBI, 11 SB, .771 OPS).
- 300 Club: He is one of seven in Gwinnett history with 300 hits, joining Sean Kazmar Jr. (675), Jose Constanza (437), Rio Ruiz (356), Todd Cunningham (334), Joey Terdoslavich (308), and Ernesto Mejia (302).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 33 of 40 games (82.5%) with the Stripers, batting .248 (28-for-113, 5 2B, 14 R, 10 RBI). He ranks among IL leaders in walks (T-10th, 30) and stolen bases (T-13th, 11), and his .412 OBP would rank third in the circuit if he had enough at-bats to qualify.

LET'S GET TROMPICAL: Chadwick Tromp drove in the decisive runs in Tuesday's 7-0 win (1-for-4, 2 RBI), raising his RBI total to a team-best 29. He also leads the club in homers (9) and is third in total bases (66).

• Mashed in May: Over 20 games in May, Tromp ranked among IL leaders in homers (T-3rd, 8), RBI (T-6th, 22), SLG (T-7th, .632), extra-base hits (T-10th, 12), and total bases (T-12th, 48). He was named the IL Offensive Plaver of the Week for 5/2-8 after batting .471 (8-for-17) with league highs in homers (4), extra-base hits (7), RBI (12), SLG (1.353), and OPS (1.879). Tromp's monster month included a Gwinnett-record nine-game extrabase hit streak from 5/1-12 (4 2B, 7 HR).

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte returned to the Stripers lineup on 6/1 vs. Louisville (1-for-4, 2 R), his first game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 162 of 190 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .284 (186-for-655, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 128 R, 137 RBI, 13 SB, .944 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... From 7/8/21-9/21/21, his Stripers owned the best record in Triple-A Baseball (45-19, .703) ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for Minor League Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryce Elder makes his seventh Triple-A start of the season in game four of a six-game series at Jacksonville.

- GWN Career: Makes his 14th career start with Gwinnett ... Is 4-5 with a 3.80 ERA (31 ER in 73.1 IP), .167 BAA, and 76 strikeouts (9.33 SO/9.0 IP ratio) since 2021 ... When he debuted last season, was the first of Atlanta's 2020 draft class to reach Triple-A.
- Triple-A Splits: In six career road starts, is 2-3 with a 5.12 ERA and .173 BAA ... In 11 career night starts, is 4-4 with a 3.59 ERA and .160 BAA.

PROSPECTING: Elder is ranked the Atlanta Braves' No. 4 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the second-highest ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's roster (Kyle Muller is No. 3).

2022 WITH GWINNETT: Began the season on Gwinnett's Opening Night roster, but did not appear before having his contract selected by Atlanta on 4/12 ... Optioned back to Gwinnett on 5/1 ... 5/18 vs. MEM: Set new career high with 11 strikeouts over 7.0 IP (5 H, 3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB) for his first Triple-A victory of the season as the Stripers won 4-3 ... 5/30 vs. LOU: Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings (2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 8 SO) and had a no-hitter through 6.1 frames in a 2-0 win on Memorial Day.

2022 WITH ATLANTA: Made his MLB debut with Atlanta on 4/12 vs. Washington, earning the win (5.2 IP, 6 H, 3 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 4 SO) in the Braves' 16-4 rout ... Became the 107th former Gwinnett player to reach the Majors and the first Braves starter to win his MLB debut since Ian Anderson (8/26/20 at NYY, won 5-1) ... Went 0-3 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER in 13.1 IP) in his next three starts.

2021 SEASON: Earned the Braves' Phil Niekro Award for Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 11-5 with a 2.75 ERA, 1.10 WHIP, and .193 BAA in 25 starts across three levels (High-A Rome, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett) during his pro debut ... Ranked among MiLB pitching leaders in innings (1st, 137.2), starts (T-2nd), wins (T-6th), and strikeouts (10th, 155) ...
