SUPAK, ORTIZ LEAD RIDERS TO SERIES FINALE VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders dominated the Amarillo Sod Poodles 9-1 on Sunday night from HODGETOWN. The RoughRiders (7-11, 45-41) struck first in the top of the first inning when two runs scored on a **Josh Hatcher** sacrifice fly, thanks to an obstruction call at second base against Sod Poodles (10-8, 42-45) starter Alec Baker (2-3). In the second, Frisco added on when **Frainyer Chavez** drove in a run with an RBI groundout to push the lead to 3-0. The RoughRiders then exploded in the fourth inning for five runs. **Ian Moller** started the scoring with an RBI double before Chavez reached on an error, scoring two more runs. Hatcher then ripped a two-run single to increase the lead to 8-0. **Abimelec Ortiz** clobbered a solo homer in the seventh, boosting the lead to 9-0. The shot was his 12th of the season to re-take the team lead. The Sod Poodles pushed their only run across with an RBI single from Manuel Peña in the eighth to make the score 9-1. **Trey Supak** (6-3) earned the victory, throwing six shutout innings, allowing just three hits while striking out seven and walking one. **Ryan Lobus** and **Gerardo Carrillo** both threw scoreless innings in the win out of the bullpen.

<u>VS. THE HOOKS</u>

The RoughRiders are 8-6 against Corpus Christi this season, including 4-4 at home against the Astros affiliate. **Abimelec Ortiz** leads the RoughRiders in OPS (.936) against Corpus with three home runs while **Sebastian Walcott** has clubbed four of his nine home runs against the Hooks.

K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 20 games, he is hitting .384 (28-for-73)/.464/.479/.943 with seven doubles, five RBIs, 10 walks, 10 runs scored and just seven strikeouts. In July, he is batting .378 (14-for-37) over 10 games, which is sixth in the league.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 54 games since May 7th, he is batting .278/.343/.478/.821 with 16 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 18 games, he is slashing .316/.369/.579/.948 with six doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:

Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is third in the league in ERA (2.73) while leading the league with 98 strikeouts this season. He is also eighth in innings (79.0), second in WHIP (1.13), first in strikeout rate (30.4 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), first in left on base rate (82.7 percent) and first in swinging strike rate (14.0). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.54 is second in all of Minor League Baseball.

SWIPE CITY

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 16 of their last 19 games. Over those 19 games, they have stolen 30 total bases, which is third in the league. **Sebastian Walcott** is tied for second in the league with eight steals in that span while **Cam Cauley** is eighth with six. Overall this season, the Riders are sixth in the league with 98 stolen bases.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

After the RoughRiders committed 20 errors in 23 April games, which was sixth in the league, they have the fewest in the league overall with 57. They also have just committed just 39 errors in their last 63 games. That mark is also second-best in Double-A. Their 57 stolen bases allowed are the fewest in Double-A and are the third-fewest in Minor League Baseball.

SAVE TONIGHT

The RoughRiders have had 11 different pitchers record a save in 2025. Frisco was the first team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. **Gavin Collyer** are leads the team saves (eight) for the Riders, a mark that second in the Texas League. Their 27 saves are tied for the most in Double-A. Their 4.24 bullpen ERA is seventh in the league. In June, their 3.62 reliever ERA was fourth in the Texas League.

WALLY'S WORLD

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.3 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 33 steals over 128 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.

-Made only relief appearace of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

2023 SEASON

- -In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.
- -He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.
- -In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.
- -Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.
- -Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

- -115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).
