### ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Brandon Birdsell fired 4 straight no-hit, shutout innings, and Yohendrick Pinango pulled in a 3 RBI game as the South Bend Cubs defeated the Great Lakes Loons 7-3 to tie the series at 2 games apiece.

### A BIRDIE ON 18

Through 3 pro starts, Birdsell, the Chicago Cubs 5th-round pick out of Texas Tech has posted a no-hit performance in 2 of the 3. On Easter Sunday in Quad Cities, he went 3 no-hit innings, yesterday though was as locked in as he has been so far.

### GOOD EYE

With 11 walks so far this season, Yohendrick Pinango is already one-third of the way to the total number of walks he had last year in 115 games. Additionally, Kevin Made has 8 walks in 10 games, he had 19 free passes in 37 games with South Bend last year.

### ZOOM ZOOM

The South Bend Cubs continue to lead the Midwest League in stolen bases with 32, and are the only MWL league team to eclipse 30 steals so far.

### GOOD MEMORIES HERE

This week's series in Midland marks the first time that the South Bend Cubs have played at Dow Diamond since winning the MWL East Division Pennant there on September 8, 2019. It was win the Cubs posted before taking on and beating the Clinton LumberKings in the Championship Series that September. Righty Derek Casey was the starting pitcher for SB in Great Lakes that night.

### STREAKING

After last night's win over Great Lakes, Bradlee Beesley has extended his hitting streak to 9 straight games, Haydn McGeary is up to 8 games straight with a hit, and Fabian Pertuz has his on-base

streak at 11 consecutive ballgames.

### CHAMPIONS RETURN

On the 2023 South Bend Cubs Opening Day Roster, 15 players who are 2022 Midwest League Champions return. ### FAMILIAR COACHING STAFF

Manager Lance Rymel, who has now won back-to-back championships from the Arizona Fall League in 2021, and the Midwest League in 2022, is back as South Bend Cubs Manager. He is joined by returning hitting coach Dan Puente, and bench coach D'Angelo Jimenez. New to the staff is pitching coach Clayton Mortensen, who was the pitching coach last year with Low-A Myrtle Beach. Mortensen was the St. Louis Cardinals' first round pick in 2007. He made his MLB debut with St. Louis on June 29, 2009. In total, Mortensen pitched in 74 Big League games and struck out 112 batters with the Red Sox, Athletics, Rockies, and Cardinals.

### MCGEARY SETTING THE PACE

South Bend Cubs first baseman Haydn McGeary is now hitting over .400 in his first taste of High-A baseball, and is now leading the Midwest League in base hits with 21, as well as total bases 34. McGeary is no stranger to hitting .400+, in his final 2 years at Colorado Mesa (Division II) he hit .481 both seasons.
