### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound tonight, looking to bounce back from last night's loss (have not lost consecutive games since three straight at Indy from 8/25-8/27). The Bats will counter with RHP **Carson Spiers**. Columbus is 56-39 (.589) versus righties this year. Spiers has faced Columbus four times in his career, going 0-1 with a 3.95ERA (13.2IP, 11H, 7R, 6ER, 9BB, 11K).

### vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). The Clippers have won each series so far this year (3-2 from 5/19-5/23, 4-2 from 6/30-7/5). **Kahlil Watson** has hit .341 (14x41) with 2HR and 6RBI in 11G against Louisville in his career (**Milan Tolentino** has hit 4HR with 18RBI in 28G).

### Start with a Bang

Over the last 35G, the Clippers have plated 248 runs (most in the IL, 7.1 per), with 157 (63%) tallied in the first four innings of the game. Opponents have only 75 in the first four innings of the last 35G, but are outscoring the Clippers 117-91 thereafter. Last night's loss snapped a 64G win streak when Columbus led after the 7th (first loss since 8/22/25; 78 straight wins when leading after the 8th; 8/7/25).

### Bombs Away

Columbus leads all of pro baseball in homers hit since 7/28 (75), entering today with the 3rd most in franchise history (192, one of four teams in the IL with at least 190, zero PCL teams have that many; 10 of 13 teams with at least 160 in Triple-A are in the IL). Columbus has only 88HR on the road, but is averaging at least one a game for the seventh straight season (zero times in previous 14 seasons).

### Heating Up

**Kahlil Watson** has hit safely in each of the last 5G (.381/.409/.810), picking up 3HR and 9RBI (.204/.339/.355 with 4HR and 15RBI in first 26G after being optioned on 7/22). Watson has played just over twice as many games with the Clippers this year (87) as last year (43), but has an identical .835OPS. His next steal will be his 100th in the minors (9SB in MLB), but he has 13CS this year (of 37 in career).

### Big Time Production

**Kyle Manzardo** hit safely in each of 19G from 8/15 until last night (.347, 26x75, 3HR), while collecting 23RBI (RBI in 14G of streak). The streak was the 2nd longest in the IL this year (Rochester's **Trey Lipscomb** hit in 20 straight from 8/2-8/25). In his Columbus career, Manzardo has played only 131G (576PA), but he has still managed 69XBH (.557SLG), including 31HR, against just 60 singles.

### Capitalizing

**George Valera** has played sparingly since 7/28, appearing in only 14 of 35G, but he has slashed .352/.435/.759 with 5HR and 13RBI when he does take the field (hit .148/.250/.182 with 0HR and 7RBI in 26G prior, 6/10-7/26). The hot streak includes hits in 13 of 14G and, dating to a game prior, he has reached base in 15 straight (.424OBP). In his Clipper career, he has hammered 48HR in 304G.

### Twenty Town

**Kody Huff** snapped a 12G homerless streak last night, to reach 20 on the season (.364, 16x44, .591SLG since 8/23). Columbus now has three players with at least 20 and a couple more with at least 19 (**Kahlil Watson** hit 19th on Sunday, **Cooper Ingle** hit 19th on Saturday), marking the second time in history (2019) the Clippers have five players with at least 19HR (never had five with at least 20HR).

### Power and Speed

**Milan Tolentino** popped his 20th homer Saturday night (3HR in last 8G) and picked up his 18th steal on Friday, as he attempts to secure the second 20-20 season in franchise history. He scored the first such season last year and, since the start of 2025, he is 2nd in the IL with 41HR (t-25th with 38SB). **Kahlil Watson** is sitting at 19HR (career high, had 11HR through 5/29) and 22SB (three off career best).

### Busting Out

**Dayan Frias** was 1x25 (.040) with an RBI triple from 8/20-8/28, but has gone 8x27 with 4HR and 7RBI in 5G since (also has 4BB). He tied a career high with his 20th steal Saturday night (had 20SB between Akron and Columbus last year). **Tyresse Turner** is hitting only 1x9 (.111) in 4G since being promoted, but has drawn 5BB (.429OBP) and collected 3SB (61SB against just 6CS in the last three years).

## Columbus Clippers Game Information

Wednesday, September 9

### This Date in Clipper History

9/9/1996

**Dave Eiland** tossed a complete game to open the Governors' Cup Finals, beating the Rochester Red Wings 5-2. The Clippers would go on to sweep Rochester, following a sweep of Norfolk, to go perfect in the playoffs (only five perfect playoff teams in IL history: 1937 Newark Bears, 1982 Tidewater Tides, 1987 Columbus Clippers, 1996 Columbus Clippers and 2002 Durham Bulls).

### First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,496 to 1,450).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 188-149 (.558) in pitch reviews, with batters going 94-88 (.516) and pitchers/catchers going 94-61 (.606). They have run out of challenges in 48G and have not challenged in 8G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

### On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 847, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

### On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 165 through 136G (on pace for 178SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 50CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (54; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

### Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 190 runs while crafting a .891OPS (over 60 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 128 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +62 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 307-201 from innings 5-7).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 81 grand slams and 2,003RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.36 through 135G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 200HR (would be 2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 7th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 74G this season (43-31, .581), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Good Baseball

**CJ Kayfus** bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers have the 8th most last at bat wins this year (15, three off the lead) while playing in the 13th most games decided in the last at bat (28, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 102G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 49-53 (.480, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's seventh year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 460-468 (.496), 430-422 with Columbus (.505).

#### Workhorse:

Allen is the only Clipper averaging over 81 pitches per start this year, at 87.3 (has 90+ in 7GS, rest of team has 90+ in 8GS). Averaging almost 93 pitches per outing in the Majors last season, Allen hit triple digits six times (Columbus has not had a pitcher reach 100 since **Peyton Battenfield** on 9/2/22, 577G ago).

#### On Guard(ians):

In four stints in the Majors this season (27th man in a DH on 4/5 and 7/18, two-day excursion from 5/24-5/25, three weeks from 8/15-9/3), Allen has appeared seven times for Cleveland. He closed out the game on 5/25 vs. Washington (4.0IP, 5H, 0R, 0ER, 1BB, 7K), his second in relief at the Major League level (once last season). Allen then made a start in the second game of a DH on 7/18 at Pittsburgh (3.1IP, 6H, 3R, 2ER, 3BB, 3K), his first start in the Majors since last year's season finale.

#### Better Half:

Allen has 7GS in the second half of the season, going 4-1 with a 3.16ERA (37.0IP, 35H, 13R, 13ER, 9BB, 44K). He ranked 2nd in the IL in strikeouts this half (one behind **Trenton Denholm**), before his latest promotion on 8/15 (42nd now) while placing 13th in ERA and 10th in WHIP (1.19). The first half of the season saw him 10th in strikeouts (68, 112K overall rank 8th), 22nd in ERA (5.15) and 26th in WHIP (1.58) among 29 pitchers with at least 57.0IP.

#### Stellar Support:

Through 19GS, the bullpen has graced Allen with a 2.99ERA in relief (69.1IP, 23ER), stranding four of seven runners inherited. The defense has committed only 14E in Allen's starts, while the offense has put forward 5.6 runs per game. That all adds up to a 16-3 record (.842) for Columbus when he takes the hill.

#### Month to Month:

In his first 5GS (103BF), Allen recorded 32K (31%) against only 10BB (10%), while painting the zone with strikes on 63% of his offerings. Once the calendar flipped to May, however, he made 4GS (87BF), watching his strikeout rate dip to 16% (14K) and his walk rate inflate to 14% (12BB; strikes on 57% of pitches). He found his groove in June, starting with a 10K outing (fifth of career) on 6/6 vs. Omaha (40K to 105BF last month, 38%; 5BB, 4%, 67% of pitches were strikes). In July, his strikeouts were down once more (23K to 91BF, 25%), while walks were up (6BB, 7%; still sat at 65% strikes thrown, however).

#### Cleaning Up:

Opposing cleanup hitters had just one hit off Allen in their first 30AB of the season, though the hit went over the wall (**Charles McAdoo**, 4/26 at Buffalo). Coming into today, they are 7x46 (.152, 3HR, 1BB, 13K) and, looking at the lineup as a whole, the top five in the order have slashed .225/.298/.385 with 9HR in 231AB against Allen, while batters 6-9 have hit .343/.409/.557 with 6HR in 140AB.
