SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 2-1, to close the series in Portland. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 in that series and 8-4 on the 12-game road trip to New England. On Sunday, **Nick Sinacola** started and allowed one run over six innings, tying the longest outing of his career, to pick up his second Double-A win. **Nick Swiney, Jose Cruz** and **Tyler Myrick** each pitched a scoreless inning to finish the game. **Ismael Munguia** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the top of the third inning with an RBI single. **Carter Howell** scored on a wild pitch in the fourth to stretch the lead to 2-0. In the fifth, the Sea Dogs scored their only run of the day with an RBI single by Tyler McDonough.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in the opener of a six-game series. The two teams met in a three-game set in New Jersey to open the season in April, with the Patriots taking two-of-three games. This series is the Patriots' only visit to The Diamond this season. The Flying Squirrels are 14-7 this year against teams from the Northeast. Today's game marks the start of the Eastern League's second half.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-2 dating back to last Friday. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won four-of-their-last-six series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9. They followed by winning four-of-six June 11-16 at New Hampshire and four-of-six last week in Portland.

THE PATRIOTS have lost five consecutive games, all last week at home against the SeaWolves. They finished the first half with a 32-37 record, which was fourth in the Northeast Division. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (74) and triples (16). There are five Somerset players ranked MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), 3B Tyler Hardman (No. 25) and RHP Danny Watson (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects list includes three Somerset players, including Jones (No. 2), Selvidge (No. 11) and Vrieling (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Wil Jensen makes his third start of the season. He last pitched last Wednesday at Portland and allowed one run over 3.2 innings, striking out five. He made his first start of the year on June 13 at New Hampshire and allowed a season-high five runs in 1.2 innings. Prior to that outing, he had not allowed a run in his previous four starts for the Flying Squirrels. He pitched three games out of the bullpen with Triple-A Sacramento before being assigned back to Richmond on June 11. At the time of his promotion to Triple-A on May 24, Jensen had the third-lowest ERA (1.91) in the Eastern League (min. 28 IP) and had worked the second-most relief innings (28.1). Among Eastern League relievers (min. 20 IP) through his May 24 promotion, Jensen had the fifth-lowest ERA. Jensen is in his third season with the Flying Squirrels. Dating back to 2022, Jensen is 12-4 with a 3.16 ERA in 56 games, including 10 starts, for the Flying Squirrels. For the year in 2023, Jensen led the Eastern League and ranked 10th in MiLB (min. 80 IP) in ERA (2.53) while leading the Flying Squirrels in wins (7) and ranking third in strikeouts (93). He also ranked second in the minors (min. 85 IP) in runners left on base (86.8%) while ranking second in Double-A in relief innings pitched (75.0). Jensen was signed by the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2020 out of Pepperdine University, where he led the nation in ERA that year. For more on Jensen, see page two.

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Bailey Dees makes his 15th start of the season and his second this year against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday against Erie and threw one inning before the game was suspended for rain. He faced the Flying Squirrels on April 6 in Bridgewater and allowed a season-high eight runs over 3.1 innings in a loss. This year, Dees is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (74) and tied for first in games started (14). Dees was selected by the Yankees in the 18th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Penn State. He pitched 16 games out of Somerset's bullpen last year, going 1-1 with a 4.29 ERA after starting the year with High-A Hudson Valley, where he went 1-1 with a 1.74 ERA in 26 appearances.

KOSS-SOME: After leading the minors with a .647 batting average (11-for-17), Christian Koss was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday. In his return to Portland to face his former team, Koss posted a league-leading 1.591 OPS and also led the circuit in hits (11) and doubles (5). He was tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (5), ranked second in OBP (.650) and SLG (.941) and tied for second in runs scored (6). Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 18 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .426 (26-for-61), which is second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season.

HIT PARADE: In Over the last 11 games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.309), runs (80), hits (122), total bases (185), RBIs (73), walks (45), OBP (.384), SLG (.468) and OPS (.852) while ranking tied for first in triples (2) and tied for second in doubles (23). In those 11 games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6.7 runs per game and 11.1 hits per game.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 12 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .367 (22-for-60) with three homers, four doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again last Friday night at New Hampshire and added a homer on Tuesday at Portland. In his last 22 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .326 (30-for-92) with six homers, five doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. His 11-game hitting streak was snapped on Saturday night. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in five-of-six games dating back to June 15 and is batting .440 (11-for-25) in that stretch.

HELLO, JAIRO: In the last road trip, **Jairo Pomares** hit .333 (14-for-42) with four homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs in 11 games. On June 11 at New Hampshire, he picked up a pair of hits, including a double, and set a season high with three RBIs. He matched the three RBIs and homered the next night, adding a double. Pomares homered for the second straight game on June 14, one of his two hits in that game. He homered again on June 16, his third homer of the series in New Hampshire. Pomares went 3-for-5 with a double to open last week's series at Portland last Tuesday and hit a two-run homer last Wednesday.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting .423 (11-for-26) with a homer, a double and seven RBIs over his last six games dating back to Sunday. He has picked up multiple hits in four-of-his-last-six games, including three hits on June 16, June 19 and in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. He hit a solo homer in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with Shane Matheny, Sean Roby and Devin Harris while trailing only Ricky Oropesa (37), Jacob Heyward (33) and Jarrett Parker (30).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .311 (33-for-106) over his last 31 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 23 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .258. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On June 12 at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. In Friday's doubleheader, he drove in four runs.

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .353 (6-for-17) and has added a stolen base. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2022, the Flying Squirrels played a doubleheader against the Portland Sea Dogs. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels won, 4-2. In the first, Brett Auerbach hit an RBI single and Sean Roby hit a two-run homer to open a 3-0 lead. He added a second homer, a solo shot, in the sixth. It was his 18th home run of the season and his 15th at The Diamond, a new record, and his fourth two-homer game of the year. Matt Frisbee started and allowed two runs in a complete game.

IN OTHER WORDS...

Christian Koss on his big week in Portland against the Sea Dogs last week while facing his old team:

"To be playing well is a good feeling. The fact that it's them on the other side makes it a little better. I think the biggest thing is just trying to be consistent with my at-bats. I think hits are cool, but I know it's not always going to be like this, so I am just trying to consistently keep the mindset and gameplan that I am trying to attack. When the results are there, I can't complain. ... We're playing really good base-ball. My job has been a lot easier, having guys in scoring position and having an easy plan to attack. It's contagious."
