Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his 11th Triple-A start of the year against lowa, tonight at 7:38 PM ET at Principal Park.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber against Columbus on $7 / 12$ for the second time this season as he punched out seven batters across 6.0 innings while picking up his fourth win.

Against the I-Cubs: Germán has made three starts vs. lowa. He's pitched a combined 16.1 innings with 17 strikeouts while allowing eights runs (seven earned).

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on $6 / 28$ at 0akland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on $8 / 2$ and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on
March 16, 2024.
