INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY NIGHT: Despite taking a two-run lead into the bottom of the ninth, the Indianapolis Indians dropped the series finale to the Omaha Storm Chasers in walk-off fashion at Werner Park on Sunday evening. 3-2. Down by a pair of runs in the bottom of the ninth inning, Omaha rallied to score a trio of runs en route to the walk-off victory. Tyler Gentry homered to tally the Storm Chasers' first run of the contest. Omaha then knotted the game at two apiece on a Ryan Fitzgerald single. Following an intentional walk issued to Cam Devanney, John Rave roped a single to right field to secure the win. On the first pitch of the game, Ji Hwan Bae launched a solo shot to right field to give the Indians an early lead. Alike Williams added an RBI single in the top of the ninth inning, but it was not enough to secure the victory.

LEADING IT OFF: Ji Hwan Bae led off Sunday evening's contest with a first-pitch home run onto the right-field berm against Daniel Lynch IV. It was his third leadoff home run of the season (also: April 25 at Omaha and May 18 vs. Toledo) for the Indians, the first of which against current-teammate Luis Cessa with the Storm Chasers. Bae launched a pair of leadoff home runs with Indianapolis in 2022, and his five in an Indians uniform now leads all team career leaders in the Victory Field era. In 71 games as the first batter in Indy's lineup, Bae is hitting .322 (89-for-276) with 15 doubles, one triple, nine home runs and 34 RBI. When leading off an inning, regardless of position in batting order, he owns a .331 batting average (58-for-175) with 11 doubles, six home runs and 21 walks.

SILENCED BY CESSA: Facing his former team, RHP Luis Cessa took a no-hitter into the fifth inning and silenced the Storm Chasers with 5.0 shutout frames, exiting his start in line for a win on Sunday evening. He walked three and struck out one through his first four hitless frames before stranding his first and only runner in scoring position following a pair of fifth-inning singles. The performance was Cessa's first scoreless outing since May 15 with Omaha at St. Paul, when he earned the win with 5.0 shutout frames and five strikeouts. Cessa began the season with Omaha after being signed by Kansas City as a minor league free agent on Nov. 18, 2023. In his tenure with the Storm Chasers, he went 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA (17er/39.1ip) and 29 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts) before being granted his release on June 1. He then signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on June 10 and is 1-2 with a 4.87 ERA (11er/20.1ip) and 12 strikeouts in six games (five starts).

CELLY STREAKING: Gilberto Celestino went 2-for-4 with a run on Sunday night to extend his hitting streak to six games since July 5. The outfielder has now hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games since June 23. In that time, he owns a .289 batting average (13-for-45) with four runs, three doubles and five RBI. Sunday was just his second multi-hit performance in that stretch, following July 12 (2) vs. Columbus when he went 2-for-2 with a walk and RBI. In 67 games with Indianapolis this season, he is hitting .271 (64-for-236) with 33 runs, 14 extra-base hits, 25 RBI, 27 walks and nine stolen bases.

STREAK SNAPPED: Ben Heller's International League-leading 15-game scoreless streak (15.1ip) was snapped on Sunday night as he allowed three runs in the ninth inning. During his stretch from May 21-July 19, he recorded a 0.59 WHIP and .082 batting average against (4-for-49). His 15-game streak is the longest scoreless streak by appearances by an IL pitcher since 2022 when Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Greg Weissert led the league with a 25-game scoreless streak (25.1ip).

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a nine-game road trip with a six-game series at Iowa beginning tonight at 7:38 PM ET. The Indians mashed at Principal Park over six games in May, launching a staggering 14 home runs (see below). In 12 total games vs. Iowa, the Indians are 7-5 after winning a six-game set at Victory Field from June 18-23. Kicking off the six-game series for the Indians today is RHP Domingo Germán (4-4, 5.36), who earned back-to-back wins against the I-Cubs on June 18 and 23 with a combined 2.45 ERA (3er/11.0ip) and 12 strikeouts. Countering for Iowa is RHP Kyle McGowin (0-1, 5.67), who has made one career start against the Indians in 82 career Triple-A appearances (66 starts). On June 19, he tossed 5.0 shutout innings with seven strikeouts to take a no-decision as Indy went on to win, 2-0.

DOMINGO'S DAY: Domingo Germán makes his first start since requesting his release on July 16 and being re-signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on July 21 tonight vs. Iowa. He tossed 6.0 two-run innings with seven strikeouts to earn his fourth consecutive win in his last start on July 12 (1) vs. Columbus. During a four-game win streak since June 18, he has a 3.86 ERA (11er/25.2ip) and 25 strikeouts with two-or-less runs allowed in four of those five starts.

MASHING VS. THE I-CUBS: The Indians have launched 17 of their 82 home runs in 12 total games against the Iowa Cubs, their most home runs against a single opponent this season. Fourteen of those home runs came during a six-game series at Principal Park from May 21-26, with the Indians launching a season-high six long balls on May 23. Individually, Matt Gorski leads the pack with five homers in 11 games against Iowa. Below is a list of the hottest Indians hitters against the I-Cubs and their stats.

THIS DATE IN 2001: With 22 hits in a 15-6 win vs. Toledo, the Indians set a new Victory Field era record for the most hits in a single game. Of those 22 team hits, eight were doubles and one was a home run. The effort was highlighted by first baseman Larry Jacobsen, who went 3-for-4 with two RBI and three runs scored on three doubles. Indy's No. 8 and 9 hitters — Elvis Pena and Robinson Cancel — tallied four hits apiece.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Domingo Germán: Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his 11th Triple-A start of the year against Iowa, tonight at 7:38 PM ET at Principal Park.

Last Outing: Germán toed the rubber against Columbus on 7/12 for the second time this season as he punched out seven batters across 6.0 innings while picking up his fourth win.

Against the I-Cubs: Germán has made three starts vs. Iowa. He's pitched a combined 16.1 innings with 17 strikeouts while allowing eights runs (seven earned).

Historic Germán: Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

Miscellaneous: Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
