The RailRiders trailed going into the bottom of the ninth, but looked to start a rally. Jesus Bastidas smoked a ground ball down the third base for a double. Mickey Gasper was hit by a pitch to put two on. A three-run homer from Michael Hermosillo brought SWB within one. That was all the home team could muster falling 4-3.

NEWS & NOTES

NO FREE BASES– The RailRiders issued zero free pases last night as four pitchers combined for no walks through nine innings. It was the first time this season without issuing a base on balls. The staff struck out 12, including five from Ryan Weber. Over 12 games played so far, pitchers have walked just 48 batters to their 115 total strikeouts.

DURAN DURAN - Rodolfo Duran has now extended his hitting streak to five total games, recording at least one in every contest he has participated in. Last night he had two doubles for three total on the season. Duran has also hit a home run. He is second on the team in runs batted in with five. As a catcher, he has been influential in his contests behind the plate. Duran caught his second runner stealing last night and is 2-for-3 on the season. He has not allowed a passed ball, but has three assists.

MATT ATTACK- Matt Krook was first out of the bullpen last night tossing a 1-2-3 sixth. He struck out the side on 12 pitches. Krook has now thrown a total of seven innings this season, letting up just one earned run on two hits. He has issued three walks to his 11 strike-outs. Krook has been lights out as a reliever dropping his ERA to 1.29 through four appearances. In 2022, Krook nailed a franchise record of 155 strikeouts for a season-high along with 10 wins as a part of the starting rotation.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has only allowed three more runs than they have scored this season. The RailRiders have let up 54 runs, while scoring 51 of their own. The best differential in the International League is Columbus with +29 on a .500 record. The worst is Gwinnett who are -29 with a 2-9 record.

BULLPEN BEAUTY- The bullpen combined for five shutout innings on Thursday night. James Norwood had two clean frames while Matt Kroon and Nick Ramirez each had one of their own. The group allowed just one hit and seven total strikeouts. The bullpen has just a 2.68 ERA in 57 innings, which is 55% if the innings pitched.

LEADING THE CHARGE - Manager Shelley Duncan has been rotating through his starting lineup pretty consistently, seemingly focusing on pitching matchups. While every player has gotten at least one rest day, three have participated in all but one contest. Andres Chaparro, Elijah Dunham, and Michael Hermosillo have gotten into eleven games this season. Out of the bullpen, Nick Ramirez, Matt Bowman, and Greg Weissert have the most appearances with five total.

EXTRA EXTRS - With 16 doubles and 18 homers in 12 games, the RailRiders have amassed 34 extra base hits. Two players have five on the season. Jake Bauers has a pair of doubles and three homers, while Elijah Dunham has four two-baggers and one home run. They are one of just three teams in Triple-A without a triple this season.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their parts of the starting pitching staff.


