LAST TIME OUT

Buffalo, NY (July 26) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders dropped 14-2 to the Buffalo Bisons on Wednesday. Franchy Cordero had a two-hit contest, while Estevan Florial recorded his 22nd homer of the season.

Florial went first pitch swinging with a leadoff home run. It was his third time with first at-bat homer this season.

A 10-run third inning boosted the Bisons over the RailRiders. After Ernie Clement started things off with a single, the next five batters reached safely. The team batted through the order and then some with 14 coming up to the plate. With seven hits, three walks, and a hit by pitch Buffalo put up their most runs in a single inning this season and just the third time in 35 years. It was capped off by a bases clearing double from #4 prospect Orelvis Martinez.

The Bisons made it a double-digit advantage with Davis Schneider's leadoff home run in the fifth.

In the sixth, an RBI double off the bat of Schneider made it 12-1.

Buffalo tacked on two more in the seventh with their second long ball of the contest. Tanner Morris smoked a line drive to right field for a 14-1 advantage.

The RailRiders added one in the eighth inning. Austin Wells doubled and moved over on Cordero's base hit. A sacrifice fly off the bat of Carlos Narvaez made it 14-2.

Tanner Tully (L, 5-5) tossed just two and two thirds allowing eight runs on nine hits. Aaron McGarity, Deivi Garcia, and Zac Houston each let up two innings in their outings.

Bowden Francis pitched the first four innings allowing just the initial homer. Gabe Klobovits and Junior Fernandez (W, 3-2) tossed scoreless outings.

NEWS & NOTES

FLO'S FLYING - Yesterday Estevan Florial began the game with a lead off homer on the very first pitch. It was the third time this season he has beaten the opposing pitcher in the first at-bat. At this rate he is averaging one a month. Florial has been in the leadoff batting spot 72 times this summer, the most of anyone on the team.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - In the last seven games, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has had four contests where they have given up 10 or more runs, all for losses. Worcester had three of six games where they reached double digits in runs. The RailRiders have an 1-10 recorded when they have allowed 10+ runs and a 3-18 record when an opponent plates 8 or more runs.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - The RailRiders have committed a total of 87 errors on the season, with one yesterday. Buffalo has 76 on the season. Andres Chaparro and Otto Lopez each have 13 to lead their teams. Visalia leads all of Minor League Baseball with 138 errors.

HOMER HEAVEN The RailRiders are the first team in Minor League Baseball to hit 150 home runs on the season and have 159 this season. Buffalo has the least in Triple-A with just 80 as a team. The New York Yankees have amassed 141, and the Atlanta Braves have the most with 188. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-two, while six players are in double digits.

PEREIRA'S POWER: Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in Triple-A, batting .345 in 14 games played. He has had five of multi-hit and seven multi-RBI. Pereira has batted in 17 runs on 19 hits, including 3 doubles and four homers. The righty has played all three outfield positions. In Somerset, Pereira was batting .291 in 46 total games. There Pereira had 10 doubles and 10 homers.

BUFFALO BRINGS RAIN: Four of the the RailRiders rain delays have occurred against Buffalo this season. However, the team is playing .500 ball in rain delayed contests this season. They have won seven and lost seven with any amount of weather-related timing impact. In addition, half of the delays have occurred at PNC Field and the other half on the road. They have a 4-3 record in those contests on the road.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb making his debut last night. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospects, catcher, Austin Wells (#2 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) and outfielder Everson Periera (#4) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Currently ranked #12 in the Yankees farm system by MLB Pipeline

SPRING START: For the second year in a row, Vasquez received the invite to Major League spring training and appeared in Grapefruit League contents. This spring he went 1-0 in three appearances with one start. He tossed 7.0 innings allowing four runs on 10 hits. He struck out seven and walked four.

THE BIG DEBUT: Randy Vasquez impressed in his first Major League start versus the San Diego Padres. Vasquez recorded his first big league strikeout to Rougie Odor and went on to also punch out Juan Soto and Fernando Tatis Jr. Later in the contest, Soto went on to hit and two-run homer, the only runs Vasquez allowed. He tossed 4.2 innings allowing just four hits and three walks. He struck out six. After the game, Vasquez was optioned back to Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre but remains on the 40-man roster for future use.

PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION: On 4/1/23, Vasquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter.

BRING ON THE CURVE: Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 9 prospect and labeled as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands... combining low-80s power with vertical and horizontal movement produced by spin rates that top 3,100 rpm

PLAYOFF RANDY: He capped his 2022 season with eight no-hit innings in the deciding game of the Double-A Eastern League playoffs before getting added to the 40-man roster in November.

INITIAL SIGNING: Vásquez has gone from signing for just \$10,000 out of the Dominican Republic at the relatively old age of 19 in May 2018 to becoming one of the Yankees' better pitching prospects.
