TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints got a dominant start from Louie Varland, who threw 6.0 shutout innings, but could not back it up in a 3-1 loss. Alex Isola doubled to lead off the second and scored on a DaShawn Keirsey Jr. single to give the Saints a 1-0 lead. Varland allowed just two singles and a walk while striking out seven in the start. The Saints held the 1-0 lead into the eighth inning before Brian O'Keefe hit a pinch-hit solo home run to tie the game. In the ninth, Cam Devanney hit a two-run home run to give the Storm Chasers a 3-1 lead. The Saints loaded the bases in the bottom of the ninth but could not get the tying runs across in the loss.

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on Sunday and the 43rd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League.

\$\sigma\$ In the month of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, the most in the International League. He also leads the league in July with his 41 total bases and his .788 slugging percentage. His 1.217 OPS is the third-best in the IL this month. It is also the best of any month he's had in 2024 and over double his .544 OPS in June.

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: The Minnesota Twins sent Jose Miranda to St. Paul on a Major League rehab assignment on Wednesday. The Saints have two Major League Rehab assignment on their roster, along with Royce Lewis is making his second rehab appearance with the Saints, previously playing with them from May 25-June 2. Lewis has gone 4-for-25 with a double in seven total games. Miranda was placed on the 10-Day IL on July 14 (retro July 11) for a low back strain.

CHASING STORMS HOME RUNS: The Saints have hit 74 home runs against Omaha at CHS Field, the most long balls they have hit against any team in any venue in franchise history. Their .481 slugging percentage against Omaha is the fourth-best against any opponents at CHS Field since 2021.

AND THAT'S ON BASE: A day after Anthony Prato reached base in all five of his plate appearances on Saturday, Chris Williams replicated the feat on Sunday in his 4-for-4 outing. He is the fourth Saint to do so this season, joining Prato (4/24, 7/20), Will Holland (4/23) and Diego A. Castillo (5/14). Prato and Williams are the second pair to do so in back-to-back games, as Holland and Prato did so on April 23-24. Williams is the 15th player in franchise history to reach base in all five-or-more plate appearances.

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .426 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 12 of the 14 games he's played in, drawing eight walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is third among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .449 across three levels.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 46 games since May 21, he has hit .347 (59-for-170), with 10 home runs, drawing 34 walks to 47 strikeouts, owning a 1.025 OPS. Since June 1, Severino is tied for the league lead with 48 hits, third in on-base percentage at .456, fourth in the IL in batting average at .345 and fifth in OPS, at 1.010. His 29 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins were held to three hits in a 3-0 loss to Philadelphia on Tuesday. Simeon Woods Richardson threw 6.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits and a walk. The Phillies scored all three of their runs in the ninth inning against Jhoan Duran, who took his fifth loss of the season.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/7 v GWN...made 15th start of the season, giving up career-highs in hits and runs, giving up nine runs on 13 hits, one home run, walking one and striking out three over 4.0+ innings of work...allowed three hits in the first inning, including a two-run homer to Yuli Gurriel...allowed back-to-back singles to start the second inning that both came around to score...worked around a walk and double in the third inning...allowed one run in the fourth inning on a single and double...allowed four straight hits to open the fifth, leaving the game before recording an out...13 hits allowed tie the most given up by a Triple-A pitcher in 2024 and are tied for the second-most in franchise history...Saints allowed franchise record 24 hits and 21 runs...took third loss and second in a row in 21-6 Saints loss.

WORLD SERIES RUNNER-UP: Caleb spent his college years not far from home at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. As a freshman, he got to experience something that not many players get the opportunity to experience: a trip to the College World Series. His DIII squad reached the championship after beating Salisbury, 7-3, Emory, 3-2 in 12, losing the first game of the semifinals to Trinity(TX), 16-7, but bouncing back to win the second game, 10-7. Unfortunately, they met their match in the championship dropping the best-of-three to Cortland, getting swept 11-3 and 6-2. He would get back to the DIII World Series in 2016, but this was less successful losing 8-0 to Trinity, beating Emory, 12-3 before being eliminated by the team they lost to in the 2015 DIII Championship Game, Cortland, 8-3.

SOMETHINGS BREWING: One can't help where they grow up which can determine who you root for growing up. Caleb was born in Neenah, WI and resides in Madison, WI, so naturally he rooted for the Milwaukee Brewers. His hometown team came calling in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021, taking Caleb with the 22nd pick overall from the San Diego Padres. The storybook had an incredible ending when he was called up to the Brewers on September 29, 2023. He pitched 2.1 innings of relief vs. Chicago Cubs and allowed one run on one hit while walking two and striking out five. He earned the win in his lone Major League appearance.

GIVE BACK: Each of the Major League team's usually choose a player or players within their organization for the hard work they put towards the community. In 2023, the Brewers selected Caleb as the Nashville Sounds Community Player of the Year.
