# **TIDES SURVIVE ON WALK-OFF**

The Jumbo Shrimp scored twice in the top of the ninth to tie on Saturday, but Jackson Holliday's walk-off sacrifice fly won it for the Tides 5-4. Norfolk got the scoring started with back-to-back RBI doubles from Kyle Stowers and Billy Cook in the third. Devvision De Los Santos homered in the fourth and Victor Mesa Jr. tied the score with an RBI single in the fifth. A sacrifice fly in the sixth put the Tides back in front. After a Norfolk tally in the eighth, an error plated two Jacksonville runs in the ninth inning. However, the Tides stopped the Jumbo Shrimp's three-game winning streak.

### SEVENTH HEAVEN

Despite Saturday's 5-4 loss to Norfolk, Jacksonville has still won seven of its last nine games. Eight of those nine games have been decided by two runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have yielded more than four runs only twice during this stretch, with not coincidentally those resulting as the club's lone losses over this run. However, while Jacksonville has allowed just 24 runs over these nine games (2.7 per game), they have hit just .221/.297/.357/.654 as a team, plating only 36 runs (4.0 per game).

# IT'S TEARIN' UP MY START WHEN I'M WITH YOU

In 2005, Jacksonville starting pitchers ranked just 25th in Double-A with 741.0 innings, which represented 60.6 percent of the club's 1223.2 innings. This season, the Jumbo Shrimp's starting rotation has worked 51.4 percent of the club's innings, a total of 448.1 out of 871.2 frames. That figure is the eighth-most in Triple-A. Jacksonville lid-lifters also lead the level in ERA (4.24; next-closest is Memphis at 4.58) while ranking second in WHIP (1.35), third in BAA (.251), fourth in OPSA (.766) and ninth in walks (177).

# **GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'**

Jacksonville has gone 24-16 (.600) in their last 40 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 28 of those 40 affairs (70.0 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in fewest runs allowed (144: next-closest is Indianapolis at 161). ERA (3.44: next-closest is Indianapolis at 3.81) and WHIP (1.32) while ranking second in OPS against (.724) and third in both BAA (.240) and fewest hits allowed (308).

# **QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START**

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 35 of the last 39 games, with 27 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 14 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 71 runs, 64 earned, on 155 hits (8.2 H/9) in 169.1 innings for a 3.40 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 174 strikeouts (9.2 K/9) against 76 walks (4.0 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 17 different pitchers over these 39 contests.

### **SOULJA TROY**

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 50 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 62-for-188, slashing .330/.399/.505/.904 with 12 doubles, three triples, five homers, 25 RBIs, 20 walks and 33 runs scored. Johnston has 16 multi-hit games in his last 32 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (109) while also ranking sixth in doubles (24) and 23rd in batting average (.284).

# GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 64 games, the Duke product is 63for-219, slashing .288/.363/.548/.911 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 41 RBIs, 25 walks and 40 runs scored. Among the 108 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks ninth in HR/FB (25.8 percent). On the year, he ranks tied for 14th in the IL in both homers (17) and extra-base hits (36).

# **SHRIMP BITES**

The Jumbo Shrimp are 18-11 (.621) in their last 29 road games... By winning one on Sunday to close their series at Norfolk, Jacksonville would earn their second consecutive set victory, something they have not done since taking four of six from both Norfolk and Memphis from April 16-28... After surrendering nine runs on seven hits in 6.2 innings over his first two Triple-A starts (12.15 ERA), Valente Bellozo has ceded just six runs, four earned, on 18 hits in 23.0 innings for a 1.57 ERA over his last five outings at the level.

# **ABOUT VALENTE**

- -Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.
- -After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.
- -Bellozo made his major league debut for the Marlins on June 18, 2024 against the Royals from Kauffman Stadium in Kansas City. He tossed 5.0 shutout innings, scattering two hits and a walk with two strikeouts.
- -Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

# 2024 SEASON

- -Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.
- -At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

# 2023 SEASON

- -In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).
- -As a starter with Asheville, Bellozo posted an 0-3 record and 7.34 ERA in 13 starts (57.2 IP, 65 H, 19 BB, 53 K, .284 BAA). Comparatively, as a reliever, he was 3-0 with a 4.38 ERA in nine appearances (37.0 IP, 41 H, 7 BB, 41 K, .273 BAA).
