In the fastest nine-inning game in franchise history, **Mitch Myers**, **Grant Judkins** and **Hunter Breault** combined on a three-hit shutout, **Brayan Buelvas** drilled a two-run double and **Euribiel Ángeles** delivered a sacrifice fly for the victory in one hour and 44 minutes.

Streiking: **Euribiel Ángeles** went 1-for-2 with a single and a walk last night, extending his team-high hitting streak to 12 games.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in total bases (947), triples (31), slugging percentage (.402) and OPS (.752), tied for 1st in batting average (.259), and 2nd in runs (378), base hits (611), doubles (124), RBIs (345), and tied for 2nd in on-base percentage (.350).

Speedball: On June 2, the Lugnuts beat Peoria in Game 1 of a doubleheader, 5-1, in one hour and 23 minutes, setting the franchise record for fastest seven-inning game. Then last night, the Nuts set the new franchise record for fastest nine-inning game, beating the Whitecaps, 3-0, in one hour and 44 minutes. The last two days, the Lugnuts have outscored the Whitecaps 11-1 in a combined three hours and 46 minutes to play 18 innings, averaging six minutes for each half-inning. The Whitecaps' offense collected 17 hits and 15 runs in the first game of the series... but only have one run on eight hits in the last two games, dropping West Michigan's team batting average to .222 and team OPS to .654, 11th out of the 12 MWL teams.

Tops in the TL: **Gunnar Hoglund**, who pitched for the Lugnuts last season, tossed six innings for the Double-A RockHounds last night, allowing one run, walking none and striking out eight. Hoglund is tied for 1st in the Texas League in wins (8), tied for 1st in starts (14), tied for 1st in complete games (1), the only pitcher in the league with a shutout, 1st in innings pitched (84 2/3), tied for 2nd in strikeouts (79), tied for 3rd in batting average (.218), 4th in WHIP (1.10) and 5th in ERA (3.08).

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 Athletics prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 24), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

Nothing but Goose Eggs: 2022-23 Lugnuts pitcher **Grant Holman** has pitched 30 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this season, 19 1/3 with Midland and 10 2/3 innings with Las Vegas, the most scoreless innings for any MiLB pitcher. Holman tossed 1 1/3 scoreless innings last night, fanning two.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., hit back-to-back home runs off Bowling Green reliever Joe Serrapica in the bottom of the seventh, but the Lugnuts fell to the Hot Rods, 10-6. Bichette finished 3-for-5 to raise his batting average to .402, reaching 102 hits for the year.

2019: Hagen Danner notched his second two-HR game of the year, Griffin Conine swatted a two-run shot, and the host Lugnuts beat Lake County, 9-4. Danner knocked solo home runs down the left-field line in the third inning and down the right-field line in the fourth inning, erasing an early 2-0 deficit.

2023: Petey Halpin broke a fourth-inning scoreless tie with a three-run inside-the-park home run, and the Lake County Captains topped the Lansing Lugnuts, 4-2, at Classic Park. Jake Walkinshaw looked impressive in a limited debut and catcher Tyler Soderstrom walked, singled, crushed his team-leading 12th home run of the year and threw out two Captains on the bases in the losing cause for Lansing.

In a Nutshell: Declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay (\$2.61 million in 2018) and then motored through four levels in his 2023 professional debut... glove this year is green and black to represent A's green and Lugnuts' black... opened 2024 on the Injured List, activated April 29... notable splits:

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder.

Home Cooking: Born in Barquisimeto in the state of Lara, where former Lugnut and current Diamondbacks catcher Gabby Moreno was also born... cousin is Carlos "Cookie" Carrasco, in his 15th year in the Major Leagues and a current member of the Cleveland Guardians rotation; Carlos Carrasco led the Majors in victories (18) in 2017 and finished 4th in A.L. Cy Young voting.
