LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured consecutive victories for the first time in 2023, defeating Aberdeen in 10 innings, 4-3... LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a walk-off RBI single in the 10th...C **Kevin Parada** went 3-for-4, falling a home run short of the cycle...Aberdeen tied the game in the 9th on a walk, a single, and a throwing error...RHP **Tyler Stuart** punched out a career-high 9 over 5 frames in a no-decision for the 'Clones... RHP **Daniel Lloyd** matched a career-best with 7 K's over 4 innings for the IronBirds...LHP **Daniel Juárez** earned his 2nd win and posted his 20th-straight outing without yielding an earned run.

BULLS ON PARADA: C Kevin Parada registered a career-high 3 hits in Brooklyn's 4-3, 10-inning win over Aberdeen on Tuesday night...The 21-year-old singled in the 1st, doubled off the left-field fence and scored in the 6th, and added a triple into the right-center field gap in the 8th...lt was Parada's 3rd multi-hit game in his last 6 outings...ln that span, the Pasadena, Calif. native is hitting .308 (8-26) with 4 extra-base hits.

BIG STU SHOVES: RHP Tyler Stuart has been as consistent as any starting pitfcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023... The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision on Tuesday vs. Aberdeen...The 9 K's were the most by a Cyclones pitcher this season...Stuart's 9 punchouts were the most by for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Dominic Hamel** struck out 9 vs. Wilmington on September 2, 2022...Entering Wednesday, Stuart leads the SAL in ERA (1.93)...He is tied for 4th in strikeouts (27), 6th in batting average against (.203), and 9th in WHIP (1.23)...The right-hander is also 4th in strikeout rate (34.6%) and xFIP (3.17).

BOUNCE BACK BULLPEN: Brooklyn's bullpen has been sublime over the last 3 outings dating back to last Wednesday at Jersey Shore...On Tuesday, 4 Cyclone relievers combined to yield just 1 unearned run over 5 innings...Brooklyn's bullpen has not permitted an earned run since the 8th inning of last Wednesday's contest, a span of 11.1 innings...Over the last 3 games, Cyclones relievers have accrued a miniscule 0.71 ERA (1 ER in 12.2 IP)...In 12.2 innings, Brooklyn relief pitching has permitted 8 hits, 10 walks, and struck out 16.

RUN LIKE THE WIND, BULLSEYE: Brooklyn has made a habit of swiping bases in 2023...Coming into Wednesday's match-up, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League with 12 and Palmer is tied for 7th with 9...More importantly, both are a combined 21-for-22 on attempts...The 'Clones are tied for 8th in the league with 36 team stolen bases, but have the best success rate in the SAL at .900... Brooklyn has been caught stealing a league-low 4 times this year...Hudson Valley is in 2nd with 6 runners caught.

OMAR'S AUTOMATIC: In addition to his 12 stolen bases in 12 attempts in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 82 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for the 3rd most in Milb...Only Triple-A El Paso & Nashville OF Esteury Ruíz (85) and Double-A Portland & Triple-A Worcester INF David Hamilton (84) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...

vs. ABERDEEN Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds claim 5 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per Baseball America...2022 No. 1 overall pick — SS Jackson Holliday — is the top-rated prospect at No. 3 in the organization...OF Dylan Beavers (11), OF Jud Fabian (14), INF Max Wagner (19), and INF Frederick Bencosme (29) are also featured...The Cyclones were eliminated by the IronBirds, 2-1, in the 2022 South Atlantic League North Division Championship last September... Brooklyn is 117-105 (.527) all-time against Aberdeen.

Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 31.

DANIEL'S DOMINANCE: LHP Daniel Juárez has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023... In his first 7 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 12...In 12 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 11.2 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 20 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts in 22.0 innings.

NEW KIDS ON CONEY: Brooklyn added INF Mateo Gil to the roster from Double-A Binghamton and RHP **Benito García** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...Gil, the son of 8-year Major League INF **Benji Gil**, slashed .143/.214/.204 in 14 games for the Rumble Ponies, adding 7 RBI...García made 5 relief appearances with St. Lucie, composing a 1-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER in 9.1 IP) an 5 strikeouts...INF **Brad Malm** was transferred to the Doublement Liet. ferred to the Development List.

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, Baseball America ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 4 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, Baseball America deemed Colón one of the Mets' "14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30"

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season...Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA'S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)...He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
