SATURDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 7-6. After Andrew Pinckney gave Harrisburg the lead with a two-run homer in the first, Richmond scored five runs in the second to take the lead. With the bases loaded, Jimmy Glowenke was hit by a pitch, Luis Toribio walked in a run, Turner Hill hit a go-ahead single, Ismael Munguia hit an RBI groundout and Carter Howell added a sacrifice fly. C.J. Stubbs closed the score to 5-3 with a bases-loaded walk in the top of the third, but Glowenke moved the lead to 6-3 with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the inning. Victor Bericoto hit an RBI double in the fourth to push the Richmond lead to 7-3. The Senators scored on a wild pitch in the fifth, an RBI groundout by J.T. Arruda in the sixth and an RBI double by Pinckney in the eighth to pull within a run. Mat Olsen closed his second save of the year with a scoreless ninth. The Senators went 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position and stranded 12 on base in the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, in the second of a six-game series. The series marks the Senators' only trip to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels played a six-game series in Harrisburg from April 16-21, going 3-3. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for six games from August 13-18.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 3-3 last week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half the previous week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .221 and averaging 3.85 runs per game (154 runs/40 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). Richmond is 3-11 in its last 14 home games dating back to June 6.

THE SENATORS are 3-10 to open the second half after finishing second in the Southwest Division in the first half, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg has lost five straight games and has gone 4-14 over its last 18 games since June 19. On the season, the Senators offense ranks last in the Eastern League in batting average (.220), OBP (.301), SLG (.328) and OPS (.628). Harrisburg's pitching staff ranks second in the league in ERA (3.38). Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Daylen Lile (No. 10), RHP Andy Lara (No. 14), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Bryzykcy (No. 19) and SS Kevin Made (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes even Harrisburg players, including Lile (No. 6), Pinckney (No. 16), Brzykcy (No. 17), Made (No. 18), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), Lara (No. 27) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Seth Lonsway makes his third Double-A start. Last time out, he surrendered five runs, all in the third inning, in a five-inning no-decision at Bowie last Wednesday night. In his debut on June 28, he threw six scoreless innings and allowed four hits with five strikeouts against the Patriots at The Diamond. It was the first six-inning scoreless debut for the Flying Squirrels since Conner Menez in 2018. Dating back to his final two starts in High-A, it was the third straight outing he pitched six innings. In his final four High-A starts dating back to June 1, Lonsway posted a 2.95 ERA (7 ER/211 IP). Lonsway pitched at Ohio State before being selected in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Giants. He was also selected by the Reds in the 2017 MLB Draft out of high school but did not sign. Lonsway spent last season with Eugene and went 2-9 with a 5.87 ERA in 28 outings, including 17 starts. For more on Lonsway, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Kyle Luckham makes his 16th start of the season. He last pitched on July 1 against the Curve and allowed one run over five innings, striking out six. He also pitched against the Flying Squirrels on April 16 at FNB Field and threw six innings, allowing two runs with four strikeouts. In the Eastern League, Luckham ranks fourth in innings pitched (87.2) this season, five shy of the league leader. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Wilmington and went 5-7 with a 4.85 ERA in 25 games (24 starts). He finished the year tied for first in the South Atlantic League in games started (24) and innings pitched (124.1) while ranking third in BAA (.252) and WHIP (1.23) and sixth in ERA (4.85). He was promoted to Double-A Harrisburg for his final start of the season on September 15 and allowed four runs (three earned) over five innings against the Baysox. Luckham was selected in the 15th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Arizona State University.

CARTER'S CRUISING: Dating back to June 13 in 18 games, **Carter Howell** is batting .333 (25-for-75) with seven doubles, two triples and 14 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times and he has two hits in three-of-his-last-six games. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for fourth in doubles (18), ranks ninth in batting average (.287) and tied for ninth in hits (73).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 25 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .349 (37-for-106) with three homers, six doubles, six walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 35 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .326 (45-for-138) with six homers, seven doubles, 12 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in nine-of-17 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .366 (26-for-71) in that stretch. He is currently riding an eight-game hit streak since June 29.

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .317 (19-for-60) and has added four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 14 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. Last Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

POMARES POWER: Jairo Pomares has three homers in his last eight games dating back to June 28. On the year, he leads the Flying Squirrels and ranks fourth in the Giants system in homers (10). Pomares missed the start of the season with an injury and joined the Flying Squirrels for his Double-A debut on May 5. Since then, his 10 homers are tied for third in the Eastern League, trailing only 11 home runs by Erie's Hao-Yu Lee and Chris Meyers. For Pomares, his 18.1 PA/HR is the second-best in a season in franchise history (min. 150 PA), trailing only Sean Roby (14.12) in 2022 when he set the single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever Eric Silva has thrown six consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 8.2 innings. He has 10 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.84. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,885), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 18), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.

SHINING STARS: Major League Baseball announced the full 2024 All-Star Game rosters on Sunday night and two former Flying Squirrels, outfielder Heliot Ramos and pitcher Logan Webb, were both selected for the first time in their careers. Webb, who pitched 14 games for Richmond in 2018 and 2019, became the first former Flying Squirrels pitcher to be selected as an MLB All-Star. With Richmond, Webb went 2-6 with a 2.88 ERA in his two seasons and was the team's Opening Day starter in 2019. Ramos, who joined the Flying Squirrels at age 19 in 2019, then the youngest player in franchise history, went on to play 87 games with Richmond across the 2019 and 2021 seasons, batting .239 with 13 homers and 41 RBIs. The pair marked the first former Flying Squirrels to be selected as MLB All-Stars since 2021. They became the fifth and sixth Flying Squirrels alumni to earn MLB All-Star selections, joining Brandon Crawford (2015, 2018, 2021), Joe Panik (2015), Brandon Belt (2016) and Adam Duvall 2016). The 2024 MLB All-Star Game will next Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas at 8 p.m.

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2011, the Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 4-3. With two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning, Roger Kieschnick hit a walk-off single to break a 3-3 tie. Eric Surkamp started on the mound for the Flying Squirrels, working seven innings, and became the first pitcher in franchise history to strike out 12 batters in a game. That record was matched twice, including once later that year by Surkamp, before it was passed in 2022 when Matt Frisbee struck out 13 at Portland.
