Playoff Picture: The Double-A Northeast League will feature a two-team playoffs this season with one best-of-five Championship Series played between the two teams with the best overall records regardless of division. The Patriots currently find themselves 0.5 games ahead of the Bowie Baysox for the second playoff spot and 5.0 games behind the Akron RubberDucks for the best overall record in the league. The Portland Sea Dogs are also in the conversation, currently 1.5 games behind Somerset. Seven of the Patriots' final 14 games of the season are against Akron and Bowie.

Road Warriors: With the recent announcement that the first three games of Somerset's next series against the Hartford Yard Goats will be played in Hartford, at least 15 of the team's final 18 regular season games will now be played on the road.

Call to the Bullpen: Somerset's bullpen tossed 3.0 scoreless innings yesterday and now has a 1.00 ERA (5 ER over 44.2 IP) over its last 11 games. The bullpen has not allowed a run in it's last four games and has currently tossed 15.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run. Patriots' relievers have the lowest combined ERA (2.83) among all Double-A bullpens and second-lowest in all of Minor League Baseball. Additionally, Somerset's bullpen has the lowest WHIP (1.11) and BAA (.196) in MiLB.

Arms Race: Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.43), BAA (.211) and most shutout wins (15) across all MiLB levels. Additionally, the team owns the third-lowest WHIP (1.16), and ranks second in strikeouts (1,162). The Patriots have already set a new franchise record for strikeouts in a season, passing the previous high set in 2016.

Ernst-ing His Keep: RHP Nick Ernst earned his second Double-A save last night. He currently owns a 1.50 ERA (2 ER over 12.0 IP) over his first seven appearances. Additionally, Ernst has only allowed six baserunners over 12 innings while striking out 17.

Where's Oswaldo: INF Oswaldo Cabrera hit a go-ahead three-run home run in last night's win. It marked his 19th home run of the season, 11 more than his previous career high. Additionally, Cabrera currently leads the team and ranks third in the league in RBI (67).

Locked and Loaded: OF Brandon Lockridge was reinstated from the 7-Day Injured List Thursday night. Lockridge missed two weeks away from the team. He was hitting .342 with seven home runs, 13 RBI, eight stolen bases, and a .387 OBP before he was injured, including a .370 AVG and .435 OBP across 12 games in August.

Hammer Time: INF Dermis Garcia has a pair of go-ahead three-run home runs over the first two games of the current series. Garcia leads the league and the Yankees' organization in home runs (27). Additionally, he ranks second among all of Double-A and is tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball in home runs.

Belly Up: INF Chad Bell began his time in Somerset 6-for-56 (.107) over his first 15 games. He is 6-for-19 (.316) with two home runs, three RBI, and four runs in his last five games.
